THE GAME

The No. 15/14 Utah Utes (7-0)—the nation's top scoring team at 97.0 points per game—travel south on Saturday to face BYU at the Marriott Center. Tipoff is set for 5 p.m. MT.

OPENING TIP

- The Utes moved up one spot to No. 15 in this week's AP poll—the program's highest position since ranking 14th on Jan. 28, 2019—and two spots to No. 14 in the USA Today Coaches poll. It's Utah's highest position in the coaches poll since March 10, 2008 (13th). Utah was 25th in this year's preseason AP poll, and moved up to 17th and 16th over the first two regular season polls before this week's climb to 15th. The Utes are one of five Pac-12 teams ranked this week by the AP, led by Stanford (2), and joined by Arizona (12), UCLA (13) and Oregon (17).
- The Utes boast the nation's No. 1 scoring offense, averaging 97.0 points per game, and also led the nation in assists per game (21.7) and field goal percentage (52.6%).
- The first NCAA NET rankings of the year came out on Tuesday, and Utah checked in at No. 6, second-best among Pac-12 teams behind Stanford (2).
- Utah scored in triple digits for the second time this season last Thursday at Mississippi Valley State (109-42), and now has scored 90 or more points in five of seven games this season. The Utes reached 100 points three times last season and scored 90 or more eight times. Utah's highest-scoring game came vs. No. 16 Oklahoma (124), which tied the program record (March 24, 1979 vs. NAU).
- Utah's 67-point win at Mississippi Valley State (109-42) was its largest on the road in program history, following its largest all-time margin of victory, 70 points, earlier this season at home against Utah Valley University (97-27).
- Junior forward Alissa Pili added to her impressive early-season resume last week with a season-high 28 points at MVSU, on an incredibly efficient 12-of-16 shooting—including 2-2 from 3—in just 16:15 of action. Pili, Pac-12 Player of the Week Nov. 28, ranks third nationally in field-goal percentage at 69.4% and has shot 75% or better in 4 of 7 games this season.
- Utah made 10 three-pointers at MVSU, its third time in seven games making 10 or more three-pointers. It's the 90th game in Head Coach Lynne Roberts' tenure with 8 or more made threes, and Utah is 65-25 in those games.
- The Utes have dished out 152 assists this season and average a national-best 21.7 per game. Utah recorded 29 or more assists in two games, including a season-best 33 against No. 16 Oklahoma. Utah has assisted on 63.6 percent of its field goals this season, and every Utah player has logged an assist on the year.
- Utah's 46-point victory over No. 16 Oklahoma on Nov. 16 was the largest win margin by the Utes against an AP Top 25 team. It was also the largest margin of victory for a Pac-12 team against a ranked team since 1999-00.
- Two Utes landed on national preseason award watch lists, sophomore Gianna Kneepkens (Jersey Mike's Naismith Award/nation's top player; and Cheryl Miller Award/top small forward) and Junior Alissa Pili (Katrina McClain Award for the top power forward).

POSTGAME SERVICES

Head coach Lynne Roberts will be available for post-game interviews with the media after each game. Utah student-athletes will be available following a 10-minute cooling-off period. A member of the Utah athletics communications staff will gather interview requests immediately following the game. In-game and final stats are available via StatBroadcast at the link on the utahutes.com schedule page, and other information may be provided upon request.

IN-SEASON INTERVIEWS

Head coach Lynne Roberts and requested Utah student-athletes are available for interviews throughout the week. Those members of the media wishing to interview Roberts or a student-athlete must coordinate their request through the athletics communications office at least 24 hours in advance. Roberts will also hold a weekly press conference throughout the Conference season, with day and time to be determined as the Conference season begins.

UTAH SPORTS RADIO NETWORK

ESPN 700 (KALL-AM) has been the radio home to University of Utah athletics since 1951. All of Utah's games on ESPN 700 can also be heard live on the Internet at ESPN700sports.com. Radio coverage for women's basketball games that conflict with other events airing on ESPN 700 will be announced as they are scheduled. Managing the radio network is Utes Sports Properties, a division of LEARFIELD. Utes Sports Properties (USP) through LEARFIELD is in its sixth year as the multi-media rights partner for Utah Athletics. USP brokered the most recent contract extension with ESPN 700 and Utah Athletics – a five-year agreement signed in May, 2022. Handling the play-by-play for the Utah women's basketball team is **Tyson Ewing**, who is in his seventh season. Ewing previously spent four years as the voice of Weber State women's basketball, and was the sports director at KWCR in 2013 during his time as a student at Weber State. He worked for the Utah Jazz Radio Network as a broadcast assistant from 2014-16 and currently serves as a statistician on the TV side.

