1. Applications are invited in the prescribed format from the candidates fulfilling the following conditions for engagement of **204 nos.** of Act Apprentices for **Liluah Workshop & 659 nos.** for **Howrah Division** under the Apprenticeship Act, 1961 and Apprenticeship Rules, 1962 for imparting training .
2. **The candidates shall have to apply for one unit only either for Liluah Workshop or for Howrah Division. No candidate could apply for both the units (i.e. more than one unit) in case of which the application is liable to be rejected.**

5. Standards of Fitness for PH Person : (BOTH FOR LILUAH & HOWRAH DIVISION)

Candidate selected under the reservation provided for PH Person is to be placed in the appropriate category viz. UR/SC/ST/OBC to which he belongs.

A) For Loco motor or Cerebral palsy (OH) :-

- 1) Fitter:- Lower limb partially damaged from one side can join.
- 2) Turner:- Lower limb partially damaged from one side can join.
- 3) Machinist:- Only small finger damaged can join.
- 4) Mech(Dsl):- Upper limb partially damaged (Little finger & Ring finger) can be accommodated.
- 5) Welder :- A person without leg and without three finger of one hand can be accommodated.
- 6) Painter General : One upper and lower limb partially damaged.
- 7) Electrician :- Partially lower limb can be accommodated.
- 8) AC & Refrigeration :- Only one lower limb partially working can be accommodated.
Small finger of each hand damaged can be accommodated.
- 9) Mech. (MV) :- Upper limb partially damaged (Little finger & Ring finger) can be accommodated for both hands. Lower limb partially damaged only one side can be accommodated.
- 10) Carpenter :- One upper & lower limb partially damaged.
- 11) Mechanic Machine Tool Maintenance.:- with one lower limb partially damaged.

B) For Hearing Handicapped :-

1) Only deaf / dumb or deaf-mute.

2) Hearing Handicapped are not entitled in the trade of :-

i) Turner ii) Machinist iii) Mech. Machine Tool Maintenance.

Only Loco motor or Cerebral palsy having 40% or more in the relevant disability and Hearing Handicapped having loss of 60 decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequency are eligible to apply.

C) For Visual Handicapped :- (for Howrah only)

- 1) Total absence of sight or visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses or limitation of the field of vision subtending and angle of 20 degree or worse.
- 2) LOWER VISION :- person with low vision means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device. Provided also that the standard of fitness relating to eyes shall not apply in the case of a person with low vision(Low vision means a persons with impairment of vision of less than 6/18 to 6/60 with best correction in the better eye or impairment of field in any one of the following categories i) Reduction of field less than 50 degrees ii) Heminaopia with Macular involvement iii) Altitudinal defect involving lower fields) in the trade – i)FITTER ii)ELECTRICIAN.

A physically Handicapped person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation would have to submit a disability certificate issued by a competent authority. Physically Handicapped certificate issued by Govt. Hospital/ Medical board as per Para- 4 & 5 of the gazette extra ordinary published by the concerned authority dated 17.07.99 is to be enclosed with the application. Provided that standard of relaxation for persons having blindness or low vision for the trades of fitter & Electrician will be applicable as per extent rules. Provided also that standard of relaxation for person having loco motor disabilities/ Cerebral palsy will be applicable for the trades of fitter, Machinist, Welder, Mech.(Diesel),Painter & Electrician as per extent rules. Provided also that that standard of relaxation for persons having hearing impaired will be applicable for the trades of Fitter, Mech.(Diesel) & Electrician as per extent rules. (Medical Board duly constituted by the Central/State Govt. Hospital. The Central/State Govt. may constitute medical Board (S) consisting of at least three members out of which at least one shall be a specialist in the particular field for assessing Locomotor/Cerebral/Visual/Hearing Disability as the case may be.)

6. EX-SERVICEMEN :-

An Ex-serviceman candidate selected under the reservation provided for them is to be placed in the appropriate category viz. UR/SC/ST/OBC to which he belongs.

Reservation for Ex-serviceman , their children and children of Armed force personnel will be engaged for Apprenticeship as per details mentioned below :-

- a) Children of deceased /Disabled Ex-Servicemen including those killed/disabled during peace time.
- b) Children of Ex-Servicemen
- c) Children of Serving Jawans.
- D) Children of Serving Officer
- e) Ex-Servicemen.

