Begin: Screencast video clip 1 Voiceover audio	PDF and Google Form are open side by side  Ouestions, answer options and images are added in sync with script.	<ol> <li>Let's begin by downloading and opening the PDF entitled Google Form Content for Staff Dietary Restrictions Survey from the course.</li> <li>Open your Google Drive in a second window of your Chrome browser, side by side to your PDF.</li> <li>Click New, Google Form, Blank Form</li> <li>Copy and Paste the Title and description into the first text block</li> <li>Copy and paste the first question into the question block.</li> <li>You'll notice that the form is ready for you to type choices. So either copy and paste or type in the choices from the PDF into the questions block. You can tab over to the next item or move your mouse.</li> <li>When you get to the end of the list, click on "add Other" and it will create a checkbox with a fill in line for users to write in their own custom item.</li> </ol>	Voiceover clip 1  Use zoom in/out and annotation sketch red circle as narrator describes each button feature.

If you want to add an image to this question, click on this image icon and upload from one of the choices.  10. Click on the circle with three dots to align or change.  11. Go ahead and select "Add ALL" and manually add the missing items.</li> <li>15. When you get to the end of the list, click on "add Other" and it will create a checkbox with a fill in line for users to write in their own custom item.</li> <li>16. Let's check out some of the other design blocks you can use.</li> <li>23. Select the "paper with arrow" icon. If you had questions from another form, you could easily add them with this button. (none selected)</li> <li>24. If you want to add an image block, click the image icon and select your image from one of the options. (Add a title and hover text: Peanuts, a serious allergy food!)</li> <li>25. If you have a video, you can upload it here. (none selected.)</li> <li>26. And if you want to create a section break, click on this symbol. You can customize what users do at the end of each section also. (delete section)</li> <li>27. If you want to rearrange blocks, select the six small dots in the top middle of the block you want to move and drag to its new location.</li> </ul>	Voiceover clip 6

Notice that your theme colors were automatically changed, but you can adjust theme here and adjust the background colors here. You can also change the fonts if you want something different. 		title you entered in the title text block.  33. Click on the Settings tab.  34. Since this is a survey, we are not going to turn on set to quiz. This is great if you are creating a graded quiz for a class, but not for a survey where we want users to have a variety of customized answers.  35. For "RESPONSE", Turn on collect email addresses.  36. Send responders a copy of their response? Always.  37. turn on "Allow response editing" so users can edit anytime.  38. keep off "Limit to one response" so users can edit anytime.  39. For "PRESENTATION", turn on "show progress bar"  40. keep off "Shuffle questions" because we want the questions to have a logical order.  41. EDIT the Confirmation message to "Thank you for your response!"  42. Keep off "View results summary" for confidentiality.  43. keep off "Disable autosave" so it will save automatically.  44. For DEFAULTS: turn on "collect email addresses" by default.  45. Keep off "Make questions required" so users can have the choice not to answer.
