Andrea Jadi Nemeth is a Hungarian attorney with dual licenses for Hungary and New York, USA. She is a senior lecturer at Corvinus University and co-founder of the regional legal alliance, bpv LEGAL. Dóra was recognized by Index, 444, Marie Claire and was also on Instyle Magazine's "50 Most Inspiring Women" List in 2020.
