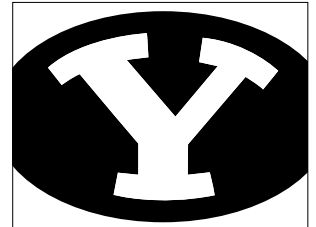

- BYU is coming off an 83-63 loss at No. 10 Gonzaga. BYU is now 15-6 overall and 5-2 in WCC play. Josh Sharp scored a career-best 14 points while Brandon Davies added 14 points, 6 boards and 3 steals. Matt Carlino had 11 points, 4 assists and 4 steals in the setback.
- Tyler Haws has scored 20-plus points in 14 games and Matt Carlino has scored in double figures in seven-straight games. Carlino's streak is a career best.
- BYU swept the season series against Portland last season, winning 79-60 at Portland and 76-66 at home. Brandon Davies had a double-double with 18 points and 13 rebounds on the road and 25 points in the home win. Brock Zylstra had 12 points and 5 boards on the road and 20 points and 9 boards at home.

BY THE NUMBERS

6 Dave Rose and the Cougars have the second-longest current streak of consecutive 25-win campaigns in the country at six (2006-07 to 2011-12). Only Bill Self and Kansas, owners of seven-consecutive 25-win seasons (2005-06 to 2011-12), have a longer current streak. BYU has also advanced to the NCAA Tournament for six-straight seasons.

14 Brandon Davies picked up where he left off last season, taking 14 charges through 21 games, including a season high of three vs. Tennessee State. He has now taken 45 charges since the beginning of last season. Nate Austin has taken five charges this season after drawing 29 offensive fouls last season.

17 Brandon Davies has four double-doubles this season, with 22 points and 10 rebounds vs. UTSA, 21 points and 10 rebounds vs. Montana, 26 points and 17 rebounds at Baylor and 27 points and 10 rebounds vs. Northern Arizona. He now has 17 career double-doubles, including nine last season.

42 The number of points Tyler Haws scored against Virginia Tech, a career high and the most scored by an individual in NCAA Division I basketball this season. The 42 points are also a BYU sophomore record and tied for the eighth most in program history. Haws also broke the family record of 40 set by his father Marty Haws in 1989.

200 Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 200 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

HAWS NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – JAN. 14, 2013

Tyler Haws was named the WCC Player of the Week after leading BYU to wins over Pepperdine at home and at Santa Clara last week while averaging 24.0 points and shooting .643 from the field, .400 from three and .909 from the free throw line. In addition to his stellar scoring and shooting numbers, Haws collected 3.5 rebounds and came away with 2.5 steals per game.

HAWS NAMED WCC, SI.COM, NBC SPORTS PLAYER OF THE WEEK – DEC. 31, 2012

Tyler Haws was named player of the week by the WCC, SI.com and NBC Sports after leading BYU to wins over Northern Arizona and Virginia Tech. Haws averaged 28.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals.

DAVIES NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – DEC. 17, 2012

The WCC named Brandon Davies the Men's Basketball Player of the Week for his career-high 33 points and added eight rebounds and one block in BYU's 78-68 victory at Weber State.

LAST TIME OUT – COUGARS FALL TO CONFERENCE FOE GONZAGA

SPOKANE, Washington – BYU men's basketball lost for the second time in West Coast Conference play this season, falling 83-63 at Gonzaga on Thursday at the McCarthy Athletic Center.

Josh Sharp led the Cougars (15-6, 5-2 WCC) with a career-high 14 points, alongside Brandon Davies who scored 12 points in the second half to also end the game with 14. Matt Carlino was also in double-digits with 11 points and had a game-high four steals for BYU. Gonzaga (17-2, 5-0 WCC) was led by Kelly Olynyk and Elias Harris with 26 and 25 points, respectively. Olynyk was a perfect 9 of 9 from the field and 8 of 8 from the free-throw line.

Gonzaga was fired up in the first two minutes of the game, capitalizing on fast-break points and team defense to take an 11-3 lead over BYU. Out of the first timeout, Carlino knocked down a shot from the top of the arc to stop the bleeding and cut the Gonzaga lead to five with 17:36 remaining.

From the 17:03 to the 13:15 mark, neither team was able to find the basket. BYU was the first to score, ending the four-minute drought, when Carlino fed Sharp for the easy lay in. However, the Bulldogs answered quickly on their next possession to raise the score to 15-8 in their favor.

Davies scored his first points of the game at the 9:43 mark to finally put BYU in double-digit scoring, down 17-10. Two minutes later, Gonzaga extended its lead to 11 at 21-10 with two-straight field goals from Harris.

With five minutes remaining in the half, Carlino stole the ball and finished at the basket to cut the Gonzaga lead to 10 at 24-14. However, the Bulldogs extended their double-digit lead to 22 with a 12-0 run heading into the two-minute mark. At 1:54, Sharp executed on a three-point play and then followed with another shot in the paint to become the only Cougar in double-digit scoring for the half with 10.

On the next Gonzaga possession, the Bulldogs were given four free shots due to a called personal foul and a technical foul on Sharp.

Heading into the locker room at halftime, BYU found themselves 19 points down at 40-21. BYU owed the deficit to poor shooting from the field. Gonzaga held BYU to only 8 of 31 shooting and didn't allow Tyler Haws, who leads the WCC in scoring, to score a single point.

