Since Reasoning section is generally the toughest for students, you should attempt solving maximum questions in the time you have been given. More than any other subject, it is crucial to start preparations early for Reasoning. This is because Reasoning questions are tricky and complicated.

Topic-Wise Preparation Tips of SSC Stenographer Reasoning

Classification

- You need to have a great vocabulary to easily identify all the words given in the question.
- Paying attention to the words is necessary.
- Give a quiz related to Classification here: **Quiz 1 for Classification** and **Quiz 2 for Classification**.

Analogy

- Analogy involves comparing to infer similarity.
- Go through the various questions to identify the relationship between two elements by using their similar aspects.
- Make sure you give enough time to each question because the elements are tricky and do not involve straightforward elements.

Coding Decoding

- Check the alphabets and numbers you have in the code properly.
- Try to find whether the codes follow an ascending or descending sequence.
- Figure out if there are any rules or patterns that these alphabetical or numerical elements work on.

Directions & Distances

- Always consider all eight directions before solving any question.
- For simplicity, assume you are facing North.
- In rotation based questions, rotate the person in the clockwise or anticlockwise direction relative to the direction they were facing last according to the question.
