

# Adele



To fit average sized ladies hands

#### **YARN**

Kidsilk Haze – 2 x 25 gm (photographed in Majestic 589)

#### **NEEDLES**

1 pair 3½mm (no 10) (US 3) needles 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

#### TENSION

26 sts and 36 rows over st st using 31/4mm needles and yarn DOUBLE

Cast on 66 sts, using 3\(^4\)mm (US 3) needles and yarn DOUBLE.

**Row 1: (RS)** K2, \* p2, k2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** \* P2, k2, rep from \* to last 2 sts, p2.

These 2 rows set rib.

Work 10 rows more in rib.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles and using yarn SINGLE cont as follows:-**Row 1:** (**RS**) K3, \* p1, yon, sl 1, k1, psso, p1, k4, rep from \* to last 7 sts,

p1, yon, sl 1, k1, psso, p1, k3.

**Row 2:** P3, \* k1, p2, k1, p4, rep from \* to last 7 sts, k1, p2, k1, p3. **Row 3:** K3, \* p1, k2tog, yfrn, p1, k4, rep from \* to last 7 sts, p1, k2tog,

yfrn, p1, k3. **Row 4:** As row 2.

These 4 rows set lace pattern.

Cont in patt as set, dec 1 st at each end of 3<sup>rd</sup> and every foll 6<sup>th</sup> row to 46 sts.

Work 2 rows without shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row. Work 1 row, dec 1 st at end of row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3½mm needles and using yarn DOUBLE cont as follows;— Beg with a K row, work in st st for 28 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Shape Thumb gusset

Row 1: K21, m1, k3, m1, k21. 47 sts.

Row 2: and every foll alt row. Purl.

**Row 3:** K21, m1, k5, m1, k21. 49 sts.

 $\textbf{Row 5:} \ K21, m1, k7, m1, k21. \ 51 \ sts.$ 

**Row 7:** K21, m1, k9, m1, k21. 53 sts.

Row 8:. Purl.

Divide for thumb

Next row: K32, turn.

**Next row:** P11 and turn.

Working on these sts only for thumb, cont as follows:-

Cast on 3 sts at beg of next row. 14 sts.

Work a further 21 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and thread through all 14 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely. Sew thumb seam.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts and pick up and K 3 sts from base of thumb, K rem 21 sts. 45 sts.

Work 15 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Work first finger

Next row: K29 and turn.

Next row: Cast on and purl 1 st, P13, turn.

Working on these sts only for first finger, cont as folls:-

Cast on 1 st at beg of next row. 15 sts.

Work a further 27 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Break yarn and thread through all 15 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off

# securely. Sew seam. Work second finger

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts and pick up and K 2 sts from base of first finger, K6 and turn.

Next Row (WS): Cast on and purl 1 st, P14 and turn.

Working on these sts only for second finger, cont as folls:-

Cast on 1 st at beg of next row. 16 sts.

Work a further 29 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Break yarn and thread through all 16 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely. Sew seam.

#### Work third finger

With RS facing , rejoin yarn to rem sts and pick up and K 2 sts from base of first finger, K5 and turn.

Next Row (WS): Cast on and purl 1 st, P12 and turn.

Working on these sts only for third finger, cont as folls:-

Cast on 1 st at beg of next row. 14 sts.

Work a further 25 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. Break yarn and thread through all 14 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely. Sew seam.

## Work fourth finger

With RS facing , rejoin yarn to rem sts and pick up and K 2 sts from base of first finger, K to end.

Working on these 12 sts only for fourth finger, cont as folls:—Work a further 21 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and thread through all 12 sts. Pull up tight and fasten off securely. Sew side and finger seam.

Make a second glove in exactly the same way.

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
