### (15) Double Lineup

- Moderate to Difficult, Could be tricky, Moderate to Highly Time Consuming,
   Moderate Accuracy possible, Requires clean charting with proper technique and step-by-step solving.

#### (16) Scheduling

- Weightage: 0-5 Qs
- **Question Types:** Age based, Day based, Year based, Month based questions on Scheduling to be expected. Maximum one or two variables possible.


#### (17) Data Sufficiency
