- India's first National Sports University is supposedly going to be named Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education.
- The National Sports University Ordinance will be on the lines of the National Sports University Bill which was introduced in the Lok Sabha in 2017.
- The University will be one of its kind, specializing in sports technology, sports management and sports coaching.
- It will also function as a National Sports Training Center applying the best International Practices.
- Rs. 100 Cr were allocated to it in the 2014-15 budget by PM Narendra Modi initially.
- 325.90 acres of land has been made available for setting up this University by the Government of Manipur in the west Imphal district of Koutruk.
- This University fills the void between the sports talent in India and the nurturing of that talent which is lacking.


Protest Against First National Sports University's Venue

On June 1st 2018 a group of students, who are allegedly, the members of DESAM (Democratic Students Alliance of Manipur) vandalized the offices of the Registrar and Dean of the National Sports University. They are protesting against the proposal to open several departments of the varsity in other states. The students claim that major departments are planned to be set up in other states while the National Sports University Office is to be set up in Imphal. DESAM President Akash Salam said "Interview notices had been published for recruiting persons at the Lucknow offices in

sports journalism, management and performances on June 11th 2018. We have been demanding location of these departments in Manipur." Chief Minister N. Biren Singh and Registrar K. Radhakumar have replied to these concerns stating that there are no plans to shift NSU anywhere else.
