Important Current Affairs 10th December 2018

- India to remain at top position in remittances
 - According to the World Bank's Migration and Development Brief, India
 will retain its position as the world's top recipient of remittances in 2018.
 - o India received US\$80 billion as remittances from its diaspora.
 - India is followed by China (US\$67 billion), Mexico and the Philippines
 (US\$34 billion each) and Egypt (US\$26 billion).

'Nishidhi' stone inscription found









- A 'Nishidhi' stone inscription from the 12th century was found at 'Nandi Basaveshwara temple' in Harakere village in Karnataka.
- R. Shejeshwara, Assistant Director, Department of Archeology, Heritage and Museums, and Jagadeesh, historian, discovered the inscription in Harakere village.
- Nishidhi stone inscriptions are issued to commemorate Jain ascetics who perform Sallekhana vratha.

· Historian Mushirul Hasan passed away

- Historian Mushirul Hasan, a noted historian, passed away on 10
 December 2018.
- He has extensively written on India's Partition.
- He was the Vice-Chancellor of the Jamia Millia Islamia University.
- He has also served as the Director-General of the National Archives of India, and the President of the Indian History Congress.

Current account deficit widens to 2.9% in Q2

- According to the Reserve Bank of India, the Current Account Deficit (CAD)
 widened to 2.9% of GDP for the July-September quarter.
- o The deficit for the second quarter was \$19.1 billion.
- o The CAD for the April-June quarter was 2.4% of GDP or \$15.9 billion.
- The widening of CAD on a year-on-year basis was primarily on account of a higher trade deficit at \$50 billion.

• SEBI to relax listing norms for start-ups

- SEBI has proposed few relaxations for new-age ventures in sectors like ecommerce, data analytics and biotechnology.
- The proposed relaxation will help startups to raise funds and get their shares traded on stock exchanges.
- The proposed changes also include renaming the 'Institutional Trading Platform' that the regulator had created for such listings as 'Innovators Growth Platform'.

• AIIB cleared \$400-m loan for Andhra Pradesh

The board of Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) approved a
 \$400-million loan for a water sanitation project in Andhra Pradesh.











- This project will increase access to safe drinking water and support the
 Government of Andhra Pradesh in addressing water supply and sanitation.
- The project will also reduce health risks and health expenditures for women in Andhra Pradesh.

India's first underwater museum to be opened

- o India is set to get its first underwater museum off the Puducherry coast.
- INS Cuddalore, a minesweeper decommissioned in March 2018, will be turned into a museum.
- The minesweeper will be deployed in the seabed 7 km off Puducherry coast.
- The vessel will be a popular destination for scuba diving and snorkelling.
- This will also improve marine biodiversity and the fishing industry.

- Kannur International Airport in Kerala was inaugurated on 9 December 2018.
- The Kannur airport has been built on a Public-Private Partnership (PPP)
 mode.
- With the commissioning of the Kannur airport, Kerala has become the first in the country to have four international airports.
- The other three international airports in Kerala are in Thiruvananthapuram, Kochi and Kozhikode.

- o Itanagar is the capital of Arunachal Pradesh.
- o Pema Khandu is the Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh.

Government notifies medical devices as drugs





- The government of India notified commonly used medical devices like nebulizers, blood pressure monitors, digital thermometers, and glucometers as 'drugs' under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act.
- o It will enable the government to ensure their quality and performance.
- The Drug Controller General of India (DCGI) will regulate the import,
 manufacture and sale of these devices from January 2020.

Vanessa Leon won 'Miss World 2018' crown

- Mexico's Vanessa Ponce de Leon won the coveted 'Miss World 2018' crown on 8 December 2018.
- She is a volunteer for 'Migrantes en el Camino' and is on the board of directors of a rehab centre for girls.
- Thailand's Nicolene Pichapa Limsnukan was declared the runner-up.
- Miss Belarus Maria Vasilevich, Miss Jamaica Kadijah Robinson, and Miss Uganda Quiin Abenakyo were also among the final five.

• Ex 'Indra Navy 2018' commenced

- Indian Navy and Russian Federation Navy will hold the maritime exercise
 'Indra Navy 2018' from 9 to 16 December 2018.
- o The exercise will be conducted at Visakhapatnam.
- The aim of the exercise is to increase interoperability amongst the two navies and develop common understanding and procedures for maritime security operations.
- The first 'Indra Navy' exercise was held in 2003.

- Indian Air Force and Russian Federation Aerospace Force (RFSAF) will hold exercise 'Aviaindra 2018' at Air Force Station Jodhpur from 10 to 21 December 2018.
- The first exercise 'Aviaindra' was held in 2014.
- The aim of the exercise is focused on anti-terrorist operations.
- o The exercise is unique wherein the RFSAF will not bring its air assets.
