### Har Gobind Khorana - An Introduction

**Mary Ann Evans** was born on **9th January 1922.** He is one of the main contributors who helped demonstrate how genetic information is translated into proteins. Being the youngest child of a village patwari (agricultural tax clerk), did not deter him from studying hard. Har Gobind Khorana had a great transformation from *a student, to professor, to researcher, to a Nobel Prize Winner*. His work has been an inspiration to many generations & will motivate many more!

• Har Gobind Khorana was born in Raipur, Punjab (now Pakistan).



- In year 1945, at the age of 23, Har Gobind Khorana went to University of Liverpool to complete his PhD with the help of Government of India Fellowship Programme.
- Once he completed his Ph.D., he went to Eidgenösische Technische Hochschule in Zurich to learn with a famous researcher, Prof. Vladimir Prelog.
- Soon after, he moved to Columbia University in New York, USA.
- Khorana married Esther Elizabeth Sibler in 1952. They had 3 children Julia Elizabeth, Emily Anne & Dave Roy.
- He died on 9 November 2011 in Massachusetts.

#### Har Gobind Khorana - Career & Work

- Khorana extensively worked in the field of **genetics and DNA**.
- During this period, he researched with Marshall W. Nirenberg and Robert
  W. Holley.
- They discovered that the order of nucleotides in our DNA determines
  which amino acids are built. These amino acids form proteins which carry out essential cell functions in the body.
- Khorana and his team had established that the mother of all codes, the biological language common to all living organisms, is spelled out in three-letter words: each set of three nucleotides codes for a specific amino acid.
- He later made a second scientific breakthrough when he **constructed the first synthetic gene**.
- Har Gobind Khorana became a citizen of America & was awarded with the National Medal of Science.

 He served as MIT's (Massachusetts Institute of Technology) Alfred P. Sloan Professor of Biology and Chemistry, Emeritus and was a member of the Board of Scientific Governors at the reputed Scripps Research Institute.

#### Har Gobind Khorana - Awards & Recognition

- The University of Wisconsin-Madison, the Government of India (Department of Biotechnology), and the Indo-US Science and Technology Forum had jointly created the **Khorana Program** in **2007**.
- The main motive of the Khorana Program was to build a seamless community of scientists, industrialists, and social entrepreneurs in the United States and in India.
- But, the biggest achievement for Har Gobind Khorana was the Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine that he shared with Marshall W.
   Nirenberg and Robert W. Holley in 1968.
