



Symbols and Meaning






Typography Company Font Styling


Most Blazed websites import the fonts: Hind Vavodara <u>(Google</u> <u>Fonts)</u> and DM Serif <u>(Google Fonts)</u>.

The sans-serif font (Hind-V) should be used far more frequently than the serif font (DM). Pertaining to DM only, either the "Display" or "Text" family of DM Serif can be used.

Font size should be readable for target audience, but using size exceedingly sparingly, the developer should use font size to communicate which level of heading is used and thus the relative importance of the body of text which they precede.

If being published in a website, the fonts should be imported (using an @import statement) before any other CSS is parsed for the page, it should be the very first CSS rule.
