

R O W A N

Rose Hip Scarf

YARN

Rowan Silk Twist

7 x 50gm

(photographed in Amethyst 667)

NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles

1 pair 5mm (no 6) (US 8) needles

TENSION

18 sts and 22 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 5mm (US 8) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf measures 180 cm (71 ins) long and 24 cm (9½ ins) wide.

MAIN SECTION

Using 5mm (US 8) needles cast on 36 sts.

Now work in patt as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P4, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *K4, P1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, inc 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, taking inc sts into rev st st. 46 sts.**

Cont straight until scarf meas 25 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Place markers at both ends of last row.

Next row (RS): P2tog, patt to last 2 sts, P2tog.

44 sts.

Next row: K1, P1, K2, *P1, K4, rep from * to last 5 sts, P1, K2, P1, K1.

Next row: K2, P2, *K1, P4, rep from * to last 5 sts, K1, P2, K2.

Rep last 2 rows until scarf meas 155 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): Inc in first st, patt to last st, inc in last st. 46 sts.

Place markers at both ends of last row.

Next row: K5, *P1, K4, rep from * to last st, K1.

Next row: P5, *K1, P4, rep from * to last st, P1.

Last 2 rows form patt for rest of scarf.

Cont as now set until scarf meas 22 cm from last pair of markers, ending with RS facing for next row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows. 36 sts.

Work 2 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off in patt (on **WS**).

POCKETS (make 2)

Work as given for main section to **.

Cont straight until pocket meas 22 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles.

Next row (RS): *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

Rep last row until pocket meas 25 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Matching ends of cast-off edge of pocket to marked row of main section, sew pockets to ends of main section.

Roses (make 2) and leaves (make 4)

Work as given for rose and leaves of rose hip cardigan, forming each rose and pair of leaves into a corsage that is attached to each scarf pocket as in photograph.
