## BYU VS. NEW MEXICO STATE STORYLINES

- **This is only the second meeting between BYU and New Mexico State.** The Cougars won the only matchup 42-7 in Provo last year.
- **The last time BYU played in the state of New Mexico, the Cougars won the New Mexico Bowl 52-24 over UTEP in 2010.** The Cougars hold a 23-8-1 record in the Land of Enchantment.
- **BYU wide receiver Cody Hoffman has caught a pass in 30 straight games,** tied for the 10th longest streak in the nation. He has caught a pass in 36 of 37 career games. Hoffman has six 100-yard receiving games this year. New Mexico State's Austin Franklin has caught a pass in 20 straight games.
- **Punter Riley Stephenson was just named one of 10 Ray Guy Award semifinalists,** honoring the nation's top punter. Stephenson is currently No. 2 in the nation with 47.1-yard average. The Aggies' Cayle Chapman-Brown is No. 16 nationally with a 43.9 average.
- **New Mexico State head coach DeWayne Walker spent one season at BYU as a secondary coach in 1994.** He also coached against the Cougars four other times as a defensive coordinator at UCLA from 2006-2008 and at Utah State in 1993.
- **BYU's defense has moved up to No. 3 in total yards allowed, giving up just 273.5 yards per game.** The Aggies are currently ranked No. 103 in total offense, getting 341.8 yards on average.
- **The Cougars are playing the Aggies on a Thanksgiving weekend.** BYU is 3-1 on games after the weekend of Turkey Day under head coach Bronco Mendenhall.
- **In regular season finales, BYU is 4-3 under Mendenhall.** The Cougars have faced Utah five times in the regular season finale, along with San Diego State and Hawai'i.

**POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY**

A postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Mendenhall's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

**LATE SURGE NOT ENOUGH IN 20-14 LOSS TO SAN JOSE STATE**

SAN JOSE, Calif. - A late fourth quarter surge wasn't enough as the BYU football team came up short in a 20-14 loss to San Jose State Saturday at Spartan Stadium.

Down 20-7 with 2:36 left to play in the game, senior quarterback Riley Nelson scrambled to keep the play alive and hit David Foote for a 20-yard touchdown to cut into the Spartans' lead, 20-14.

Justin Sorensen logged an onside kick that hit the back of a Spartan and ended in Cody Hoffman's hands to give the ball back to BYU. Hoffman continued to make plays with a 17-yard sideline reception to convert on 4th and 8.

On San Jose State's 21-yard line with 1:20 on the clock, the Spartans sacked Nelson, causing a fumble that ended the Cougars comeback attempt.

The Spartans (9-2) controlled the first half, scoring on their first three possessions but would not go on to score again. The Cougars' (6-5) defense dominated the second half, holding San Jose State to just 69 total yards.

San Jose State rallied for a total of 364 yards. BYU outgained the Spartans with 422 total yards with 335 passing yards.

Nelson finished the night completing 28 of 51 attempts for 335 yards, one touchdown and one interception. Hoffman grabbed a career-best 13 catches for 155 yards to lead all wideouts. Jamaal Williams led the run game with 62 yards on 15 carries, including one touchdown.

Craig Bills led the defensive attack with 10 tackles. Kyle Van Noy brought pressure with three tackles for loss, one sack and seven total tackles. Daniel Sorensen hauled in an interception and totaled one tackle for loss and eight total tackles.

**OPPONENT OUTLOOK**

**NEW MEXICO STATE'S LAST GAME**

LAS CRUCES, N.M.-The New Mexico State University football team could not hold off San Jose State University as the end result was a 47-7 loss on Saturday, Nov. 10, for the team's last home conference game of the season.

"It was just a bad day, and I am kind of surprised," said head football coach DeWayne Walker.

The Aggies finished the game with a total of 220 yards of offense. The Aggies threw for 100 yards and ran for 120 yards.

Quarterbacks Andrew Manley and Travaughn Colwell shared snaps under center throughout the game. Manley threw for 46 yards off seven completions and Colwell threw for 54 yards off five completions and one touchdown. Colwell's touchdown pass was his first of the season and his third career touchdown pass. Colwell also ran for 16 yards.

A pair of NM State running backs reached the 50-yard mark in the game. Running back Tiger Powell ran for 51 yards off eight carries and running back Germi Morrison ran for 50 yards off 14 carries.

Tight end Trevor Walls led the Aggies in receiving yards with three catches for 30 yards and one touchdown. Wide receiver Austin Franklin also contributed with two catches for 16 yards.



On special teams, punter Cayle Chapman-Brown punted for a total of 356 yards, averaging 50.9 yards per punt. Franklin also helped out on special teams with 84 return yards on kick return.

On defense, safety Davis Cazares led all Aggies with nine total tackles, including two unassisted tackles. Linebacker Trashawn Nixon finished with eight tackles and linebacker Alex LaVoy finished with six tackles. Safety George Callender recorded his second interception in as many games.

