- HAL's Helicopter clears 6-km flight test
 - o The multi-purpose Light Utility Helicopter (LUH) that is under development has achieved an important milestone of flying at 6 km altitude on 10 December 2018.
 - LUH has been created by Hindustan Aeronautics Limited.
 - The LUH is being designed and developed by HAL's Rotary Wing Research and Design Centre to replace the aged Cheetah and Chetak helicopters of the Armed Forces.

- The DSRV can be operated at a depth of 650 meters and can hold around
 15 people.
