

RJ Vinedos Reunion Torrontes 2016

This sustainably farmed, single vineyard wine is composed of 100% hand harvested grapes from the Calchaquías Valley in Cafayate, Salta. Reunión Torrontes is fresh and lively on the palate with intense flavors of rose, jasmine, orange blossom, and peach that lead to a light, delicate, floral finish.

RJ Vinedos is a family owned winery run by its founder, Raul Joffre, and his four daughters. The winery began in 1996 when Raul purchased and refurbished a traditional cement tank winery in the Perdriel region of Lujan de Cuyo and a small vineyard in the Los Sauces region of the Uco Valley. They now have 60 hectares in the Uco Valley as well as holdings in Alto Agrelo and up north in the Calchaquías Valley, Salta. Their vineyards are sustainably farmed, and no chemicals are used in either the vineyards or the winery. Winemaker Sebastián San Martín has a minimalistic approach. He believes in letting the grapes have their own voice and looks for purity of fruit with little intervention. They produce the Reunion and MDZ wines as well as a series of reserve wines.
