Important Current Affairs 5th December 2017

- Floating Solar Power Plant in Kerala
 - The largest-ever floating solar power plant in India has become operational in Kerala.
 - Constructed by Ad tech Systems, the plant will generate 7 lakh units of power in a year.
 - The unique feature of this plant is the anchoring mechanism used by the overwhelming technology to maintain the plant with the alteration of the water level.
 - The total cost of the project is Rs. 9.25 crore.

• Google invests in Dunzo











- In its first direct investment in an Indian startup, Google has invested Rs
 65 cr in Dunzo, a hyper local concierge & delivery firm.
- The investment is part of Google's Next Billion Users push & will see the company lead a \$10-12 mn round.
- Dunzo offers services where customers can use its app to ask for errands such as fetching medicines or buying a cake, for a fee.

• Book on Indian cinema

- Bollywood superstar Amitabh Bachchan has launched a book based on Indian cinema in Mumbai.
- The book, titled 'Bollywood: The Films! The Songs! The Stars!' is Coauthored by S.M.M. Ausaja, Karan Bali, Rajesh Devraj and Tanul Thakur.
- It is a coffee table book, which provides historical insights & behind-thescene exclusives of the most iconic movies made in the history of Indian film industry.
- Google Maps introduces 'Motorcycle Mode'
 - Google has launched a new feature to its Maps application specially, for Indian users called, the Motorcycle Mode.
 - The feature will allow two-wheeler drivers the shortest or the most convenient route for their journey will also show the routes and ETA which are suited best for the bikers.
 - The app will also share details about road blockage or parking trouble near the destination.
- Google, Tata Trusts to create employment
 - Google is going to expand its Internet Saathi programme, run in partnership with Tata Trusts, to create digitally enabled livelihood opportunities for women.
 - The programme aims to facilitate digital literacy among women in rural India.













 Tata Trusts has set up FREND, which will help institutions to utilise services of Internet Saathis in the dissemination of information & services in rural areas.

• UAE & Saudi Arabia forms a new group

- UAE has announced that it has formed a new economic & partnership group with Saudi Arabia, separate from Gulf Cooperation Council.
- The announcement comes just hours ahead of a GCC meeting in Kuwait which is expected to focus on diplomatic crisis that has engulfed member-state Qatar.
- The announcement did not say whether any other Gulf Arab countries would be invited to join this new group.
- Shalabh Seth resigns
 - Shalabh Seth, CEO of Ola Fleet Technologies has resigned from the firm.
 - Seth is one of several high-profile executives hired by Ola over the past 3 years. Seth, a former CEO of brewer SabMiller India, had joined Ola in Jan.
 - OLA has been struggling to retain senior-level employees for a while now & Seth's resignation adds on to the long list of executives that have stepped down.

• ADB lends \$583mn for RPower's project

- Asian Development Bank has approved debt financing & partial risk guarantee of \$583mn to develop Reliance Power's 750MW power plant & LNG terminal project in Bangladesh.
- Energy from the power plant will be sold into country's electricity grid under a long-term power purchase agreement & will significantly improve energy infrastructure in Bangladesh.
- The total project cost is \$1bn (approx).

