Use in Sentence: The lawyer adumbrated the innocence of his client.

Aegis (*noun*)

Hindi translation: संरक्षण

Meaning: The protection or support of a particular person or organization.

Memory Tip: Aegis is enhancing protection.



Use in Sentence: For writers, pen is their aegis.

Affray (*noun*)

Hindi translation: शांति-भंग

Meaning: An instance of group fighting in a public place that disturbs the peace.

Memory Tip: Affray sounds like going astray and disturbing peace.



Use in Sentence: Sam organized an affray inside the jail.