HEAD COACH LYNNE ROBERTS

Record at Utah: 119-99 (8th Season)

Career Record: 340-274

Alma Mater: Seattle Pacific (bachelor's degree in history in 1997; Master's in administration in 2000)

Since stepping foot on the University of Utah campus in 2015, head coach Lynne Roberts has had the same attitude toward the women's basketball program – there is no room for complacency.



- In her seven years in Salt Lake City, the Utes have appeared in the postseason in four seasons and have had four 18+ win seasons, including two 20-win seasons. The 20-win season in 2018-19 was the first since the 2012-13 season. The Utes won 21 games in 2021-22 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament, which was the first appearance for Utah since 2011.
- Following the 2021-22 season she received a contract extension through 2027. The Redding, Calif., native entered the 2022-23 season with a 112-99 record at Utah and a career record of 333-274 in 20 years as a head coach. She is in her 21st season as a head coach in 2022-23 after spending nine seasons at Pacific and four years at Chico State.
- After receiving votes in the AP and coaches polls in her first three seasons, the Utes jumped into the Top 25 for the first time in a decade in 2018-19, ranking as high as No. 14.
- In her first seven seasons at Utah, she saw five athletes join the 1,000-point club, including Megan Huff, who did it in just two seasons, becoming just the third player in program history to achieve the feat. She also has watched six school records fall and has coached multiple athletes to top-10 all-time rankings in program and Pac-12 history, including seeing the Utes break the school record for three-pointers made in 2018-19 (239), 2019-20 (253), 2021-22 (312).
- During her time at Utah, the Utes have had 20 All-Pac-12 selections and 27 Pac-12 All-Academic selections, adding in Utah's first player of the year award in 2019 after winning Pac-12 Freshman of the Year. The Utes earned their second Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honors in 2022. In her career, she has helped 43 total athletes to all-conference selections as a head coach.
- During the 2021-22 season, the Utes advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2011 and finished the season with a record of 21-12. Under the guidance of Roberts, Gianna Kneepkens was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, just the second time a Utah player has claimed the award. Roberts collected her 100th win at Utah on Jan. 14 with an 89-48 victory over UC Riverside.
- In 2018-19, Roberts saw Utah's program rise to new heights, claiming its first 20-win season since taking over the program in 2015-16. She also led the program to nine wins in Pac-12 play, the most since joining the conference in 2011. Roberts also had her first player as Utah's head coach drafted into the WNBA after Megan Huff was chosen in the third round to the New York Liberty.
- In 2018-19, she also had three players earn spots on the Pac-12 All-Freshman team with the Utes earning the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year award, the first Pac-12 player of the year award that the Utes have received since joining the conference.
- In 2019-20, she led freshman Brynna Maxwell to become Utah's first freshman Pac-12 All-Conference selection with her also earning All-Freshman team honors. She also saw the Utes break the school record for threes made in a season (253) for the second straight year.

HOT SHOOTING UTES

The Utes have been on fire from the floor, leading the nation in field goal percentage at 52.6 percent.

- Utah has shot 50 percent or better in five of the seven games this season.
- Utah shot a season-best 59.3 percent from the floor in a win over Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 13 (35-of-59, including 17-of-32 from three-point range).
- Utah shot 57.3 percent as a team over a three-game stretch in mid-Nov., including a stellar 40.0% mark from three-point range.
- Utah's 70-point win over Utah Valley University (11/11) was the largest margin of victory in program history, and the 67-point win at MVSU (12/1) is the largest road margin of victory.
- **Alissa Pili** leads the team and ranks third in the nation in field goal percentage at 69.4% (as of Wed., Dec. 7).
- Since the 2015-16 season, Utah has shot over 50.0 percent in 43 games. During this stretch, Utah is 40-3.

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

Transfer forward **Alissa Pili** has made an immediate impact for the Utes since transferring from USC, and picked up her second career Pac-12 Player of the Week award on Nov. 28.

