

2014 BYU FOOTBALL LAST GAME/OPPONENT OUTLOOK-3



BYU VS. TEXAS

Quarterback Taysom Hill's three rushing touchdowns led BYU football to a 41-7 domination of revenge-thirsty Texas on the Longhorns' home field Saturday.

Up 6-0 at halftime, Cougar offense turned the tide to start the second half and scored touchdowns on four consecutive drives. Hill completed the first drive with a 30-yard touchdown run after hurdling a Longhorn defender on the 5-yard line. After the defense forced a quick three and out, an acrobatic catch by Leslie set up a 16-yard touchdown run by Hine.

BYU's defense forced another quick three-and-out, and Mitchell Juergens returned the ensuing punt to the Texas 29-yard line. Hill then rushed for his second touchdown from a couple yards out. The Cougars proved they weren't done on the kickoff, with Michael Alisa forcing a fumble that was recovered by Harvey Jackson on the Texas 24-yard line. Hill recorded his third rushing touchdown of the game from a yard out.

BYU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior quarterback Taysom Hill passed Jake Heaps on the BYU all-time passing list to claim the No. 17 spot with 3,852 passing yards in his career. With 99 rushing yards, he also moved up the all-time rushing list to pass No. 12, passing JJ DiLuigi. Hill now has 1,876 rushing yards. He rushed for three touchdowns, tying a personal best. The last time he rushed for three TDs was against Texas in 2013.
- Senior receiver Jordan Leslie led all receivers with seven catches and 85 yards. Leslie has now caught a pass in 30 consecutive games.
- Senior defensive back Rob Daniel forced one fumble, the third of his career. He also recovered two fumbles, his first as a Cougar. He added six tackles.
- Sophomore safety Dallin Leavitt recorded his first career sack and led the team with seven tackles, including two tackles for loss, both personal bests.
- In the third quarter, junior running back Adam
 Hine scored his second career rushing touchdown
 on a 16-yard rush. He then rushed for his third in
 the fourth quarter. Hine rushed for 29 yards on four
 carries with an average of 7.2 yards per carry.
- Senior linebacker Michael Alisa notched the first interception of his career and added a forced fumble to go along with four tackles, tying his career high.
- Senior linebacker Alani Fua recorded his first sack of the season and sixth of his career in the second quarter.



HOUSTON VS. GRAMBLING STATE

Houston Football poured in 477 yards of offense, led by junior running back Kenneth Farrow, who ran for 130 yards and a touchdown, while the Cougars forced six turnovers en route to a 47-0 shutout win over Grambling State Saturday evening at TDECU Stadium.

The shutout win was the 38th in program history and the second in the last four games played under head coach Tony Levine. The 47 points on Saturday were the most scored since Oct. 26, 2013, at Rutgers. The total also marks the most points scored at home since Aug. 30, 2013, against Southern.

Five different Cougars jumped in the scoring action, notching five touchdowns, while kicker Kyle Bullard contributed with a career-high 17 points for Houston on four field goals and five extra points.

HOUSTON PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior Kenneth Farrow's 55-yard rush is a career long. His previous longest was 48 yards, last coming Nov. 24, 2012 vs. Tulane. Farrow's 2-yard touchdown with 9:51 left in the first half marked his first touchdown of the season.
- Farrow finished the game with 130 rushing yards accounting for his first career 100-yard game. Also marked a new career rushing high. The junior running back had 13 carries, also marking a new career high.
- With his 14 pass attempts tonight, sophomore quarterback John O'Korn tied David Dacus for 11th all-time on the Houston career passing attempts list. He currently has 503 and is just six away from 10th all-time. O'Korn's 200 passing yards tonight gives him 3,521 all-time, passing David Dacus (3,446 yards) for 11th all-time in school history.
- Junior wide receiver Deontay Greenberry led UH in receiving yards with 110 tonight. Tonight marked Greenberry's sixth 100-yard receiving game. Greenberry moved up to 11th on the school's all-time career receiving yards list (1,977) passing Marcus Grant (1,927).
- Senior Efrem Oliphant tallied double-digit tackles for the 11th time in his career and led the team in tackles for the second straight game.
 Oliphant finished the game with 10 tackles (1 solo, 9 assist)

2014 BYU FOOTBALL TEAM NOTES-4

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FOUR

The 12-game independent slate features teams from 10 states and seven conferences, including the American Athletic, Atlantic Coast, Big 12, Pac-12, Conference USA, Mountain West and Mid-Eastern Athletic.

