Fall

As summer turns to fall, the air grows crisp. The days grow shorter, and night lasts longer.

During the fall season, trees get less water. Oak trees need to save water to start the growth of buds for spring. The trees do this by dropping acorns. Animals gather the acorns to store for winter.

Trees also get less sunlight in the fall. With less water and sunlight, the leaves change color. Green leaves turn bright red, orange, and yellow. The leaves drop from the trees and land in dry, crunchy piles.

Jumping in leaf piles is just one of the many fun things to do in the fall. Many kids go to orchards and pumpkin patches. It is normal during the fall to take hay rides and explore corn mazes. Scarecrows show up in the fall, along with hot cider.

Fall begins in September, on the equinox. The equinox happens when the sun is exactly over the equator. Fall lasts until winter starts in December.
