IBPS PO Preparations - Know the Exam Pattern

The Preliminary paper of **IBPS PO 2018** will have **three sections**.

- 1. **TEST CAN BE GIVEN IN TWO LANGUAGES:** Every section (except English Language) will be available in Hindi as well as in English.
- 2. **THERE IS SECTIONAL CUT-OFF:** Each section will have an individual cut-off. Besides this, there will be a minimum overall score that IBPS will decide after the results are tallied which you must cross to reach Mains.
- 3. <u>THERE WILL BE NEGATIVE MARKING</u>: Each wrong answer will deduct 0.25 of the marks assigned to that question from your total. In this case, since each question is worth 1 mark, you lose ¹/₂/₂ narks per wrong answer.

- Easy + More Weightage
 - In this group include topics of Simplification, Number System, Data Interpretation, Profit & Loss, Average, Percentage, Ratio & Proportion.
 - Practice these topics first.
 - Easy + Time Consuming
 - Include topics of Interest, Number Series, Problem on Ages, Quadratic & Linear Equations.
 - Practice these after the first group of questions are done.
- **Difficult + More** Weightage
 - Include topics on **Speed**, **Time and Distance**, **Mensuration**, **Data Sufficiency**.
 - Solve these after all the easy topics are done.
- Difficult + Time Consuming
 - Include topics on **Permutation & Combination / Probability, Mixtures & Alligations, Time and Work.**
 - Practice these in the end.
