

EMPLOYMENT NOTICE

Applications in prescribed format along with 2 passport size photographs are invited from eligible male and female candidates to fill up (a) 270 posts of GD Constables in Armed Battalions, (b) 60 posts of Women Constables, (c) 12 posts of Constables (Technical) in Communication Branch in the pay band of Rs 5200-20200 plus grade pay of Rs 2400 and other allowances as admissible under the rules in Sikkim Police. However, during the period of probation/Apprenticeship/Training, pay shall be governed by Notification No.459/GEN/DOP Dated 31/10/2011. The reservations for various categories are as under.

RESERVATION FOR SPORTSPERSONS & ARTISANS OF EXCELLENCE is as follows –

GD Constable: ST-1, OBC(CL)–1, SC – 1 and Primitive Tribe-1.

GD Constable(Women): OBC(CL)-1.

Note: The Sportsperson and Artisans of Excellence should fulfil the criteria mentioned in Office Memorandum No.3909/GEN/DOP Dated 29/11/2016.

RESERVATION FOR EX-SERVICEMEN is as follows-

GD Constable: UR-1, OBC(CL)–1, OBC(SL)-1, ST-1 and SC –1.

Constable (Technical): BL-1.

Note: Ex-Servicemen should provide discharge certificates from their concerned units.

In case of unavailability of sufficient number of women candidates for the posts reserved for them, the same will be filled up by men candidates belonging to the same reserved category. Similarly, in case HG candidates fulfilling the required standards are not available the posts will be filled up by open candidates.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS (for GD Constable):

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION – Minimum class X passed from recognized Board for open candidates as well as for HG candidates.

AGE – Not less than 18 years and not more than 22 years as on 1st February, 2018.

AGE RELAXATION: In addition to the age prescribed above the candidates will be given relaxation of 5 yrs. for BL/ST/SC/Primitive Tribe, 4 yrs. for OBC(CL) and 3 yrs. for OBC(SL).

Upper age limit for HG candidates are 32 yrs. for BL/ST/SC/Primitive Tribe, 31 yrs. for OBC(CL) and 30 yrs. for OBC(SL).

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS –

- (a) Height - 5'3" minimum for male
- 5' min. for female
- (b) Chest - 32" min. with min. 2" expansion for male.
- (c) Weight - 50 Kgs. min. for male
- 45 Kgs. min. for female

HG Candidates –

- (a) Should have enrolled not later than 1st February, 2015.
- (b) Should be in possession of an enrolment or discharge certificate issued by Dy. Commandant General, Home Guards.
- (c) Should not have been charged for offence (s) and punishment listed under 15 (2) of the Sikkim Home Guards Rules, 1993.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS (FOR Constables/Technical):

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION – Minimum class XII passed in PCM.

The Physical Requirements, Age and Age Relaxation are the same as required for GD Constable above.

EX-SERVICEMEN CANDIDATES shall be allowed to deduct the period of service rendered in Armed Forces from his actual age subject to his service (continuous) rendered in Armed Forces of the Indian Union is not less than 6 months and that he was not discharged or dismissed from the service on account of misconduct or inefficiency and is not a deserter.

The candidates fulfilling the above criteria and possessing the following documents may apply. However, **no photocopies** of the following documents except NOC at Sl. No. (f) below are required to be submitted at the time of application. All relevant documents in original will be scrutinized at the time of appointment. Any candidate filing false information on the application form shall be disqualified even if he/she is otherwise eligible for appointment.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED : (a) Sikkim Subject/COI, (b) Valid local employment card, (c) BL/ST/SC/OBC/BPL Certificate, (d) Educational qualification certificate/mark sheet, (e) Birth certificate, (f) NOC from Head of Department in case of Govt. servant.

PREScribed APPLICATION FORMS are available from 29/01/2018 and can be obtained from the office of the Deputy Inspector General of Police/Special Branch, Tadong, Gangtok and the office of District SsP (North/South/West) on working days till 28th February, 2018 on production of Bank (SBS) Receipt for Rs. 70/= under revenue head **0055-Police-800 other receipts**. ***The candidates must fill in application form with his/her own handwriting and affix his/her signature.***

Candidates may apply for more than one post and give their order of preference for the post. Final selection will be done on the basis of merit and post applied for. ***A candidate should get registered from one centre only. Multiple registrations will be detected by the computer system and, if found, the candidature will be cancelled forthwith.***

LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION: 28th February, 2018

SELECTION: The candidates are selected through the process of –

- (a) Physical Measurement,
- (b) Physical Efficiency/Endurance Test (PET),
- (c) Written Examination &
- (d) Viva-voce.

PHYSICAL TEST – DATES & VENUES: Physical Measurement & PET shall be held at the following places. The police bus ferry service will be made available for the candidates for Gangtok from Police Headquarters and for Pipaley from Jorethang PS.

Mangan (Namphrikdang Ground, Upper Dzongu) –19th March, 2018 from 8 am.

Pipaley (IRB Camp) –23rd and 24th March, 2018 from 8 am daily.

Gangtok (Khel Gaon, Reshithang) – 27th, 28th and 29th March, 2018 from 8 am daily.

WRITTEN TEST: Candidates who qualify in the physical measurement and PET shall be called for the written test which will be announced/notified separately. The detailed syllabus and distribution of marks can be had from the office of the Deputy Inspector General of Police/Special Branch, Tadong, Gangtok and District SsP or can be downloaded from www.sikkimpolice.nic.in.

VIVA-VOCE: Only those candidates who qualify in written test shall be called for viva-voce. The names of such candidates shall be displayed in PHQ, Gangtok and offices of respective District SsP.

MERIT LIST of HG candidates will be kept en-block below OPEN category candidates owing to their different minimum required qualification and separate syllabus for written examination. However, those willing to appear from open category may do so.

DEPLOYMENT: *The selected male candidates on completion of basic training shall be posed in **INDIA RESERVE BATTALION** and shall be liable to serve in any part of India.*

NB: No individual calling letters shall be issued and no TA/DA shall be paid for attending any phase of selection.
