• **THE SERIES.** BYU and Virginia are meeting for the sixth time in the series. The Cougars trail in the series 2-3 but won the last game, a 41-33 contest in Provo in 2014. Running back Adam Hine took a kickoff back 99 yards to put BYU up 41-26 in the fourth quarter and the Cougars held on to win.

• **WELCOME BACK.** Virginia head coach Bronco Mendenhall returns to Provo for the first time since leaving as the Cougars' head coach and taking the job at Virginia. Mendenhall won 99 games over 11 years at BYU as the head coach (2005-2015) and spent two years as the defensive coordinator (2003-04). He had five 10-win seasons and took the Cougars to a bowl game every year as the head coach. In addition to Mendenhall, it is also a homecoming for 10 UVA staff members who either coached, played or worked on the football staff at BYU: Robert Anae, Nick Howell, Kelly Poppinga, Mark Atuaia, Jason Beck, Shane Hunter, Garrett Tujague, Matt Edwards, Justin Anderson and Pat Hickman.

• **POWER 5 TEAMS.** BYU is playing its sixth Power 5 team of 2021 and will play seven total this year. The Cougars are 4-1 against the Power 5 this season, beating the four Pac-12 teams. BYU will see Virginia this week and USC later this season. BYU has 11 Power 5 wins under Kalani Sitake and 31 since 2003, the most of any team not playing in a Power 5 conference. BYU had never beat four Power 5 teams in a single season prior to this year.

• **BIG 12.** On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an official invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 86-50 since becoming an independent in 2011. [\(Read more\)](#)

• **SEEKING 600.** BYU has won 599 games since its first official collegiate season in 1922. Its next win will be No. 600. The Cougars would become the 60th program in the history of college football to win 600 games. In its first 47 seasons until LaVell Edwards was hired as the head coach, BYU won 173 games. Since 1972, Edwards' first season, the Cougars have won 426 games. Edwards won 257 games (Tied for 7th all-time in FBS), Gary Crowton won 26, Bronco Mendenhall 99 and Kalani Sitake has won 44 to give BYU 426 since Coach Edwards took over. BYU is No. 8 in total wins since 1972.

• **BACK IN THE RANKINGS.** BYU got back into the Associated Press Top 25 with a win over Washington State, coming in at No. 25. BYU is 14-4 under Kalani Sitake when playing as a ranked team.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

22.2 Wide receiver Puka Nacua is No. 6 nationally with an average reception of 22.2 yards. The deep-ball threat has caught passes of 35 yards or more in four games. Against Baylor, Nacua had three receptions of 45+, the first BYU player to do so in a single game.

92.9 With 28 trips to the red zone, BYU is 26 for 28 in scoring (92.9), picking up touchdowns on 21 red zone possessions and field goals in five. The Cougars' 92.9 percent in the red zone ranks No. 15 nationally while its TD percentage of 75.00 ranks No. 11.

• **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has nearly 100 years of coaching experience. Offensive line coach Darrell Funk has the most with more than 30 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.

• **TWO BY TWO.** BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Rex and Holker have combined for 23 catches and 272 yards and three touchdowns this year. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 3,500 rushing yards and have 42 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'I Pau'u have posted more than 3,100 receiving yards and 20 touchdowns.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