- Pili is shooting 69.4 percent from the floor for the season, the 3rd-best mark in the nation. In four of the seven games this season, Pili has shot over 75 percent from the floor, including a 12-of-16 effort (75%) in just 16:15 of playing time at Mississippi Valley State (12/1), scoring a season-high 28 points.
- She leads the Utes in scoring this season, averaging 19.9 points per game.
- In her first game, against Idaho, Pili scored a game-high 27 points on 12-of-14 shooting. Her 27 points were the sixth-most in a first game with a team in the Pac-12 since 1999-00, and she added seven rebounds and two blocks.
- Pili added her second 20+ game of the season with 21 against No. 16 Oklahoma, then poured in another 21 against Ole Miss in the Bahamas before her season-high 28 points at MVSU
- She has scored in double-figures in six of the seven games of her Utah career.

KNOCKING OFF OKLAHOMA

Utah used a high-powered offensive attack to knock off then-No. 16 Oklahoma, 124-78, on Nov. 16 at the Jon M. Huntsman Center.

- It was the first win over a ranked opponent for Utah since Dec. 8, 2020 (No. 15 Oregon State, 85-79).
- Utah won by 46 points, the largest margin of victory against an AP Top 25 team in program history.
- The 46 points are also the largest victory for any Pac-12 team against an AP Top 25 team.
- Utah's 41 third-quarter points were the most scored in a single quarter in program history.

- The 41 points in the third quarter are the second-most points in a quarter by a Pac-12 team since the change to four quarters was made in 2015-16.
- The 124 points tied Utah's school record, and represent the most points scored against a ranked team in regulation in a single game since 1999-2000.
- It was the first time since Jan. 27, 2019 that Utah hosted a Top 25 matchup. Then-No. 21 Utah hosted No. 6 Stanford in that matchup.
- The win over No. 16 Oklahoma was the first non-conference win over an AP Top 25 team since Dec. 17, 2005, when Utah defeated No. 23 N.C. State in the Duel in the Desert.
- Prior to the Utes' 46-point victory over the No. 16 Sooners, the program's largest victory against a ranked team came on March 11, 2006 with a 24-point win over No. 20 BYU.
- Utah set its program high for points against a ranked team with 124. The previous high was 85, which happened twice: against No. 15 Oregon State (Dec., 8, 2020) and against No. 23 TCU (Dec. 11, 2004).

BEATING THE BEST

The Pac-12 has been the nation's top-rated conference by RPI in four of the last seven seasons, with the Utes facing a Top 25 opponent nearly every week.

- Utah's 124-78 win over then-No. 16 Oklahoma was the seventh win against a ranked opponent under head coach **Lynne Roberts**.
- Utah beat No. 15 Oregon State on Dec. 8, 2020, the first win over a Top 25 opponent on the road since taking down No. 19 ASU in Tempe on Jan. 19, 2018.
- Utah's win over Oregon State in 2020-21 was the 27th win over a Top 25 opponent in program history and its highest ranked win since Stanford (#6) in 2019.
- The win against the Beavers marked the first time since Feb. 10, 2013 that the Utes had defeated the Beavers (66-40), and the first time since Dec. 18, 2000 that Utah had won in Corvallis.
- Utah's win over No. 21 Arizona State on Sunday, Feb. 23, 2020 was the second time the Utes had beaten the Sun Devils when they were ranked in the Roberts era.
- Utah's win over the No. 6 Stanford Cardinal in 2019 ties for the highest ranked win in school history and was also the first win over Stanford in program history.
- Utah's Top 25 wins in the Roberts era include victories over No. 16 Oklahoma in 2022, No. 15 Oregon State in 2020, No. 21 Arizona State in 2020, No. 6 Stanford in 2019, No. 22 Arizona State in 2018, No. 24 California in 2017 and No. 21 California in 2016.

WINNING!

Utah's 7-0 start this season marks the third time the Utes have begun a season with at least six wins in a row since **Lynne Roberts** took over the program in 2015-16. The other two came in 2018-19 (12-0) and 2016-17 (11-0).

- The longest winning streak Utah had to open a season was during the 2018-19 season when they won 12 straight games.
- Utah won 11 in a row to open the 2016-17 season.
- The Utes are looking for their seventh consecutive win to open the season on Thursday at Mississippi Valley State.

SHARING IS CARING

The Utes have been sharing the ball this season, recording assists on 63.6 percent of all made field goals (152 of 239).

