SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

About 6 1/2 x 38 (16.5 x 96.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 137-135 Lion Brand Heartland Thick & Quick Yarn: Yosemite
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11
[8 mm]
- Pom pom Maker
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt
Needles (Set of 6)

**Heartland Thick & Quick (Article #137). 100% acrylic;
package size: 5.00oz/141.75 gr. (125yds/114m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

11 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every st on every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece in Garter st (knit every st on every row).
2. A slit is made in the Scarf by working half the sts with one ball of yarn and the other half of the sts with a second ball of yarn.
3. The slit provides styling options when wearing the Scarf.

SCARF

Cast on 5 sts.

Knit one row.

Increase end of Scarf

Next Row: Knit into front and then back of first st, then knit to end of row – you will have increased 1 st, so you'll now have a total of 6 sts.

Repeat the last row until you have 18 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every st on every row) until piece measures about 25 in. (63.5 cm) from last increase row.

Divide for slit

Next Row: Knit 9 sts, join a second ball of yarn and knit to end of row.

Next Row: On first side, knit 9 sts with one ball of yarn; on second side, knit 9 sts with second ball of yarn.

Continue working in Garter st, working each side separately with it's own ball of yarn, until slit measures about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm).

Next Row: Knit across 9 sts of first side, with same ball of yarn, knit across 9 sts of 2nd side. Now you'll be working with just one ball of yarn. Cut the second ball of yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

Knit 2 rows.

Decrease end of Scarf

Next Row: Knit 2 sts together, then knit to end of row – you will have decreased 1 st, so you'll now have a total of 17 sts.

Repeat the last row until you have 5 sts.

Knit one row across 5 sts.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Following package instructions, make 2 large pom-poms.

Tie a pom-pom to each end of Scarf.

Weave in the yarn ends.
