- 7th Int. Coffee Festival in Bengaluru
  - The seventh edition of the India International Coffee Festival (IICF) will be held in Bengaluru from January 16-19.
  - The four-day IICF 2018 is being organized by the India Coffee Trust and
     State-run Coffee Board to promote the Indian coffees globally.
  - IICF 2018 would be a precursor to the International Coffee Organisation's
     World Coffee Conference being hosted by India in Bengaluru in 2020.
- India to set up IT centre in Egypt
  - India will be establishing a Centre of Excellence in Information Technology (CEIT) at Al Azhar University.
  - It is Egypt's highest religious authority and one of the world's most eminent seats of Sunni Muslim learning.
  - $\circ\quad$  Cairo is the capital of Egypt and Abdel Fattah el-Sisi is its president.

### New species of scorpions discovered

- Tripura has identified a new species of scorpions in Tripura's Trishna
   Wildlife Sanctuary.
- o The Schaller's wood scorpion has large and powerful pincers.
- The study was published in Zootaxa, an international journal devoted to new species descriptions. Mr. Mirza discovered them.
- He named the new species Liocheles schalleri in honour of celebrated wildlife biologist George Schaller.

#### · Book on Gauri Lankesh's writings

- A book containing selected writings by late journalist Gauri Lankesh was launched at the Mumbai Press Club.
- The book named "The Way I See It" has been edited by writer and sociologist Chandan Gowda.
- The six sections of the book comprise Lankesh's early reportage in various publications and selected articles.
- 3 months ago Gauri was gunned down outside her home by unidentified men.

#### Package for paddy farmers: Maharashtra

- Maharashtra government announced a financial package to help paddy and cotton farmers whose crops have been damaged because of pests.
- Farmers cultivating paddy will be provided with Rs 7,970 per hectare compensation for non-irrigated land. Farmers who have irrigated land would get Rs 14,670 per hectare.
- The compensation will be allowed upto two hectares.

## • Bengali Singer Jatileswar Passes Away

- Acclaimed Bengali singer Jatileswar Mukhopadhyay passed away in Kolkata following a prolonged illness. He was 82.
- The West Bengal government had conferred him with the Sangeet Samman award in 2012.

#### MEA Launches 'SAMEEP' Policy

- Under this MEA officials will talk to students to help them better understand foreign policy.
- The main objective of SAMEEP is to take Indian foreign policy and its global engagements to students across the country.

#### BPCL SBI Card launched

- SBI Card and Bharat Petroleum has announced the launch of the BPCL
   SBI Card the most rewarding fuel co-branded credit card in the country.
- The BPCL SBI Card will offer up to 70 litres of free fuel per year to cardholders.
- Cardholders can earn rewards and save on fuel at 14000 Bharat Petroleum fuel stations across the country. It has been launched on the Visa platform.

#### Quikr acquires HDFC's Units

- HDFC has sold its realty brokerage business HDFC Realty and its digital real estate business HDFC Developers to Quikr.
- The all-stock deal will see HDFC pick up around 3.5% stake in Quikr for the two businesses, which have collectively been valued at about Rs 357 crore.
- o Aditya Puri is the CEO of HDFC, which is headquartered in Mumbai.

#### • MoU for Petrochemical park in Kochi

 A MoU for setting up a ₹ 1,800-crore petrochemical park in Kochi was inked by the Kerala government and 'FACT'.

- It will come up in 481 acres of land owned by the Fertilisers and Chemicals Travancore.
- The park was aimed at making Kochi, a hub in petrochemical production chain on par with Jurong in Singapore and industrial complexes in South Korea.

#### • Kisan Diwas - 23rd December

- Kisan Diwas (Farmer's Day) is observed every year on 23 December to celebrate the birth anniversary of the fifth prime minister, Chaudhary Charan Singh.
- A kisan leader, Late Chaudhary Charan Singh belonged to a peasant family.
- He also served as the Deputy PM during the reign of Morarji Desai. He
  introduced Budget 1979 which was designed to accomplish the needs of
  the farmers in all respects.

#### • UN imposes new sanctions on North Korea

- The UN Security Council unanimously approved tough new sanctions against North Korea.
- These sanctions are taken in response to its latest launch of a ballistic missile that Pyongyang says is capable of reaching anywhere on the US mainland.
- The resolution includes lower limits on North Korea's refined oil imports, the return home of all North Koreans working overseas within 24 months etc.

## • Peace Summit on Mandela's 100th b'day

- The UN General Assembly has decided to mark the 100th anniversary of Nelson Mandela's birth by holding a high-level meeting.
- Ther meeting will focus on world peace. In 2009, the General Assembly established "Nelson Mandela International Day" on July 18, the date he was born in 1981.

#### • Jerusalem no longer Israel's capital

- The U.N. General Assembly denounced President Donald Trump's recognition of Jerusalem as Israel's capital.
- The resolution reaffirmed what has been the United Nations' stand on the divided holy city since 1967- that Jerusalem's final status must be decided in direct negotiations between Israel and the Palestinians.
- o Benjamin Netanyahu is Israel's Prime Minister.

#### • Lt Gen B S Sahrawat becomes DG, NCC

- Lieutenant General B S Sahrawat became Director General of National Cadet Corps.
- He is an alumnus of the National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla and Indian Military Academy, Dehradun.
- He was commissioned in December 1980 in 13th Battalion (Rezang La),
   the Kumaon Regiment.
- He has been awarded the Sena Medal during the floods of Kosi River in Bihar in 2008.

#### • 'Blue Flag' Beach Project launched

- Ministry of Environment and Forests has launched a pilot project named
   "Blue Flag" for beach cleanup and development.
- The objective of the project is to enhance standards of cleanliness and upkeep basic amenities at beaches.
- Under the pilot programme, each of the coastal State/UT has identified a beach, to be funded through the ongoing Integrated Coastal Management Programme.

## Russia's Deputy PM Dmitry Visits India

o Russia's Deputy Prime Minister Dmitry Rogozin arrived in New Delhi.

- He will co-chair the meeting of India-Russia Inter-Governmental
   Commission on Trade, Economic, Scientific, Technological and Cultural
   Cooperation (IRIGC-TEC).
- The meeting will enable the two sides to review the progress achieved by various working groups and sub-groups under the IRIGC-TEC.

#### • Government Launched 'Ganga Gram' project

- The government had formally launched the 'Ganga Gram' project at the Ganga Gram Swachata Sammelan in New Delhi.
- o It is a part of clean Ganga mission.
- Namami Gange, the Ganga Gram project is an integrated approach for the holistic development of villages situated on the banks of the holy river with the active participation of villagers.

#### Vijay Rupani Remains Gujarat CM

- Vijay Rupani will continue as chief minister of Gujarat and Nitin Patel as his deputy chief minister.
- The BJP had won 99 seats, only seven more than it needed for a majority to form the government.
- The decision was taken at a meeting of all the newly-elected BJP MLAs and the announcement was made by union minister Arun Jaitley

## • Rohit equals fastest century record

- Indian cricket captain Rohit Sharma equalled David Miller's record for the fastest century in the shortest format of the game.
- He scored a 35-ball century against Sri Lanka in the second T20 international in Indore.
- David Miller had scored a century in 35 balls against Bangladesh in October this year.
