• THE SERIES. BYU and Virginia are meeting for the

- THE SERIES. BYU and Virginia are meeting for the sixth time in the series. The Cougars trail in the series 2-3 but won the last game, a 41-33 contest in Provo in 2014. Running back Adam Hine took a kickoff back 99 yards to put BYU up 41-26 in the fourth quarter and the Cougars held on to win.
- WELCOME BACK. Virginia head coach Bronco Mendenhall returns to Provo for the first time since leaving as the Cougars' head coach and taking the job at Virginia. Mendenhall won 99 games over 11 years at BYU as the head coach (2005-2015) and spent two years as the defensive coordinator (2003-04). He had five 10-win seasons and took the Cougars to a bowl game every year as the head coach. In addition to Mendenhall, it is also a homecoming for 10 UVA staff members who either coached, played or worked on the football staff at BYU: Robert Anae, Nick Howell, Kelly Poppinga, Mark Atuaia, Jason Beck, Shane Hunter, Garrett Tujague, Matt Edwards, Justin Anderson and Pat Hickman.
- POWER 5 TEAMS. BYU is playing its sixth Power 5 team of 2021 and will play seven total this year. The Cougars are 4-1 against the Power 5 this season, beating the four Pac-12 teams. BYU will see Virginia this week and USC later this season. BYU has 11 Power 5 wins under Kalani Sitake and 31 since 2003, the most of any team not playing in a Power 5 conference. BYU had never beat four Power 5 teams in a single season prior to this year.
- BIG 12. On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an offical invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 86-50 since becoming an independent in 2011. (Read more)
- SEEKING 600. BYU has won 599 games since its first official collegiate season in 1922. Its next win will be No. 600. The Cougars would become the 60th program in the history of college football to win 600 games. In its first 47 seasons until LaVell Edwards was hired has the head coach, BYU won 173 games. Since 1972, Edwards' first season, the Cougars have won 426 games. Edwards won 257 games (Tied for 7th all-time in FBS), Gary Crowton won 26, Bronco Mendenhall 99 and Kalani Sitake has won 44 to give BYU 426 since Coach Edwards took over. BYU is No. 8 in total wins since 1972.
- BACK IN THE RANKINGS. BYU got back into the Associated Press Top 25 with a win over Washington State, coming in at No. 25. BYU is 14-4 under Kalani Sitake when playing as a ranked team.

BYU beat Arizona for the third time in six years in the season opener with a 24-16 win at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas. Neil Pau'u caught eight passes for 126 yards for two touchdowns while linebacker Keenan Pili had 17 total tackles.

1	Utah (4-3)		W 26-17	ESPN

The Cougars owned the trenches and powered their way to their first win in the series since 2009 with a 26-17 triumph over the Utes at LaVell Edwards Stadium. BYU led from start to finish and did not turn the ball over while forcing two against Utah.

9/18 Arizona State (5-2) W 27-17 ESPN

BYU forced four turnovers and cashed in on several Arizona State mistakes to beat the Sun Devils 27-17 in front of another big crowd at LaVell Edwards Stadium. Jaren Hall threw two touchdown passes in the win.

9/25 South Florida (2-5) W 35-27 ESPN2

Baylor Romney led a fast start to the offense with 21 straight points to start the game and BYU outlasted the USF Bulls 35-27. Romney threw for 305 yards while Gunner Romney and Puka Nacua both posted 100-yard receiving games.

0/1 at Utah State (5-2) W 34-20 CBS Sports

Tyler Allgeier ran for 218 yards and three touchdowns as the ground game pounded Utah State all night and the Cougars ran to a 34-20 win. BYU's defense allowed just 22 rushing yards to a USU team averaging 213.5 rushing yards coming in.

10/9 Boise State (3-4) L 26-17 ABC

Three fumbles, an interception and two turnovers on downs doomed the Cougars in their first loss of the 2021 season. BYU couldn't finish enough drives to stay in front of fell to Boise State 26-17 in a wet and rainy game.

10/16 at Baylor (6-1) L 38-24 ESPN

Baylor was able to bottle up the Cougars' run game and ran past BYU 38-24 in a preview of future Big 12 matchups. Jaren Hall threw for a career-best 342 yards and Puka Nacua caught five passes for 168 yards and his first Cougar touchdown.

10/23 at Washington St. (4-3) W 21-19 FS1

The ground game was the answer again at WSU as Tyler Allgeier ran for a career-high 32 carries and 191 yards and two scores. Leading by two points with 4 minutes left, BYU ran Allgeier seven times in a row for three first downs to run out the clock and win.

