- **Urdu as 2nd Official Language: Telangana**
 - Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrashekhar Rao declared Urdu as the state's second official language.

- **ATP World Tour Awards 2017**

- **National Education Day 2017**
 - National Education Day is an annual observance in India to commemorate the birth anniversary of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad.
 - He was the first education minister of independent India, who served from 15 August 1947 until 2 February 1958.
 - National Education Day of India is celebrated on 11 November every year.
- **National Entrepreneurship Awards 2017**
 - The Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship hosted the National Entrepreneurship Awards 2017 marking the completion of three years of its inception.
 - NEA was instituted by MSDE in 2016 to encourage entrepreneurship in India.
 - Winners were given a cash award of Rs 5 lakh (enterprises and individuals) and Rs. 10 lakhs (organizations/institutes) along with a certificate and trophy.
- **UNHCR to get Mother Teresa Award 2017**
 - UNHRC was named as the recipient of the Mother Teresa Memorial Award for Social Justice, 2017 as an acknowledgment of its exceptional work worldwide.
 - The UNHCR provides humanitarian aid to innumerable people internally displaced by conflicts and helping stateless people all over the world.
 - Mother Teresa Memorial Award for Social Justice was instituted by Harmony Foundation in 2005.
- **SEBI imposes fine on Gujarat CM family**
 - SEBI has penalised 22 entities for involvement in manipulative trading.

- One of these 22 entities is Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani's Hindu Undivided Family (HUF) that was found to be involved in manipulative trading through a listed firm called Sarang Chemicals.
- Mr. Rupani's firm has been asked to pay a Rs 15 lakh fine within 45 days.
- **Banking Services at home for 70+ people**
 - Reserve Bank of India has asked banks to provide doorstep banking facilities to senior citizens of more than 70 years of age and differently-abled persons including the visually-impaired.
 - The facilities include basic banking services like pick-up of cash, delivery of demand drafts, chequebooks and submission of KYC documents.
 - These instruction are to be implemented by December 31, 2017.
- **New outsourcing norms for NBFC**
 - RBI issued a notification outlining norms for outsourcing of functions by Non-Bank Financial Institution.
 - As per the new norms, NBFCs cannot outsource core management functions like internal audit, management of investment portfolio, strategic and compliance functions for know your customer norms and sanction of loans.
 - All NBFCs' have been directed to set up a grievance redressal machinery.
- **Government triples home loan limit**
 - The government raised the maximum amount that a central government employee can borrow from the government to Rs 25 lakh for new construction/purchase of new house.
 - The limit for home loan borrowing has been tripled for central government employees as per the 7th pay commission recommendations.
 - Earlier this limit was only Rs 7.50 lakh. This move is going to benefit about 50 lakh employees.

- **IFAD approves funds for NE project**

- International Fund for Agriculture Development has approved a USD 30 million soft loans for the fourth phase of the North Eastern Region Community Resource Management Project.
- IFAD is an international financial institution and an agency of the United Nations.
- NERCORMP is a livelihood and rural development project aimed to transform the lives of the poor and marginalized tribal families.

- **Haryana to treat Hepatitis-C by oral med**

- Haryana has become the first state in the country to treat Hepatitis-C patients of all categories through oral medicine.
- For the first time, the state government has included oral medicine in government hospitals.
- This medicine would be provided free of cost to permanent residents of all categories at the district level.

- **India Disaster Response Summit in Delhi**

- Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Kiren Rijiju inaugurated 'India Disaster Response Summit' in New Delhi.
- India has become the first country to partner with Facebook on disaster response.
- Facebook introduced a Disaster Information Volunteers programme. Under DIV, a network of trained volunteers would provide supplementary information on disasters in their local communities.

- **Panel for air pollution in Delhi**

- As Delhi's air is turning toxic over recent weeks and reaching crisis levels, the Centre stepped in and decided to set up a 7-member-committee.
- The committee will be under chairmanship of CK Mishra.

- The committee formed by the environment ministry will look to formulate short-term and long-term plans.
- **Second Economic Advisory Council meeting**
 - The 2nd meeting of the Economic Advisory Council to PM Modi spelt out a clear road map towards skill development, job creation; enhanced resource investment in the social sector.
 - The meeting was chaired by Bibek Debroy.
 - Economic Advisory Council to the PM is a non-constitutional, non-permanent and independent body constituted to give economic advice to the GoI, specifically the PM.
- **23rd GST Council Meet held in Guwahati**
 - 23rd meeting of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Council headed by Union Finance Minister, Arun Jaitley was held in Guwahati, Assam on November 10, 2017.
 - GST rate on 177 items has been reduced from 28% to 18%. Now only 50 items, mostly demerit, sin and luxury goods will attract 28% GST rate.
 - Goods and Services Tax (GST) was rolled out from July 1.
- **Linking Aadhaar with insurance policy**
 - IRDA has announced that linking of Aadhaar number to insurance policies is now a mandatory requirement under Prevention of Money-laundering Second Amendment Rules, 2017.
 - This norm of linking Aadhaar number to insurance policies will apply to new customers as well as existing policyholders.
 - Besides, it will apply not only to life insurance policies but also to general insurance policies.

- Indian delegation to IEA Ministerial Meeting, Paris was led by Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Power and New & Renewable Energy, Raj Kumar Singh.

- **Bengaluru outranks San Francisco**

- Bengaluru has been adjudged as the best city among 45 cities for the confidence of its businesses in their ability to go digital.
- The other two cities followed by it are Mumbai and New Delhi.
- The survey was conducted by Economist Intelligence Unit(EIU).
- EIU conducted this survey in partnership with telecommunications firm Telstra Corp.

- **Prannoy emerges as New National Champion**

- HS Prannoy defeated Kidambi Srikanth in the finale to claim the men's singles title at the 82nd Senior National Championship.