7. AGE: -

- (i) The candidates should have completed 15 years of age and should not have completed 24 years of age **as on 01.07.2017 i.e. should not born earlier than 02.07.1993 and not later than 01.07.2002.**
- (ii) Upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in case of SC/ST Candidates. **i.e. should not born earlier than 02.07.1988 and not later than 01.07.2002.**
- (iii) Upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years in case of OBC candidates. **i.e. should not born earlier than 02.07.1990 and not later than 01.07.2002.**

- (iv) For Physically Handicapped Person : - Upper age limit is relaxable by 10 years for UR / for SC&ST 15 years and 13 years for OBC. i.e. **should not born as follows: –**
UR – earlier than 02.07.1983 and not later than 01.07.2002.
SC/ST – earlier than 02.07.1978 and not later than 01.07.2002.
OBC – earlier than 02.07.1980 and not later than 01.07.2002.
- (v) The upper age limit is relaxable for ex-servicemen up to the extent of service rendered in defence forces plus 3 years maximum up to 40 years provided they have put in a minimum of 6 months service at a stretch. Ex-servicemen who have already joined the Govt. Service on Civil side after availing of other benefits given to them as ex-servicemen for further employment can not claim ex-servicemen status for the purpose of their engagement. Such a person will be deemed to be Civil employee and will accordingly be entitled to only such of the benefits like relaxation of age etc. as admissible to Civil employees in the normal course in accordance with existing instructions in this regard subject to his fulfillment of conditions governing the grant of such benefits. They are required to attach a certificate issued by Military Authority indicating their date of enrolment and date of discharge. Ex-servicemen are required to clearly indicate all required particulars including Community in the application form and enclose all documentary proof including Community Certificate in the Prescribed Format as required. However, regardless of Community, Ex-servicemen will be considered against the Ex-servicemen Quota, if available. If UR vacancies are not available then only Ex-servicemen belonging to those particular Communities where vacancies are available will be considered against the Ex-servicemen Quota.

8. QUALIFICATION :-

Matriculation (Matriculate or 10th Class in 10+2 examination system) with minimum 50% marks excluding OPTIONAL/ADDITIONAL SUBJECT and having I.T.I. certificate affiliated to NCVT compulsory in relevant trade. Both side copies of all certificates viz. proof of date of birth, educational/technical Qualification Certificate, Caste Certificate , PH Certificate , Ex-serviceman certificate etc. **duly attested by a Gazetted Officer of Central or State Govt. and must bear office seal and name of attesting officer to be attached .**

Training Period : As per directives of RDAT/Kolkata.

STIPEND will be paid as per extant rules.

9. HOW TO APPLY :-

The Application form & Call Letter as per attached format must be submitted in foolscap paper /A4 size duly filled in all the columns in all respect by the candidate himself in his own hand writing with ball point pen **to be addressed to Workshop Personnel Officer, Eastern Railway, Liluah, Howrah – 711 204 in closed envelope super-scribed as “Application for Liluah Workshop” or “Application for Howrah Division”** against Notice No. 01/2017/LLH dated 27.10.17 for engagement of Act Apprentices by enclosing the following :-

- (i) 2 Self-addressed envelope of 11" X 5" with Postal Stamp of Rs. 5/- (Exemption for SC/ST/PH Candidates).
- (ii) **A Crossed Postal Order in favour of F.A. & C.A.O., Eastern Railway, Kolkata payable to GPO/Kolkata for Rs. 100/- as a processing fee which is not refundable/transferable under any circumstances (The Postal Order purchased before the date of publication of this notice will not be valid).**
- (iii) No Postal Order is required for SC/ST , PHP, Women, Minorities & Economically backward candidates as per extant rules.
- (iv) Self declaration for waiver of fee for Minority candidates to be submitted as per Annexure- 'A' and Proforma for Income Certificate for Economically Backward classes to be submitted as per Annexure- 'B'.
- (v) 2 recent Passport Size **Photographs duly signed by the applicant**, one of which should be pasted on Application Form in the space provided for and the another should be pasted on the **CALL LETTER-CUM-ADMIT CARD** in the space provided. Both the photographs are required to be attested by Gazetted Officer.