10/30 Virginia (6-2) 8:15 p.m. ESPN2

Virginia head coach Bronco Mendenhall returns to LaVell Edwards Stadium for the first time since departing for UVA after 11 seasons as BYU's head coach. Mendenhall was 99-43 as the Cougars' head man.

11/6 Idaho State (1-6) 1:30 p.m. BYUtv

Idaho State comes south from Pocatello for a game against the Cougars after visiting LaVell Edwards Stadium in 2019. BYU is 6-0 against the FCS opponent and won the last meeting by a score of 42-10.

11/20 at Georgia Southern (2-5) 4 p.m. TBA

BYU and Georgia Southern will meet for the first time. The Cougars trip to Georgia will be just the fourth trip to the Peach State. BYU has played in Atlanta twice (Georgia Tech) and once against Georgia in Athens.

11/27 at USC (3-4) TBA TBA

After defeating the Trojans in Provo in 2019, BYU returns to the Coliseum for the first time since 2003. The last time the Cougars visited USC, Matt Leinart and Reggie Bush were leading the offensive attack for the Trojans.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

BYU has had 13 different players catch passes this season, including quarterbacks Jaren Hall and Baylor Romney. 12 players have multiple receptions, five have 10 or more and six different players have receiving touchdowns.

Wide receiver Puka Nacua is No. 6 nationally with an average reception of 22.2 yards. The deep-ball threat has caught passes of 35 yards or more in four games. Against Baylor, Nacua had three receptions of 45+, the first BYU player to do so in a single game.

92.9 With 28 trips to the red zone, BYU is 26 for 28 in scoring (92.9), picking up touchdowns on 21 red zone possessions and field goals in five. The Cougars' 92.9 percent in the red zone ranks No. 15 nationally while its TD percentage of 75.00 ranks No. 11.

Running back Tyler Allgeier is No. 7 nationally with 861 rushing yards through eight games. His average of 107.6 yards per game ranks No. 15. The Doak Walker Award candidate is tied for No. 6 in rushing touchdowns with 11.

- TWO BY TWO. BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Rex and Holker have combined for 23 catches and 272 yards and three touchdowns this year. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 3,500 rushing yards and have 42 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'l Pau'u have posted more than 3,100 receiving yards and 20 touchdowns.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

Malik Moore ranks No. 7 in the country wiht three interceptions in his first year as a starter. BYU has eight interceptions to rank No. 21 on the season. Moore is one of six Cougars to pick an opponent pass this year.

BYU has made 14 sacks, averaging 1.75 sacks per game. The Cougar defense has also interupted opponents in their backfield with 36 tackles for loss on the year for 156 yards.

The BYU defense ranks No. 18 with 14 turnovers gained on the year. Overall, BYU ranks No. 15 in turnover margin at (0.88). BYU has made eight interceptions to rank No. 21 while adding five fumble recoveries through eight games.

Ben Bywater has been filling in admirably for injured Mike linebacker starter Keean Pili. Pili had 31 tackles in just over two games on the field before his season-ending knee injury against ASU. Bywater, who moved from Rover LB to Mike LB after the Pili injury, ranks No. 22 in the nation in solo tackles per game (5.2) and leads BYU with 63 total tackles on the year.

BYU is allowing 22.5 points per game on the season, which ranks No. 47 nationally. To date, BYU has held all four of its Pac-12 opponents to just 17.3 points per game (16 Arizona, 17 Utah, 17 Arizona State, 19 Washington State). Among the seven Power 5 opponents, Baylor scored 38, most surrendered by BYU, while Virginia and USC are upcoming games.

He has punted 29 times in eight games with 16 of his boots surpassing 50 yards while 10 kicks were placed inside the 20-yard line. A Ray Guy Award candidate, he was named a Ray's 8 honoree in week five (after Utah State game).

Jake Oldroyd set a new BYU record at Utah State this year by extending his streak of consecutive successful field goals to 16 before suffering his first miss in the past two seasons. He was tied with Owen Pochman's for the consecutive field goals made record, which Pochman did in the 1999 season.

Against Arizona State, Ryan Rehkow set sail with an 83-yard punt for a new school record. The previous record came in 2014 when Scott Arello booted a kick 81 yards against Middle Tennessee.

Against Arizona State, Ryan Rehkow recorded a new career-high punting yards of 317. He also set a new person record for punts in a game with six, including four that went for more than 50 yards.

KALANI SITAKE HEAD COACH YEARS AT BYU 6th year at BYU YEARS OVERALL

6th year as head coach, 21 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.



Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children. Skye. Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
