# Most Important Topics to Prepare Reasoning for IBPS Clerk Prelims 2018











Given below are the most important topics from Reasoning Section along with the Tricks to solve them.

- 1. Arrangement & Pattern
- 2. Coding & Decoding
- 3. Inequalities
- 4. Syllogisms

# Tricks to Prepare Reasoning for IBPS Clerk Prelims

#### 1. Arrangement & Pattern

There are 10 Qs asked from any of the topics i.e. Random Alphabet, Number Arrangements, Sequences and Mixed Sequences. The Random Sequence of Alphabets questions is asked on a group of 5 terms each of 3 alphabets or series of the alphabet, while Number Arrangements Qs asked are mostly based on a group of 5 terms each of 3 digits or series of numbers.

### 2. Coding & Decoding

There is 5 question asked on this topic which includes Coding (Fictitious Language) or Coding (by Analogy) or Coding (by Letter Shifting).

## <u>3. Inequalities</u>

5 questions on either Direct Mathematical Inequalities or Coded Inequalities will be asked. Other than that, Mathematical Inequalities are very simple and scorable. So, score more practice at least 5 sets of each daily.







## 4. Syllogisms

Syllogism could be difficult to solve and require special focus. So, practice 20 questions daily. Questions based on 2 Statements and 2 Conclusions with possibility case are usually asked.

# Scoring Chapters to Prepare Reasoning for IBPS Clerk Prelims 2018

The below-mentioned topics are scoring & can be done 100% accuracy.

- 1. Direction & Distance
- 2. Blood Relation
- 3. Order & Ranking
- 4. Classification & Analogy

#### 1. Directions & Distance

This topic is easy and less time-consuming. Also, easy to attain accuracy. Questions based on Route and Network are mainly asked. Practice at least 20 Questions daily to improve your speed.

#### 2. Blood Relations

It includes a single statement & family tree problem. By drawing T- diagram you can easily solve these questions.

### 3. Order & Ranking

Order and Ranking is a very scoring topic. It mainly involves finding out the positions.











## 4. Classification & Analogy

This topic involves questions based on GK, Numbers and Letters. These topics are very easy and can be accurately solved in less time duration.

# Tricky Chapters to Prepare Reasoning for IBPS Clerk Prelims 2018

- 1. Seating Arrangement
- 2. Puzzles


#### 1. Seating Arrangement

At least one comprehension of 5 or more questions on Seating Arrangement will be asked. It will include Circular or linear arrangement problems with one or more variable. Since these Qs are time-consuming so try to identify the simplest questions & then solve it.

#### 2. Puzzles

One Puzzle of 5 questions based on Double Lineup or Scheduling is mostly asked. Usually, people find Puzzles difficult. The only way to approach the puzzles is to practice them as much as you can. By practicing you will able to easily solve it in the exam.

# Less Important Topic to Prepare Reasoning for IBPS Clerk







## 1. Machine Input Output

Normally, Machine input-output questions are not asked in IBPS Clerk prelims exam. But for your safer side practice some of the Qs, so if they may be asked in the exam then you must be prepared for it.

Now that you know, how to approach the reasoning section of IBPS Clerk exam, you can plan out the study schedule for yourself. It will help to evaluate your strong & weak areas.

## **General Tips for Reasoning - IBPS Clerk 2018**

- 4. Do not spend more than 20 minutes in solving Reasoning Ability Section.
