



 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 46" x 60" [117 x 152.5 cm]

GAUGE

6½ stitches and 5 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Pebble Pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

Chain (ch) 75.

1st row: 1 single crochet (sc) in 2nd ch from hook. 1 double crochet (dc) in next ch. *1 sc in next ch. 1 dc in next ch. Repeat (Rep) from * end of chain. 74 stitches (sts). Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. *1 sc in next dc. 1 dc in next sc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. Rep last row for Pebble Pattern (pat) until work from beginning (beg) measures 60" [152.5 cm].

Do not fasten off. **Do not** turn.

BORDER

1st round (rnd): Ch 1. 3 sc in same space (sp) as last slip stitch (sl st). Work sc evenly around, having 3 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc.

Fasten off.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ Brights (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/?201 m)

Busy Blue (12005) **or**

Red, White, & Boom Varg (12011) **or**

Royal Blue (12006) **or**

Race Car Red (12001): **5 balls (951 yds/ 870 m)**

Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
