Virus is a Microscopic particle which infect the body by creating replicas of their own in the cell of Organism. They are non-cellular Organisms. They doesn't belongs to the five kingdom classification. They Cause Infection in animals, plants, fungi and bacteria.

Bacteria

Bacteria, first life form of the earth, is a single celled Organism belongs to Monera Kingdom. They don't have Nucleus. They are very tiny and present in communities and reproduce themselves through Binary Fission. Bacteria plays important role in Nutrient Cycle.











Fungi is made up of many Fungus particles belongs to Kingdom Classification. Fungi is a Eukaryotic Organism. they get their food by eating organic substances. yeast, mushrooms, moulds these all belongs to Kingdom Fungi. Fungi is used to produce -Antibiotics, Wine, Beer, Bread, Biological Pesticides etc.




Tuberculosis - 2025 Leprosy - 2018 Measles and Rubella- 2020