- (vi) Before applying, the candidates should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility and other criteria, and if erroneously engaged, such candidates shall be summarily dismissed without notice at any stage of engagement.
- (vii) All columns should be filled up properly . No column should be left blank otherwise the candidature will be cancelled. **Application having Blurred LTI will be cancelled.**

10. Regarding Creamy layer Certificate :-

- a. Current Creamy layer certificate from OBC candidates : The OBC candidates should also enclose attested photocopy of current creamy layer certificate for the Govt. of India issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format for Central Govt. Service which is of **preceding one year .**
- b. The Competent Authorities for issue of Creamy layer certificate and SC/ST/OBC are :**

Deputy Commissioner / Dy.Collector / 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate / Sub-Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate /Executive Magistrate /Extra Asstt. Commissioner (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate)
 - ii. Chief Presidency Magistrate / Addl.Chief Presidency Magistrate /Presidency Magistrate.
 - iii. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar .
 - iv. Sub-Divisional officer of the area where the candidate and / or his / her family resides.
- c. In case of SC/ST/OBC Candidate, certificate from the appropriate / competent authority authorized to issue should be submitted in the format prescribed by the Govt. of India (Annexure-'C' for SC/ST, Annexure-'D' for OBC) with due attestation from Gazetted officer.

- 12. - 13. Name and address of the candidates should be legibly filled on the CALL LETTER with a recent passport size photograph of the candidate duly signed and attested by a Gazetted Officer affixed on the space provided in the format of the CALL LETTER as per specimen enclosed. The Call Letter should be sent along with the application form.**
- 14. No column of the application form should be left blank or Incomplete application or over writing/erasing in the application or without IPO (where applicable) or not supported by attested copies of certificates, improper caste certificate. improper PH certificate , improper Ex. Servicemen certificate, improper Creamy layer certificate or without L.T.I. OR Blured L.T.I etc. will be rejected.**
- 15. If it is noticed by the Railway Administration that the applicant have furnished wrong information/fake certificates, the Railway administration reserves the right to discharge the candidate/selected candidate at any stage without notice and to recover the stipend amount paid to them under the provisions of Indemnity Bond without prior information. FIR will be lodged for submitting false / forged certificates & for furnishing wrong/false information's or documents in support of their consideration .**
- 16. The Railway administration do not undertake any responsibility for sending reply to the candidates not selected or not called for . No correspondence in regard to the application shall be entertained to any individual or organization.**

17. 24. Mode of selection :-

- a) Engagement of Act Apprentices will be done only on the basis of marks obtained in the Matriculation Examination or 10th Class in the 10+2 Examination system and minimum marks of eligibility shall be kept at 50% in aggregate (**Excluding OPTIONAL/ADDITIONAL SUBJECT**)and having I.T.I. pass Certificate is compulsory. No extra weight age shall be granted to candidates having higher education.

Candidates equal to 1.25 times of the number of slots for Act Apprentices shall be called for verification of original testimonials and their physical fitness.
- b) A final merit list will be prepared equal to the number of slots in the descending order of percentage of marks obtained by the candidate in the Matriculate/10th Class in 10+2 Examination system separately for Liluah and Howrah.
- c) Candidates finally enlisted should be engaged subject to found fit in appropriate Medical Examination by Railways as applicable for the Workshop and for the Howrah Division.

- d) No daily allowance/conveyance allowances or traveling allowance will be paid to the candidate who will be called for verification.
 - e) No Hostel accommodation will be provided and selected candidates will have to make their own arrangement during their training as per Apprentice Act, 1961 and they will be released on completion of the training.
- 25. This training is being given under statutory obligation of the Apprentice Act-1961. After passing the course of Act Apprentice there will be “NO GUARANTEE FOR THEIR EMPLOYMENT ON THE RAILWAY”.**
- 26.** Agreement of Training : - Before commencement of the Apprenticeship training in the designated trade, the selected candidate or, if he is a minor, his guardian has to enter into a contract of apprenticeship with the employer.
- 27.** Medical Fitness : - Selected candidates will be engaged in the Apprenticeship subject to the Medical Fitness to be certified by a Railway Doctor.
- 28.** The decision of the administration in regards to acceptance or otherwise of any application even without assigning any reason or in regard to selection of the candidates & their training will be final.
