## **Important Current Affairs 30th October 2018**

- SC allowed States to fix 2 hour duration
  - The Supreme Court on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2018 modified its order fixing a slot of 8 pm to 10 pm for bursting firecrackers on Diwali.
  - SC said that the timing will be changed in places such as Tamil Nadu and Puducherry but not exceed two hours a day.
  - It also clarified that green crackers are mandatory only in the National Capital Region.
- Supreme Court bans old vehicles in NCR
  - The Supreme Court has prohibited the plying of 15-year-old petrol and 10year-old diesel vehicles in Delhi NCR due to the prevailing pollution situation.
  - Such vehicles would be impounded if found on the roads in Delhi-NCR.
  - SC directed that a list of 15-year-old petrol and 10-year-old diesel vehicles be published on the website of the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).
- National Summit on Public Health Care begins
  - The 5th 'National Summit on Good and Replicable Practices and Innovations in Public Health Care Systems in India' began at Kaziranga in Assam on 30 October 2018.
  - The summit was organised by the Union Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

- The objective of the summit is to share and learn the good practices being implemented by states and organisations for the betterment of the health sector.
- Justice Bist sworn in as Sikkim High Court CJ
  - Justice Vijai Kumar Bist was sworn in as the Chief Justice of Sikkim High Court on 30 October 2018.
  - Governor Ganga Prasad administered the oath of office to Justice Vijai Kumar Bist.
  - Bist was appointed as one of the judges in Uttarakhand High Court in November 2008.
- WWF's 'Living Planet' report released
  - World Wide Fund (WWF) has released a report titled 'The Living Planet'.
  - Australia's east coast has been compared to the Amazon as a "deforestation front" in the new global report.
  - The report said that global vertebrate populations are declining at a rate of 13.6% a decade.
  - The global populations of vertebrate species have declined 60% since 1970.
- First container movement on inland waterways
  - Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) transported container cargo belonging to food and beverage giant 'PepsiCo' from Kolkata to Varanasi (National Waterway-1).
  - This would be India's first container movement on the inland vessel.
  - The vessel, called MV RN Tagore will take 9-10 days to reach Varanasi.
  - National Waterway-1 runs from Haldia to Allahabad on river Ganga.
- Urdu writer Qazi Abdussattar passed away
  - Professor Qazi Abdussattar passed away on 29 October 2018.
  - He was a noted Urdu writer and former head of Aligarh Muslim University's Urdu department
  - He was awarded Padma Shri in 1974.
  - He was also the first recipient of Ghalib Academy Award in 1978.
  - His most famous short story 'Peetal Ka Ghanta' drew acclaim in the Urdu literary world.
- China-France launched oceanography satellite
  - China has launched an 'Oceanography Satellite' on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
  - The 'China-France Oceanography Satellite' (CFOSAT) is the first satellite jointly built by China and France.
  - The satellite will help scientists to predict dangerous cyclones and climate change by monitoring ocean surface winds and waves.
- India is Asia's most investment savvy economy
  - Standard Chartered has released a new study titled 'The Emerging Affluent Study 2018– Climbing the Prosperity Ladder'.
  - India has emerged as the most investment-savvy economy in Asia.











- More than two-thirds of India's affluent class prefer to use various investment products to achieve their financial goals and greater social mobility.
- EWDS system launched by Odisha CM
  - Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik launched the Early Warning Dissemination System (EWDS) and the mass message system.
  - EWDS was launched on the occasion of Odisha Disaster Preparedness Day, which is observed on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
  - The EWDS will warn the people residing along the coast in the state through the alert siren system from towers installed at 122 locations.
- Toxic air killed over 1 lakh children in India
  - The World Health Organisation (WHO) has released a report titled 'Air Pollution and Child Health: Prescribing Clean Air'.
  - Over 1.25 lakh children in India below the age of five died in 2016 due to the impact of polluted air.
  - The report said household air pollution from cooking and ambient air pollution caused more than 50% of acute lower respiratory infections in children under 5 years.

#### • Re-appointment of Aditya Puri as MD approved

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) approved the re-appointment of Aditya Puri as Managing Director of the HDFC bank for another two years.
- Aditya Puri has been with the bank since 1994, making him the longestserving head of any private bank in the country.
- Shareholders had already approved his appointment in 2015 for five years subject to the RBI's approval.

#### New telecom policy notified by government

- The government of India has notified the new telecom policy on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
- It has renamed the Telecom Commission as the 'Digital Communications Commission'.
- Under the new telecom policy, the government plans to optimally price spectrum, review levies such as license fees and spectrum usage charge.
- $\circ$   $\;$  Among the chief aims of the policy is data security of the country.
- Justice Naresh Patil sworn in as Bombay HC CJ
  - Justice Naresh Harishchandra Patil was sworn in as the Chief Justice of the Bombay High Court on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
  - He was administered the oath of office by Maharashtra Governor C Vidyasagar Rao.
  - Justice Naresh Patil had been serving as Acting Chief Justice of the Bombay High Court since 12<sup>th</sup> August 2018.
- India, Japan signed currency swap agreement

- India and Japan signed a currency swap agreement worth \$75 billion on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
- A currency swap involves the exchange of interest and sometimes of principal in one currency for the same in another currency.
- Interest payments are exchanged at fixed dates through the life of the contract.
- India's largest Dry Dock to come up at Cochin
  - Union Minister Nitin Gadkari laid the foundation for India's largest dry dock at Cochin Shipyard in Kerala on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
  - The dock will be able to build specialised and technologically advanced large vessels like LNG Carriers, drillships, jack-up rigs, large dredgers, and aircraft carriers for the Indian Navy.
  - <sup>o</sup> The project is expected to be completed by May 2021.
- Conference on Cyber Security organised
  - Defence Research and Development Organization (DRDO) organised a conference on Innovation in Cyberspace, Cyber Security - Challenges and Innovations on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
  - The conference focused on the current trends, need and future requirements of innovation in the field of cyber security.
  - The conference brought the stakeholders working in the area to showcase their innovations.
- India, Qatar to establish joint commission
  - India and Qatar decided to establish a Joint Commission (JC).
  - The JC will be co-chaired by the ministers of external affairs and foreign affairs of the two countries.
  - The JC will be tasked to strengthen the relations between the two countries particularly in the economic, commercial, cultural, scientific, technological, information technology and educational fields.
- Mega Food park inaugurated in Gujarat
  - Union Minister for Food Processing Industries Harsimrat Kaur Badal inaugurated the first Mega Food Park in Gujarat on 29<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
  - It is promoted by Gujarat Agro Infrastructure Mega Food Park Pvt. Ltd
  - The Park is located at Village Shah and Vasravi, District Surat, Gujarat.
  - A 2nd Mega Food Park has been sanctioned in Mehsana District of Gujarat.
- CSIR develops 'Less Polluting Firecrackers'
  - Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) have developed lesspolluting firecrackers.
  - The crackers have been named as Safe Water Releaser (SWAS), Safe Minimal Aluminium (SAFAL) and Safe Thermite Cracker (STAR).
  - It has a unique property of releasing water vapour and air as a dust suppressant and diluent for gaseous emissions.
