

BYU STORYLINES

- Tyler Haws has opened the 2012-13 season on a tear, averaging 22.3 points, 6.7 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 1.7 steals. He has scored 22 or more in all three games. Against Florida State he set season highs of 23 points, nine rebounds, five assists, three steals and one block.
- The last time BYU and Notre Dame met was in the 2000 NIT. The Cougars won their first two games of the tournament at home against Southern Illinois and Bowling Green before heading to South Bend, Ind. Behind Troy Murphy's 19 points and nine boards the Irish won 64-52.
- Under Dave Rose the Cougars have lost consecutive regular season games only twice. The first time came in 2006-07 and the second was in 2008-09.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Dave Rose and the Cougars have the second-longest current streak of consecutive 25-win campaigns at six (2006-07 to 2011-12). Only Bill Self and Kansas, owners of seven-consecutive 25-win seasons (2005-06 to 2011-12), have a longer current streak.
- **3** Brandon Davies picked up where he left off last season, taking three charges vs. Tennessee State. He has now taken 34 charges since the beginning of last season.
- **6** The Cougars have won 25-plus games and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for six-straight seasons (2006-07 to 2011-12). Both streaks are program records.
- Matt Carlino opened the 2012-13 season with 10 assists vs. Tennessee State, one off his career high of 11 set last season vs. Buffalo. With seven assists vs. Georgia State, he had 17 in the first two games of the season the most assists in a two-game stretch in his career.
- **13** Brandon Davies has 13 career double-doubles, including nine last season.
- BYU posted 20-plus assists in consecutive games to start the season with 20 vs. Tennessee State and 21 vs. Georgia State. The last time the Cougars posted back-to-back 20 assist games was Jan. 7 and Jan. 14, 2012, against San Francisco and Santa Clara. Last season BYU averaged 17.1 assists per game, the sixth best average in NCAA Division I basketball. This season the Cougars are averaging 19.7 per game.
- Tyler Haws has opened the 2012-13 season with back-to-back-to-back 20-point games. He is averaging 22.3 points per game while shooting .532 from the field, .417 from three and .923 from the free throw line.
 - Tyler Haws ended his freshman year by making his final 48 free throw attempts, a BYU record for charity-stripe shots without a miss. He extended the streak to 50 with two makes in the first half against Tennessee State. The streak ended with a miss in the second half but he made his last six to finish 8 of 9. Haws has made 60 of his last 61 free throws
- Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 187 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.
- Last season Brandon Davies became the 44th Cougar to score 1,000 career points and by the end of the season had climbed to 42nd all-time. With 19 points vs. Florida State he passed Bruce Burton (1,089 points), Mark Handy (1,098) and Terrell Lyday (1,105) for 37th all-time and is two points from tying Gary Earnest for 36th.

REGULAR SEASON TOURNAMENT SUCCESS

BYU's 88-70 loss to Florida State in the Acura Coaches vs. Cancer Classic was only the program's third loss in a regular season tournament under Dave Rose. The Cougars are now 22-3 under Dave Rose in regular season tournaments. Under Rose, the Cougars have won four regular season tournament titles and taken second twice. BYU plays Notre Dame at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y., on Nov. 17 in the consolation game.

LAST TIME OUT - BYU FALLS TO FLORIDA STATE IN BROOKLYN

BROOKLYN, New York — Despite Tyler Haws and Brandon Davies combining for 42 points, BYU men's basketball fell 88-70 to Florida State in the Acura Coaches vs. Cancer Classic Friday at the Barclays Center.

Haws led BYU (2-1) with a season-high 23 points — including the team's first 11 points to start the game — and added team highs of nine rebounds and five assists. Brandon Davies also scored 19 points while Brock Zylstra and Craig Cusick each added 10.

FSU (2-1) was led by Okara White who scored 17 points while Michael Snaer (16), Ian Miller (15) and Devon Bookert (15) also scored in double figures. The hot-shooting Seminoles shot 58.0 percent from the field and 55.0 percent from the free throw line.

FSU scored the game's first six points before Haws hit a 15-foot jump shot at the 16:37 mark to put the Cougars on the board. Haws scored the next nine points for the Cougars, highlighted by a 3-point shot and a break-away layup. With Haws as BYU's lone scorer early on, the Cougars trailed 23-11.

Zylstra scored his first points of the game on a 3-pointer from the top of the arc with 10:15 left in the first half and then Nate Austin followed with a 3-point play of his own after being fouled under the basket. Cusick added to the BYU run with a 3-point shot while Zylstra sank two free throws to cut the FSU lead to five at 27-22.

Davies scored his first points of the game at with 7:45 to go before halftime after grabbing an offensive rebound and finishing at the basket. He then scored the next four points for the Cougars to cut the Seminole lead to three (31-28), its smallest lead since the 15:26 mark. Haws tallied the next four points to put BYU within two (34-32).