The second half started where the first left off as Brock Zylstra was called for a flagrant foul to give Gonzaga two shots and another possession to go up 44-22. Zylstra made up for the foul offensively when he hit BYU's first 3-point shot since the 17:36 mark in the first half.

On the next BYU possession, Sharp used a three-point play to grab a new career-high in points at 14.

Gonzaga held its 20-point lead through the first seven minutes of the second half, but Carlino cut it to 18 with a steal and fast-break to spark a 5-0 run for the Cougars.

With 9:07 remaining, Davies finished at the basket and then Nate Austin followed through on Davies' missed free throw to bring the Cougars within 13 at 59-46.

At the 7:35-mark, Haws hit one of two free throws for his first and only point of the night to cut the Zag lead to 12 at 64-52.

Winder hit his first 3-pointer of the night with five minutes remaining and hit another two points on the next possession to put the score at 72-59. After that shot, Gonzaga took an 11-4 run to the buzzer to take the 83-63 victory.

2012-13 STORYLINES AND NOTES**Player and team notes**

- Dave Rose earned his 200th career victory with a 74-57 win over San Diego. Stan Watts is the only other coach in BYU history with 200-plus wins. Watts won his 200th game during his 12th season at the helm on Feb. 2, 1961 at New Mexico. It was his 329th career game (Watts' career record was 371-254 in 23 seasons). Rose is in his eighth season and earned win number 200 in his 259th game.
- Prior to the game at Gonzaga, Tyler Haws had scored 20-plus points in seven-consecutive games, the longest such streak in his career. He opened the year with six-straight 20-point games and has 14 20-point games this season.
- Matt Carlino has scored in double figures in seven-straight games (all WCC games), a career-best streak. During that stretch he is averaging 15.3 points, 4.1 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 3.0 steals while shooting .438 from the field and .359 from three. His assist to turnover ratio during that time is 2.4 to 1.
- In the second half against Pepperdine, BYU out-scored the Waves 46-16 to earn the 76-51 victory. The 30-point scoring margin was the biggest in a half this season for the Cougars and the 16 points are the fewest allowed in a half this season by BYU.
- BYU has completed three comebacks after trailing at the half this season. The Cougars trailed Utah and San Francisco by nine at the half and won 61-58 and 80-76. BYU trailed Pepperdine by five at the half and came back to win 76-51.
- BYU played its best defensive game of the season against LMU, limiting the Lions to 51 points and 30.8 percent shooting — both season bests for the Cougars. The first half was BYU's best defensive half as the Cougars limited LMU to 20 points and 23.5 percent shooting. BYU's 57 second half points are the most scored by the Cougars in a half all season, one more than the 56 scored against Virginia Tech in the first half.
- Tyler Haws hit 10 of 10 from the free throw line vs. Weber State, his third game this season shooting 100 percent from the line while attempting at least 10 free throws. Haws has four such games in his career, tied for the most in BYU history with Jimmer Fredette. Haws is tied with Russell Larson (1993-94) and Roberts (1994-95) for most perfect days from the line (minimum of 10 attempts) in a season with three. Danny Ainge, Lee Cumard, Larson and Roberts are tied for second on the career list with three.

Haws's big day

On Dec. 29, Tyler Haws scored a career-high 42 points against Virginia Tech as he hit 14 of 25 from the field, 6 of 8 from three and 8 of 9 from the free throw line. See below for some of the records Haws set in his breakout game:

- Most points scored by a BYU sophomore
- Tied for eighth-most points scored by an individual in BYU history
- Most points scored by a BYU player not named Jimmer Fredette since 1961 (Bob Skousen, 47 vs. UCLA)
- Gives BYU a father-son duo in the 40-point club (Haws's father Marty scored 40 vs. Siena in 1989)

Haws the closer

Tyler Haws has played some of his best basketball in the final five minutes of games this season. Against Cal State Northridge, BYU trailed 74-73 with less than four minutes remaining. Haws hit a jumper with 3:44 to go to give BYU the lead and had 10 of the Cougars' final 14 points to help secure the 87-75 win. Against Utah, BYU trailed 58-56 before Haws completed a three-point play with 2:47 to go. He added two free throws with 16 seconds remaining to secure the 61-58 win. After struggling from the field the first 35 minutes at Weber State, Haws scored nine points in the last five minutes on 3 of 3 shooting from the field and 2 of 2 from the free throw line. Against Saint Mary's he scored six points in the final five minutes, including four in the last 41 seconds. For the season, Haws is 20 of 29 from the field, 3 of 4 from three and 15 of 17 from the free throw line in the last five minutes of games.

Fast start for Tyler Haws

Tyler Haws opened 2012-13 with six-straight 20-point games, the second best such streak in program history. Only Devin Durrant started a season with more consecutive 20-point games, seven in 1983-84. Danny Ainge, Kresimir Cosic and Michael Smith started seasons with five-straight 20-point games.

Davies does it all

Brandon Davies has stuffed the stat sheet this season, averaging 17.8 points, 7.2 rebounds, 2.3 assists, 1.2 blocks and 1.4 steals in 21 games. Last season he became the second Cougar in program history to average at least one of everything (points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks). Russell Larson is the only other BYU player to produce a 'one of everything' season and did so twice, in 1993-94 and 1994-95 (blocks and steals were not tracked until the 1977-78 season).

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to its most successful eight-year run since taking over in 2005. His career record of 200-60 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.769). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice and has guided the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances and six 25-win seasons. In 2010 he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one tournament game in the two seasons since, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2011.
