QUICK HITS

- The 2011-12 season marks BYU's first as a member of the West Coast Conference and a new television partnership with BYUtv and ESPN that will give fans unprecedented access to BYU basketball. ESPN2 and ESPNU will broadcast a total of eight BYU games and BYUtv is currently scheduled to televise 18 games.
- Three Cougars scored in double figures in BYU's season-opening loss at Utah State, led by Noah Hartsock with 18 and followed by Charles Abouo (16) and Brandon Davies (13).
- Two Cougars made their first career starts in the season opener at Utah State. Stephen Rogers started at guard and scored seven points and Brock Zylstra started at point guard and had two points, three rebounds, three assists and one steal.
- Under Dave Rose, BYU is 5-1 in home openers, including a streak of five-straight seasons winning the home opener. Last season, BYU defeated Fresno State 83-56 in the home opener.
- Dave Rose is one of the most successful coaches in the history of BYU basketball. He is second in program history in wins (159), first in winning percentage (.776) and has led the Cougars to five-straight NCAA Tournament berths and four conference titles. He also earned three Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year awards.
- BYU — along with Butler, Kansas and Pittsburgh — is one of only four NCAA Division I programs that has won at least 25 games in each of the last five seasons. Only eight teams have achieved the mark in each of the last four seasons, including BYU and WCC foes Gonzaga and Saint Mary's.

BYU will play its first of two home games as part of the Chicago Invitational on Friday, Nov. 18 against Longwood. The game is scheduled for a 7 p.m. MST tip in the Marriott Center. Follow the game live via GameTracker on www.byucougars.com and listen live on the radio beginning with the pregame show at 6 p.m. MST on KSL Newsradio 102.7 FM and 1160 AM out of Salt Lake City or via the Internet at KSL.com. The game will be televised live on BYUtv and BYUtv.org.

LAST TIME OUT - BYU AT UTAH STATE

LOGAN, Utah – In the first game of the 2011-12 season, the BYU men's basketball team lost to in-state rival Utah State 69-62 Friday night on the road at the Spectrum. Senior Noah Hartsock led BYU with 18 points, five rebounds and four assists. Senior Charles Abouo and junior Brandon Davies also scored in double figures, with 16 and 13 points, respectively.

The Cougars shot 46.8% (22-47) from the field but hit just 3-14 (21.4%) from three-point range and 15-22 (68.2%) from the free throw line. The BYU bench struggled to score throughout the game, shooting 2 of 7 and scoring six total points. BYU also picked up 26 team fouls in the game, 13 per half, and had six players with at least three fouls. BYU took the first lead of the game when Abouo hit a quick three before the Aggies responded and tied the game at 4-4. The lead changed six times over the following 11 minutes before Utah State went up 16-15 and held the lead for the remainder of the half.

The Cougars struggled from deep range in the first half, missing six straight threes following Abouo's opening make. BYU finished the half 2-8 from beyond the arc but shot 11 of 22 from the field. BYU also struggled

with fouls early, as the team racked up 13 in the half and four players had two apiece. Hartsock led BYU in the first half with eight points while Abouo and Stephen Rogers contributed seven each. With the combined 22 points from the three forwards, BYU went into the locker room trailing the Aggies 30-28.

Hartsock led BYU out of the locker room with four quick points that helped BYU take their first lead since the 9:48 mark in the first half. The Aggies responded with a 5-0 run to retake the lead before BYU went back up 42-38. After the Cougars stretched the lead to four, Utah State went on the biggest run of the game, an 11-0 stretch that lasted from the 10:38 mark until Davies broke it up with 6:02 remaining. The Aggies then went on another short 6-0 run to build up the biggest lead of the game at 55-44 at the 4:06 mark.

GOING GREEK

BYU men's basketball went on a 10-day, four-game tour of Greece in August. The Cougars won their first two games against the Athens All-Stars (88-56) and ASE Doukas (114-45) while also playing a friendly game against US Navy personnel on a base in Crete. While in Greece, BYU was invited to participate in the Acropolis of Athens Tournament against the Greek and Italian National Teams, both ranked among the top 10 in the world by FIBA. Against Greece, Stephen Rogers led BYU with 20 points in an 83-54 loss. Brock Zylstra exploded for 26 points and four 3-pointers in BYU's 102-63 loss to an Italian team that featured three NBA stars.

NEW HOME

In 2011-12, BYU men's basketball enters its first season as a member of the West Coast Conference. The Cougars have played each member of the league at least twice all time. Last season, BYU defeated St. Mary's 74-73 in the South Padre Island Invitational championship game and Gonzaga 89-67 in the third round of the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16. NONCONFERENCE SCHEDULE

BYU's nonconference schedule features programs from 12 different conferences and includes nine teams that played in the postseason in 2011, including three that played in the NCAA Tournament.

COACHING STAFF

For the second-straight season there was a change to the coaching staff. Former associate head coach Dave Rice, who had been with the staff since Rose became the head coach in 2005, left to take the head job at his alma mater, UNLV. Rose hired Mark Pope as an assistant coach in May 2011. Pope comes to BYU after one season as an assistant at Wake Forest. Prior to Wake Forest, Pope was the director of basketball operations at Georgia. Pope played his college ball at Washington and Kentucky. In 1996, he was a team captain and helped Kentucky win the NCAA National Championship. Pope was selected by the Indiana Pacers in the second round of the NBA draft and played seven seasons in the NBA. He played in the Eastern Conference Finals with Indiana (1998) and Milwaukee (2001).

ESPN AND BYUTV

Eight of BYU's games this season will be broadcast on the ESPN family of networks, including: vs. Oregon at EnergySolutions Arena (Dec. 3 on ESPNU), at Saint Mary's (Dec. 29 on ESPN2), vs. Santa Clara (Jan. 14 on ESPNU) vs. Saint Mary's (Jan. 28 on ESPNU), vs. Gonzaga (Feb. 2 on ESPN2), at San Francisco (Feb. 16 on ESPNU), at Santa Clara (Feb. 18 on ESPNU) and at Gonzaga (Feb. 23 on ESPN2). BYUTv will broadcast all home games not televised by ESPN. Including the two exhibition games, BYUTv is currently scheduled to broadcast 16 home men's basketball games. Broadcast plans for road games will be announced as the information becomes available.

YOUNG GUNS

The 2011-12 roster includes nine freshmen who come from several different situations. Nate Austin and Ian Harward are true freshman and are coming off two-year missions for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Mike Boswell is also coming off a mission but completed a redshirt season prior to serving. Josh Sharp is another return missionary and he redshirted one season at Utah prior to his mission. Matt Carlino and Anson Winder both redshirted for the Cougars last season. The other three freshmen — Damarcus Harrison, Austin Nelson and Jaren Sweeney — are all true freshmen.

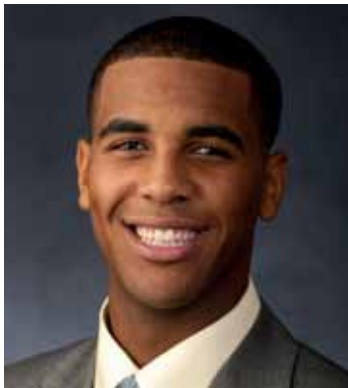
