


IBPS SO Reasoning - Weightage of Topics

Nonverbal and Verbal Reasoning

- In Verbal Reasoning, focus on the keywords used to identify the type of sentences in the question. Read this article to clear your doubts: <u>Tackling</u> <u>Verbal Reasoning</u>.
- In Nonverbal Reasoning, pay attention to the various patterns you see before you. Try giving this quiz for practice: **Quiz for Nonverbal Reasoning**.

Syllogisms

- Drawing Venn Diagrams is the best trick to avoid confusion between the categories mentioned in different statements.
- Read each question carefully and take one step at a time. This will help you avoid the overlapping of categories.
- Practice more questions related to this topic for accuracy.

Blood Relations

- This section can be aced if you once clear your basic concepts. Read these articles to completely understand this topic in one go: <u>General Understanding of</u> <u>Blood Relations</u> and <u>Understanding Complex Relations</u>.

Directions & Distances

- Always consider all eight directions before starting with any question.
- For simplicity, assume you are facing North.
- In rotation based questions, rotate the person in the clockwise or anticlockwise direction relative to the direction they were facing last according to the question.

Data Sufficiency

- Learn all the topics and first focus on your strengths before you move on to the challenging parts.


Practice is the Key
