Important Current Affairs 2nd December 2017

- **33rd year of Bhopal gas tragedy**
 - The tragedy that struck the Bhopal city three decades ago occurred on the intervening night of December 2 and 3, 1984.
 - Even after 33 years, the victims of Bhopal gas tragedy are still complaining of not being provided with proper medical facilities, better living conditions and employment.
 - Also, the toxic waste lying in the defunct Union Carbide is yet to be disposed off.
- **Virat Kohli surpasses Brian Lara**
 - Virat Kohli's record 243 guided India to 536/7 against Sri Lanka on the second day of the third Test at the Feroz Shah Kotla Stadium in New Delhi.

- Kohli overtook West Indies great Brian Lara, who held the record previously with five double tons in Tests.
- Kohli resumed Day 2 of the third India-Sri Lanka Test on 156 and quickly reached his second double ton of the series.
- **Mehbooba Mufti re-elected PDP president**
 - Chief Minister Mehbooba Mufti was re-elected as the president of the Jammu and Kashmir People's Democratic Party (PDP) for the next three years.
 - She thanked party leaders for "reposting their trust and electing me as their president".
 - A law graduate, 57-year-old Mehbooba took the plunge into mainstream politics of the state in 1996 by joining the Congress, along with her father.
- **'Bandhan Tod' app for school girl**
 - Patna-based Gender Alliance, an initiative of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), had launched the Android-based app named 'Bandhan Tod'.
 - It is to sensitize people across the state against dowry, child marriage, domestic violence and gender inequality.
 - A Bihar girl, 13 years old, sent out a distress message through this app and was saved from becoming a victim of child marriage.
- **Int. Day for the Abolition of Slavery**
 - The United Nations' International Day for the Abolition of Slavery is annually held on December 2 to raise awareness of the atrocities of modern slavery.
 - The focus of this day is on eradicating contemporary forms of slavery, such as trafficking in persons, sexual exploitation etc.
 - It was first celebrated in 1986.
- **NASA fires up Voyager 1 thrusters**

- NASA told a set of thrusters aboard the Voyager 1 spacecraft, the only human-made object in interstellar space, have been successfully fired up after 37 years without use.
- The spacecraft has been using small devices called “attitude control thrusters” to orient itself so it can communicate with Earth.
- Voyager 1 and Voyager 2 were launched 16 days apart in 1977.
- **D K Sarraf appointed as PNGRB Chairman**
 - The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the appointment of D K Sarraf, as the new Chairman of the Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board.
 - An official statement said, that former Director (Operations), Oil India Ltd, S Rath, has also been appointed as a Member of the board, after replacing K K Jha.
 - Sarraf earlier worked in ONGC.
- **CBDT signs two Indian APAs**
 - The Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) has entered into 2 Bilateral Advance Pricing Agreements (APAs).
 - These Agreements are the first ever Bilateral APAs with The Netherlands.
 - With the signing of these Agreements, the total number of APAs entered into by the CBDT has gone up to 186. This includes 171 Unilateral APAs and 15 Bilateral APAs.
- **India gets Certificate of Commendation**
 - India was awarded the certificate of commendation for its effort to combat illegal wildlife trade by Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora.
 - The award was given to Wildlife Crime Control Bureau for its efforts in conducting and coordinating species-specific wildlife enforcement operation, codenamed ‘Operation Save Kurma’.
 - CITES was signed in 1973.

- **Mission SAMPARK launched**
 - The Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare launched the National Strategic Plan 2017-24 aimed at eradicating HIV/AIDS by 2030.
 - Mission SAMPARK was also launched to trace those who are left to Follow Up and are to be brought under Antiretroviral therapy services.
 - The National Strategic Plan 2017-24 will pave a roadmap not only for achieving the target of 90:90:90 Strategy.
- **Kapu reservation bill passed in Andhra**
 - The Andhra Pradesh assembly unanimously passed the Kapu reservation bill which will provide the community with a 5% quota in education and employment in the state.
 - However, Kapu quota if issued will take the total quota in the state to 55%, which is more than 50% limit restricted by the Supreme Court.
 - The Kapu community forms 27% of the population.
- **International Day for Disabled Person**
 - The annual observance of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities was proclaimed by the United Nations General Assembly resolution 47/3 in 1992
 - It aims to promote the rights and well-being of persons with disabilities in all spheres of society and development.
 - The theme for this year's IDPD is "Transformation towards sustainable and resilient society for all".
- **Award for Divyangjan Empowerment - 2017**
 - Shri Ram Nath Kovind will present the "National Award for Divyangjan Empowerment-2017" to Individuals, Institutions, Organisations for their outstanding achievements towards empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.

- The function will be organized by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment.
- The awards will be given on 3 Dec
- **Cyclone ‘OCKHI’ warning for Lakshadweep**
 - The very severe cyclonic storm ‘OCKHI’ over Lakshadweep area and adjoining Southeast Arabian Sea moved further west-northwestwards with a speed of 10 kmph during past 06 hours.
 - The system is very likely to weaken gradually.
 - It is very likely to continue to move northwestwards during next 24 hours and then recurve northeastwards during the subsequent 48 hours.
- **Shiva Keshavan Wins Gold**
 - The sole Indian participant and defending Asian champion Shiva Keshavan retained his title with a time of 55.60 seconds.
 - India's veteran Winter Olympian Shiva Keshavan won a gold medal at the Asian Luge Championships at Altenberg, Germany.
 - Due to technical reasons, the Asian Luge Championships took place at Altenberg in Germany.
- **India re-elected to IMO**
 - India has been re-elected to the Council of the International Maritime Organisation under a category that represents nations with the largest interests in international seaborne trade.
 - India was re-elected to the body under Category B at an assembly of the organization at its headquarters.
 - India secured the second-highest number of votes(144) from member-countries, just after Germany(146).

- 24-year-old model and Miss Korea Jenny Kim has bagged the title of Miss Supranational 2017 at the gala event, which was held in Poland's Spa Resort of Krynica- Zdroj.
- Miss Columbia Tica Martinez and Romania's Bianca Tirsin were adjudged First Runner's Up and the second runner-up in the event, respectively.
- India's official entry into the competition, Peden Ongmu Namgyal, reached top 25.
- **'Populism' Named Word of the Year**
 - The word 'populism' has been announced as Cambridge Dictionary's Word of the Year 2017.
 - The dictionary defined populism as "political ideas and activities that are intended to get the support of ordinary people by giving them what they want".
 - It said searches for 'populism' rose when Pope Francis made statements warning against its rising tide.
- **Surya Re-Appointed Prasar Bharati Chief**
 - Veteran journalist A Surya Prakash has been appointed the chairman of the Prasar Bharati board for a second consecutive term till February 8, 2020.
 - Information and broadcasting ministry issued an order after a panel headed by Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu recommended Prakash's name for the post.
 - His first term as the Chairman of Prasar Bharati had ended on October 28.
- **Infosys Appoints Parekh as MD & CEO**
 - Infosys announced the appointment of Salil S. Parekh as its new CEO and Managing Director.
 - Salil was in Capgemini earlier.
 - The Bengaluru-headquartered company was searching for a new CEO after former CEO Vishal Sikka resigned in August 2017.