- Utah is averaging 21.7 assists per game, No. 1 in the nation.
- Over the last five games, Utah has tallied 116 assists on 174 made field goals (66.7%).
- Against Southeastern Louisiana and then-No. 16 Oklahoma, the Utes notched 29 or more assists in each game, with a season-high of 33 assists against the Sooners.
- Every Ute has an assist this season, led by Ines Vieira with 35, which ranks fourth in the Pac-12 (5.0 per game).

FROM WAY DOWNTOWN!

The Utes average 9.14 made three-point shots per game this season (64 total), ranking 14th in the nation and No. 1 in the Pac-12. This comes on the heels of a school-record 312 threes made in 2021-22 (9.45 per game), which led the Pac-12 and ranked seventh in the nation.

- Utah has hit eight or more threes in 90 games under the direction of Lynne Roberts, going 65-25 in those games.
- This season, the Utes have hit 8+ threes in four games (11 vs. Utah Valley, 11/11; 17 vs. Southeastern Louisiana, 11/13; 13 vs. No. 16 Oklahoma 11/16; 10 at Miss. Valley St. 12/1).
- Against Southeastern Louisiana, the Utes hit 17 three-pointers, second-most in program history and sixth-most in a game by any team this season. The school record for made threes in a game is 19, set last season against Lipscomb.
- Utah hit 13 threes in the win over No. 16 Oklahoma.
- Utah had 25 games last season with 8+ made from downtown, including six games with 14+ (19 vs. Lipscomb, 11/10, 16 vs. Eastern Illinois, 11/28, 15 vs. Cal State Fullerton, 12/10/21, 15 vs. Arkansas, 3/18, 14 vs. Xavier, 11/13, 14 vs. USC 2/9).
- Utah has broken the school record for threes made in each of the past three seasons (312 in 2021-22, after 253 in 2019-20; 239, 2018-19), and has hit 1,010 total since the start of the 2018-19 season, third-most in the Pac-12 in that span (Stanford and Oregon). It marked the first time since 2004-05 and 2005-06 that the Utes had 200+ threes in back-to-back seasons.
- During the 2021-22 season, Utah ranked first in the Pac-12 and 7th nationally in threes made (312).

McQUEEN FROM THREE

Sophomore **Kennady McQueen** has established herself as one of the nation's best three-point shooters, and continues to reinforce that status.

- Over her career with Utah, McQueen has made three or more threes in 13 games, including three this season. Utah is 11-2 in those games. McQueen is shooting 55.4% (51-92) from downtown in games in which she makes three or more three-pointers.
- Against Utah Valley, McQueen hit five three-pointers and followed it up the next game with four.
- For her career, she has made 98 threes and is shooting 40.7 percent from deep.
- McQueen is 59 threes away from joining the top 10 mark in a career for made three-pointers (157).
- Last season, McQueen hit three or more three-pointers in nine games. In the games she hit three or more, Utah went 7-2. She hit a career-high six threes twice, once against USC (2/9/22) and again in the NCAA Tournament against Arkansas (3/18/22).

HIGH SCORING OFFENSE

The high scoring Utes that we saw last year are back for the 2022-23 season. Utah has scored 85 or more points in six of the seven games of the season, including a season-high 124 points against then-No. 16 Oklahoma, and topped the century mark again at Mississippi Valley State (12/1) with 109.

- The Utes are averaging 97.0 points per game, best in the nation. Utah is 6-0 when scoring 80 or more points this season.
- The 124 points scored in the win over No. 16 Oklahoma tied the school record. The last time the Utes scored 124 points was on March 24, 1979 against Northern Arizona.
- Since the 2015-16 season, when coach **Lynne Roberts** took over the program, the Utes are 46-5 when scoring 80 or more points in a contest. Utah is averaging 88.9 points per game under coach Roberts.
- In the 51 games in which Utah has scored over 80 points under Roberts, it averages 10.1 made three-pointers a game and shoots 40.9-percent on threes.
- The Utes have scored 80 or more points in seven of their last nine games dating back to last season.
- During the 2021-22 season, Utah averaged 75.9 points per game, the fourth-highest figure in school history and the highest since 1980-81.
- Last season, the Utes scored 90 or more points in eight different games and broke 100 points three times.
- Last season, the Utes scored 106 and 105 in the first two games of the year. It was the first time since 1978-79 season, that Utah had back-to-back 100 point games.

