The dates for <u>IB Security Assistant</u> General Awareness exam are yet to be announced. The exam takes place in 3 stages, Tier I (Objective Test), Tier II (Descriptive + Spoken Ability) and final round of Interview/Personality Test. There are four sections in Tier I (objective test) exam viz. English Language, Quantitative Aptitude, Reasoning Ability and General Awareness.

General Awareness section is often kept for last minute preparation which adds up to the confusion. Proper and timely preparation for IB Security Assistant General Awareness exam, can add up to a good score in fewer efforts and hence increase your total score in the exam.  - Focus more on events related to the field of banking and economy, sports, newly elected people etc.
- 2. Read books and take quizzes:
 - Try scanning the books that cover all the current affairs information, for example Pratiyogita Darpan and Manorama.

- 3. Read Daily Current Affairs Compiled:
 - Rather than mugging chunks of information, go for news that is compiled in short sentences, preferably one liners.