At the 4:09 mark, Zylstra hit a jumper to bring the game to a 34-34 tie. FSU quickly responded and with a 10-1 run to end the half and went into the locker room up 44-35.

Davies started the second half with a commanding dunk and then ran the floor to finish on an easy layup and give BYU four quick points. However, FSU kept the pressure on BYU and hit two 3-pointers to grab a 15-point lead with 15 minutes remaining in the half.

Less than six minutes into the second half Davies was whistled for his fourth foul and went to the bench. FSU took advantage and went on a 13-0 run to extend its lead to 20 at 63-43. Zylstra ended the run at the 13:47 mark with a 3-pointer, but the Seminoles answered that shot with an 8-2 run to take their biggest lead of the game, 75-48.

The Cougars continued to fight and put together a 12-0 run to cut the FSU lead to 14 at 80-66. Davies scored six points during the run and Cory Calvert hit his second shot of the night for a new career high in points with four.

FSU ended the BYU run at 4:35 and held onto its double-digit lead to hand BYU its first loss of the season with a score of 88-70.

2012-13 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Welcome back Tyler Haws

Tyler Haws scored 22 points vs. Tennessee State, his first game since serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the Philippines. He followed that with another 22-point game against Georgia State and 23 points vs. Florida State. The three games mark his 22nd, 23rd and 24th career games scoring in double figures and fifth, sixth and seventh 20-point games. As a freshman in 2009-10 he averaged 11.3 points and 4.2 rebounds while shooting .498 from the field, .368 from three and .917 from the free throw line.

Davies does it all

Brandon Davies stuffed the stat sheet in the opener against Tennessee State, tallying 16 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists, 4 blocks and 2 steals while drawing 3 charges. He did it again vs. Georgia State with 28 points, 9 rebounds, 3 assists, 3 blocks and 2 steals. Through three games he is averaging 21.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.3 steals, 3.0 blocks and 1.3 steals. Last season he became the second Cougar in history to average at least one of everything (points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks). Russell Larson is the only other BYU player to produce a 'one of everything' season and did so twice, in 1993-94 and 1994-95 (blocks and steals were not tracked until the 1977-78 season).

Taking charge

Brandon Davies drew three charges in the season opener vs. Tennessee State. Last season Brandon Davies made the opposition pay when they drove to the basket, taking 31 charges. Nate Austin took his fair share of charges as well with a total of 29 last season. He and Brock Zylstra both took a charge in the season opener.

Block party

Brandon Davies (4), Josh Sharp (2) and Nate Austin (2) combined to block eight shots vs. Tennessee State in the opener. The eight blocks is the sixth-highest total in a game by a BYU team. Against Georgia State the Cougars had six blocks and had five more against Florida State. Last season the single-game high was nine vs. Weber State. The program record is 15 vs. Eastern Kentucky in 1990 when Shawn Bradley had 14.

Hot start

The Cougars jumped out to a huge lead against Georgia State in large part due to BYU's hot shooting. The starters hit 13 of 17 from the field and 5 of 5 from three to establish a 31-2 lead with 1:31 to go in the first half.

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to its most successful seven-year run since taking over in 2005. His career record of 187-55 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.773). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice and has guided the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances and six 25-win seasons. In 2010 he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one tournament game in the two seasons since, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2011 and the largest comeback in NCAA Tournament history (25-point deficit) in last season's 78-72 win over lona in the First Four in Dayton, Ohio.

Rose vs. the state

BYU basketball coach Dave Rose has compiled a record of 24-6 vs. instate opponents since taking over in 2005-06. He has the best winning percentage (.800) of any coach vs. instate teams during that time and the second-most wins (Utah State's Stew Morrill is 25-8 vs. instate teams since 2005-06 for a .758 winning percentage). BYU hosts Utah State and Utah on Dec. 5 and 8, respectively, and plays at Weber State on Dec. 15.

Rose in season and home openers

With the 81-66 win over Tennessee State to start the season, BYU basketball is 5-3 in season openers and 7-1 in home openers under Dave Rose. After dropping his first two season openers in 2005 and 2006, Rose led BYU to four-straight season-opening wins before falling 69-62 at Utah State to open last season. Rose lost his first home opener (also the season opener in 2005) but has since won the last seven home openers.

Roster notes

BYU coach Dave Rose announced on Nov. 7 that freshman Cooper Ainge will redshirt this season. Ainge is the son of BYU-great Danny Ainge and prepped at Wellesley High School in Wellesley, Mass. Earlier this fall it was announced that injuries ended the careers of two former Cougars, Chris Collinsworth and Stephen Rogers. Collinsworth had battled knee injuries for two years but was preparing to return to the court before it was discovered he needed microfracture surgery on his left ankle. Rogers tore the meniscus in his right knee last season and had surgery in December 2011 and April 2012. The knee did not respond to treatment and continued to swell and give Rogers pain, preventing him from returning to full activity with the team.
