 - Kanyashree is a targeted conditional cash transfer scheme aimed at retaining girls in schools and other educational and skill development institutions along with preventing child marriage.
 - The project was launched in 2011 and has helped more than 40 lakh female students in the state.

- Cristiano Ronaldo wins award
 - Real Madrid and Portugal forward Cristiano Ronaldo and Barcelona's Lieke Martens were named the UEFA Players of the Year 2017.
 - Lieke Martens was named UEFA Women's Player of the Year after leading the Netherlands to the 2017 Women's Euro title this summer on home soil.
 - The awards ceremony was held in Monaco
- Pogba wins Player of the Season award
 - Manchester United midfielder Paul Pogba has been named the Europa League Player of the Season for 2016-17.
 - Pogba was part of the United side that won the Europa League for the first time in the club's history with a 2-0 win over Ajax in May.

- Ronaldo wins UEFA Player of the Year
 - Cristiano Ronaldo has won his 3rd UEFA men's player of the year award in
 4 seasons, beating Lionel Messi and Gianluigi Buffon to get the trophy.
 - He is the first footballer to receive the honour thrice.
 - Ronaldo was the top scorer in the Champions League with 12 goals last season.
