

Bunny Blanket

NEEDLES

1 pair 4 mm & 3 ¼ mm needles

TENSION

22 sts x 30 rows = 10 cm measured over stocking st using 4 mm needles

YARN & MATERIALS

Cashsoft DK

A = Cream 500 10 x 50g Balls

B = Sweet 501 5 x 50g Balls

Blanket

Using 3¼ mm needles cast on 200 sts with **A**

Row 1 [RS] – Knit

Row 2 – as Row 1

These 2 rows form the garter st.

Cont to rep these 2 rows until 25 rows have been worked in all, **WS** facing for next row;-

Row 26 [WS] – k13, then place these sts on a holder for left hand border, K to last 13 sts, turn and leave rem 13 sts on holder for right hand border – **174 sts**

Now beg with a K row, cont to work from chart, beg at bottom right hand corner [1st row is RS of work] working chart entirely in stocking st and using the Intarsia technique for working the rabbit motifs [ie. use separate balls of yarn for each rabbit motif. DO NOT strand or weave yarns at back of work]

Cont until all 84 rows of chart have been worked.

Cont now to work Rows 1 to 84 twice more, then Rows 1 to 41 inclusive once more, **WS** facing for next row – **293 rows**

Leave 174 sts on a spare needle.

Make Up

Left Hand Border

With RS facing, A and using 3¼ mm needles K across 13 sts from holder for left hand border.

Cont in garter st until work, when slightly stretched fits up entire row-end edge of blanket, sewing in place as you go along and ending with **WS** facing for next row;-

Leave sts on a holder

Right Hand Border

With **WS** facing, A and using 3¼ mm needles K across 13 sts from holder for right hand border.

Cont in garter st until work, when slightly stretched fits up entire row-end edge of blanket, sewing in place as you go along and ending with **WS** facing for next row;-

Leave sts on a holder

Top Border

With WS facing, A and using 3¼ mm needles K across 13 sts from left hand border, then 174 sts from spare needle, then 13 sts from right hand border – **200 sts**

Cont in garter st for a further 25 rows, **WS** facing for next row;-

Cast off knitwise on **WS**.


