Reasoning is a section where you can score very good marks if you play well with the questions that will be asked. You just have to keep one thing in mind i.e. be very selective in choosing question you have to attempt first so that you can attempt more number of questions in the given time period. All you need is to learn a couple of tricks and practice different types of questions.

South Indian Bank PO Reasoning - Weightage for Topics

If you understand the weightage given to each topic, you can systematically categorize between topics you need to focus on for more score. Additionally, this will also help you to improve those topics which have more weightage so that you score well in the exam.

Inequalities

- In Inequalities, know the basic rule of signs.
- Clear your concepts and don't get confused in the 'Definite' & 'Either-Or' Case.

Syllogisms

- This is one of the topic which will fetch you easy marks in less time duration.
- Be very clear with the proper understanding of this topic.
- Read the instructions given in the Exam for this topic carefully as they sometimes play with which conclusion will follow & which will not follow.

Coding & Decoding

- This is a section where frequent changes in the pattern of questions has been seen in recent times specially in SBI PO & IBPS PO.
- You need to have acquaintance with all types of question that have been asked recently.
- It is quite possible that SIB will follow the old pattern of questions. You can check that pattern in **Shortcut to Solve Coding Decoding.**
- Look for a pattern closely that the question might follow. This will give you definite answers as questions asked will be on same pattern.

Seating Arrangement (Circular, Row & Square)

- This topic has maximum weightage & You can expect 5-10 questions for sure.
- Generally seating arrangement has three types i.e. Circular, Square And Row. Row arrangement further has two sub-types Single Row & Parallel Row. Because





there are no specific tricks and shortcuts for these type of questions, you need to practice a lot.

Order & Ranking
