A good essay comprises of three parts, namely *Introduction*, *Essay Body* and *Conclusion*. Let's talk about them one by one.

Format for Essay Writing - Introduction

- The introductory paragraph sets the most crucial impact on a reader's mind, always chose a provocative topic.
- Be very creative while writing the introductory para, try to infuse quotations by famous writers, it will help you sail through the topic easily.
- The introduction has great influence on a reader's mind so put all your central ideas but do not explain them.

Format for Essay Writing - Essay Body

- Divide all your viewpoints, opinions and arguments into paragraphs, in a way that each
 just flows into the other.
- Do not hesitate to state any real-life experiences or any research about quotes, names in your essay body.
- It is advisable to divide your essay in 3 paragraph, but it entirely depends on the complexity of the topic.

1st Paragraph - include the strongest points you have.

2nd Paragraph - state all less strong points.

3rd Paragraph - involve all the weakest arguments.

- Do not start writing without having an exact plan, make the outline beforehand to not beat around the bush while writing.
- The Essay body should take the largest amount of your essay.

Format for Essay Writing - Conclusion

- Finalise all your opinions in the last paragraph.
- Bring in your central idea back, this way you will let your reader know you are wrapping up.

⇒ Tips on Essay Writing - SSC MTS Descriptive Test 2017

- 1. Just read! This might sound clich out it is exactly what is going to help.
- 2. Enhance your vocabulary. This will save you from making unnecessary long sentences.
- 3. Make writing a daily part of your life and gradually writing an essay or a letter will not be a task for you.
- 4. Read grammar rules, making grammatical error takes away the charm from your essay.
- 5. The content of your essay should be lined up evenly at the left margin.