• 1st death anniversary of J. Jayalalithaa













- The first death anniversary of the late chief minister of Tamil Nadu and AIADMK General Secretary J Jayalalithaa is being observed in the state.
- Late Jayalalithaa has been hailed by many across the country as a towering leader with grit and a strong determination.
- She was a big name in the world of politics and also remained the unchallenged queen of Tamil cinema for nearly 30 years.
- Sharad Yadav and Ali Anwar disqualified
 - Rebel JD(U) MPs Sharad Yadav and Ali Anwar have been disqualified from the Rajya Sabha.
 - The JD(U) had sought their disqualification on the grounds that they had attended a rally of opposition parties in Patna in violation of its direction.
 - Yadav was elected to the House last year and his term was scheduled to end in 2022 while Anwar's term was to expire early next year.
- SC allows full enforcement on travel ban
 - The US Supreme Court has allowed Donald Trump's travel ban to take full effect pending appeal, for people coming from six Muslim-majority countries.
 - The travel ban is the third version of a contentious policy that Trump first sought to implement a week after taking office in January.
 - The ban applies to travelers from Chad, Iran, Libya, Somalia, Syria and Yemen.
- International Tourism Mart 2017 begins
 - $_{\odot}$ $\,$ The 6th International Tourism Mart has begun in Guwahati, Assam.
 - The 3 day program has been organized by Ministry of Tourism in association with all North Eastern states
 - It is being organised with an objective of highlighting the tourism potential of the region in the domestic & International markets
 - It will bring together the tourism business fraternity & entrepreneurs from the 8 NE States















• Kamala Harris tops global thinkers list

- Indian-American California senator Kamala Harris has topped the Foreign Policy magazine's 2017 list of '50 Leading Global Thinkers'.
- She topped the list for giving the Democratic Party hope in the era of President Donald Trump.
- Harris is the 1st ever Indian-American to be elected to US Senate. Seen as a potential Democratic presidential candidate, Harris is the only black woman in the Senate
- Syrian boy wins 'Children's Peace Prize'
 - Mohamad Al Jounde from Syria has been awarded the International Children's Peace Prize for his efforts to ensure rights of Syrian refugee children
 - Al Jounde set up a school together with his family in a Lebanese refugee camp that currently provides 200 children with education
 - He received the prize from Malala Yousafzai, who won the Nobel Peace Prize in 2014 for her work for children's rights
- Fed Bk launches saving a/c sans interest
 - Federal Bank has launched non-interest bearing savings account targeting those whose beliefs do not permit them to accept interest payment
 - While account holders will not earn any interest they will get a platinum debit card which will provide them lounge access in airports 8 times a year
 - Holders of this account will be eligible for Platinum RuPay card with daily transaction limit of 2 lakh

• New president of NRAI

- Rahul Singh, the founder, and CEO of The Beer Caf**é**has been appointed as president of the National Restaurant Association of India.
- He will replace Riyaaz Amlani, CEO & MD of Impresario Entertainment & Hospitality who resigned from his duties due to health reasons.













Rahul is the recipient of the TiECON 2014 Entrepreneurial award for excellence, Entrepreneur India 2015 award in F&B service.

• Paytm rolls out FASTag across India

- Paytm Payments Bank is rolling out Paytm FASTag across the India, with the govt mandating the use of FASTag on every new vehicle sold from Dec 1.
- The FASTags allow vehicles to pass through 380 toll plazas across India covering 55,000 km without having to stop.
- Each Paytm FASTtag is linked to a registered Paytm account to facilitate instant automatic deduction of toll charges.

• Fitch cuts full-year growth forecast

- Fitch Ratings has reduced the GDP growth forecast of India for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2018, to 6.7% from 6.9%.
- According to Fitch, growth has repeatedly been disappointing in recent quarters, although this has partly reflected one-off factors, including the demonetization and disruptions related to the implementation of GST.
- Fitch expects GDP growth to pick up in the next two years.

Shamli District Included in NCR

- Uttar Pradesh's Shamli district has been included in the national capital region, taking the total number of districts in the NCR to 23.
- The decision was taken at the 37th meeting of the National Capital Region
 Planning Board held in New Delhi.
- Besides Delhi, there are at present 22 districts- 13 of Haryana, seven of Uttar Pradesh and two of Rajasthan in the NCR.

• World Soil Day

 World Soil Day is celebrated annually on 5th of December at Food & Agriculture Organization of the UN headquarters in Rome, the regional offices and through national and local events.













- It aims to communicate messages on the importance of soil quality for food security, healthy ecosystems and human well-being.
- The Theme for this year Soil Day is 'Caring for Planet starts from the Ground'.