The Cougars will play six home games and six road contests in 2014. BYU will face teams that hail from Connecticut, Virginia, Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Idaho, Nevada and California, including seven programs—Texas, Houston, Utah State, Central Florida, Boise State, Middle Tennessee and UNLV—that qualified for a bowl game last season.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Selected by their peers, quarterback Taysom Hill, running back Paul Lasike, safety Craig Bills and defensive lineman Remington Peck have been named team captains for the 2014 season.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accomodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 83,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 406 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

Eighty-eight members of the 2014 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in 28 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- BYU is successful when it strikes first. The Cougars are on an eight-game winning streak when they are the first team to score. The Cougars are 2-0 this season and in each game, they have been the first to score. Last season, they finished 6-1 when scoring before their opponent. In the Bronco Mendenhall era, BYU is 63-8.
- **Go fast, go hard** has been the mantra of offensive coordinator Robert Anae. Against Texas, BYU ran 86 offensive plays. Last year with a new offense, the Cougars averaged 89.9 plays per game, the second most of any team in the country only behind Texas Tech. Comparatively, BYU ran 79.2 plays per game in 2012.
- Hill made history with his performance against Houston in 2013. He is one of eight players in NCAA history to ever throw for 400 yards and run for 100 yards in the same game. He finished with 417 passing yards (4 TDs) and 128 rushing yards.
- BYU has not been shut out for 126 consecutive games. The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 484 of 485 games since 1975.
- Hill is one of six active quarterbacks in the nation with seven or more games with 100+ rushing yards.
 Against Texas, he ran for 99 yards (after accounting for yards lost from sacks). Versus the Huskies, Hill threw for 308 yards and three touchdowns while also rushing for 97 yards and two more scores.
- At the end of the 2013 season, quarterback Hill ranked No. 10 in the country with an average of 329.4 yards per game of total offense. Hill earned the No. 1 all-time spot among BYU quarterbacks with 1,680 career rushing yards. Then a sophomore, he also ranked No. 19 in the FBS in rushing yards with 1,344 on the year.
- With five rushing touchdowns through two weeks, Hill leads all FBS quarterbacks in touchdowns scored and is second among all players in that category.

- In the past nine seasons, BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in various national statistical categories 61 times on defense. Currently, BYU ranks in the top 25 in defensive rushing yards per game, scoring defense, opponent red zone conversion rate, sacks per game, forced turnovers and points per play.
- Lengthening the field. The Cougars have allowed just three rushing plays of 10 or more yards this season. Only three other teams have allowed less than three in two games. For the 2013 season, BYU allowed opponents 154 plays of 10 yards or more to rank No. 19 in the country.
- Points per play and per game. The BYU defense allows 0.112 points per play, the second best for any team in the nation who has played more than one game in 2014. So far this season, the Cougars are allowing 8.5 points per game, tied with Notre Dame for No. 5 among teams who have played at least two games. They finished No. 14 nationally in 2013 for points per play and No. 24 for points per game.
- Shutting down the offense. The defense is tied for fourth nationally in opponent red zone conversions with a 42.86 percentage. BYU is also tied for 10th in sacks per game with seven and is No. 9 for forced turnovers with six.

Scott Arellano had a career-high three 50+ yard punts against Texas, registering punts of 50, 51 and 64 yards. He had 13 punts of 50+ yard in 2013 in his first year as the primary punter for the Cougars.

Trevor Samson hit all 5 PAT attempts against Texas, making him a perfect 10 for 10 on the season.

The Cougars connected on 21 field goals last season, all by senior kicker Justin Sorensen. He became the all-time leader for most FGs in a season at BYU.

YEARS AT BYU

10th year as head coach, 12th at BYU YEARS OVERALL

Entering his tenth season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputation as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to nine straight bowl appearances, two outright conference champion-ships before football independence in 2011, and regular national


Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned an 84-34 record to rank 12th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005. Mendenhall also ranks 12th in winning percentage at .712 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience.

The Cougars finished the 2013 season with an 8-5 record after playing one of the toughest schedules in school history. BYU earned six of its eight wins over bowl teams, including then-No. 15 Texas, and faced nine bowl teams overall. Under Mendenhall BYU is one of only 12 programs to earn a bowl invitation each of the past nine years. Only Florida State (7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cou-gars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first nine teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 116 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 82-34-almost identical to Edwards' 116-game mark of 83-32-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007.

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.