STEPPING UP THE DEFENSE

The Utes have been stepping up the defensive pressure this season, and demonstrated that best against Utah Valley, forcing turnovers and limiting scoring opportunities.

- The Utes limited the Wolverines to 12 points in the first half, the fewest points allowed by the Utes in a first half since allowing 13 to UVU on Jan. 6, 2010.
- The 27 points allowed were the 7th fewest in a game this season in the NCAA.
- The 32 turnovers forced in the win over Utah Valley were the most by a Utah team since at least the 1999-00 season.
- Utah held UVU to just 24.4 percent shooting from the floor.
- Utah had 14 steals in the contest, led by **Daisa Young** with four, and topped that with 18 at Mississippi Valley State (12/1).
- Utah is forcing 19.14 turnovers per game, fourth-most in the Pac-12.
- Against Southeastern Louisiana, the Utes forced 14 turnovers. This was the third straight game Utah forced double-figure turnovers, and the Utes added another 29 turnovers forced at Mississippi Valley State (12/1).

DOUBLE-DOUBLES FOR THE UTES

In the season-opener against Idaho, the Utes collected two double-doubles, and have continued to add to that total.

- **Jenna Johnson** (10 pts., 13 reb.) and **Teya Sidberry** (12 pts., 10 reb.) both collected a double-double in the Nov. 21 win over Alabama. **Johnson** added another (16 pts., 10 reb.) two days later in a win over Ole Miss.
- Johnson now has four for her career.
- Sidberry's was her first career double-double.
- Although stats from exhibition contests are not official, if they were included Sidberry would have tallied a double-double in each of the Utes first three games of the season, all coming off the bench.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

The Utes have claimed one Pac-12 Player of the Week honor thus far in 2022-23.

- **Alissa Pili** was named Pac-12 Player of the Week Nov. 28 for her role in Utah claiming two wins in the Baha Mar Pink Flamingo Championship in Nassau, Bahamas. She averaged 19.5 points and 5.5 rebounds on 15-23 shooting (78.3%) to earn her second career conference player of the week award. The first came in her second year at USC (Feb. 8, 2021). She was Pac-12 Freshman of the Week four times at USC in 2019-20. The award was Utah's first Player of the Week since 12/14/20 (Brynna Maxwell).

WATCH LISTS

Two Utah Utes received preseason recognition from national award watch lists.

- **Gianna Kneepkens** was named to the Cheryl Miller Award watch list and the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy watch list, while **Alissa Pili** was named to the Katrina McClain Award watch list.
- Kneepkens is one of eight Pac-12 Players to be named to the Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List.
- Kneepkens is one of just four sophomores on the Cheryl Miller Award Watch List (top small forward), and one of two Pac-12 players.
- Pili earned a spot on the Katrina McClain Award Watch List (top power forward).
- This is the second time on the Katrina McClain Award Watch List for Pili.
- She is one of four players from the Pac-12 named to the watch list.

PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE AWARDS

Sophomores **Gianna Kneepkens**, **Jenna Johnson** and **Kennady McQueen** earned Pac-12 preseason recognition, it was announced on Oct. 24. Kneepkens and Johnson earned Preseason All-Pac-12 honors, while McQueen was a Preseason Honorable Mention selection.

- The trio combined to score 1,052 of Utah's 2,505 points (42%) during the 2021-22 season.
- Johnson led the team in scoring, averaging 12.0 points per game. Kneepkens followed averaging 11.8 points, while McQueen averaged 9.8 points per game last season.
- They led the team in scoring 26 games last year, with Johnson and Kneepkens leading the way with 11 games each, the most on the team. McQueen followed leading the team in scoring four times.
- The trio scored in double-figures 51 times last season. Kneepkens led the team with 20 times scoring in double-digits.
- It was the first time since joining the league that the Utes have landed three players on the preseason all-conference list.

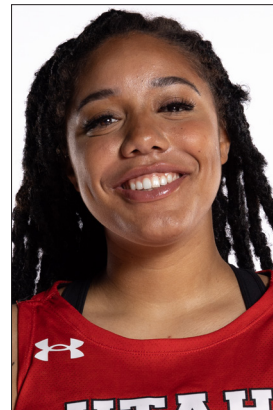

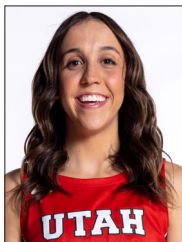
