HSSC Group D Exam Pattern 2018

HSSC will select you for Group D post on the basis of score obtained in:

- 1. Written Exam
- 2. Socio-Economic Criteria and Experience

The marks distribution for the same is given in the table below.

- The Written Exam will either OMR Sheet based or Online Computer Based.
- There will be **no Interview** for this post.

Written exam holds 90 marks and the 'Socio-Economic Criteria and Experience' hold 10 marks for the HSSC group d exam. Let's take a look at the pattern of both.

1. Written Exam

HSSC written exam has these 2 parts:

2. Socio-Economic Criteria & Experience

Denotified Tribe	If you belong to a denotified tribe (Vimukt and Tapriwas Jatis) or Nomadic tribe of Haryana which are neither SC nor a Backward Class.	5 marks	
Experience	Minimum 6 months experience is mandatory. 0.5 marks for each additional year (max.16 years) in Haryana govt.	8 marks maximum