**NOTES FROM BYU'S LAST GAME**

*BYU started strong but fell behind early and didn't have quite enough to recover despite its best efforts and suffered a 20-14 loss at San Jose State.*

- **Wide receiver Cody Hoffman kept his streak alive, now catching at least one pass in 30 straight games** and 36 of 37 career games. Hoffman finished with a career-best 13 receptions that went for 155 yards. Hoffman now has 951 receiving yards this season, surpassing his 2011 total of 943.
- **With 13 receptions, Hoffman passed Gordon Hudson with 181 career receptions. Also, with another 155 receiving yards, Hoffman moved ahead of Chris Smith for No. 9 in career receiving yards at 2,422 yards.** He also moved into a tie at No. 2 with his 12th career 100-yard receiving game and moved into sixth place in career all-purpose yards with 3,756.
- **Freshman Jamaal Williams scored one rushing touchdown, bringing his total to 11 on the season.** He is now tied for No. 2 among freshman running backs at BYU all-time for a single season. He is also No. 3 among freshman FBS running backs with 11 scores on the ground this year.
- **Defensive lineman Russell Tialavea blocked his third kick of the season,** San Jose State's first PAT attempt of the game. Tialavea blocked a PAT against Weber State and a field goal at Utah.
- **BYU ended with more passing yards than the Spartans, 335 to 305.** Nelson tied a career-high in completions (28) and attempts (51) for 335 yards, one touchdown and one interception. The 335 yards is his second 300-yard game this season and the second most of his career.
- **Junior defensive back Daniel Sorensen nabbed his third interception of the year to stall a Spartan drive.** Sorensen also logged interceptions against Hawai'i and Georgia Tech.

**INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TWO**

In 2012, BYU builds on its 10-3 2011 campaign with a more difficult schedule, featuring a road game at fellow independent Notre Dame along with three teams from the Pac-12 and matchups against the ACC, WAC and MW. BYU has had four games on ESPN, one on ESPN2 and others on ABC, NBC, ESPNU, The Fox Sports Network and BYUtv. BYU's remaining three games will be televised on ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPN3. The Cougars have future games scheduled with Wisconsin, Michigan, West Virginia, Nebraska, Notre Dame, Cincinnati, Virginia, East Carolina, Georgia Tech, Texas, UCF, Houston, Washington State, Boise State, Middle Tennessee State, Utah State, Utah, UNLV, Southern Miss and Hawaii.

**FLAG BEARERS**

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. Both flags are white with a blue "Y" logo. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

**TEAM CAPTAINS**

Selected by their peers, quarterback Riley Nelson, linebacker Brandon Ogletree and running back David Foote have been named as team captains for the 2012 season. The three seniors are all new captains for the 2012 season. Nelson will serve as the offense's captain, Ogletree for the defense and Foote for special teams. Nelson has 2,194 total yards of offense and has accounted for 14 touchdowns this year. Ogletree has 82 total tackles to lead the team. Foote has 35 rushes for 138 yards and also has seven tackles on special teams, blocked a punt and has two kick returns for 35 yards.

**LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM**

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 45,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium will feature new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

**MISSIONS**

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 347 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 25. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are currently 38 missionaries from the football team serving in 17 different countries. Members of the current team cover six of the seven continents around the globe and speak six different languages.

**FIRESIDES**

The BYU football team participates in hour-long devotionals prior to eight games this season. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Holy and Bronco Mendenhall.

**THE BYU OFFENSE**

• **True freshman and 17-year old Jamaal Williams has been a huge part of the BYU offense.** Williams leads BYU in total touchdowns with 12 (11 rushing, one receiving). His 11 rushing touchdowns are the second-most among BYU freshman running backs in school history and rank No. 3 among all FBS freshman running backs in 2012. Against Hawai'i, Williams seized the day, picking up 155 yards and two scores on just 15 carries. He is just the ninth BYU freshmen running back to have rushed for over 100 yards in a game. He was an all-purpose threat at Notre Dame with 106 all-purpose yards and was a scoring machine at Georgia Tech with four touchdowns (three rushing, one receiving). Williams had back-to-back 100-yard rushing games with Georgia Tech and last week vs. Idaho. Williams leads BYU in rushing with 682 yards and is fourth in receiving yards with 280. He is second in all-purpose yardage, averaging 87.5 yards per game. He is third in rushing yards by a freshman at BYU behind Harvey Unga (1,227) and Ronney Jenkins (733).

• **Wideout Cody Hoffman leads BYU in receiving in 2012.** Hoffman currently has 78 receptions for 952 yards and six touchdowns. The junior picked up his sixth 100-yard receiving game of the season at San Jose State with a career-best 13 receptions for 155 yards. His 952 receiving yards are No. 24 nationally. He is averaging 86.5 yards per game and 12.2 yards per reception.

• **BYU is winning all four quarters.** BYU has dominated the second quarter 109-20. The Cougars have a slight edge in the third quarter 50-46 and have outscored opponents 71-38 in the final frame. With the help of a 28-point output in the first quarter vs. Idaho, BYU is winning the first 15 minutes 70-58. The Cougars are outscoring opponents in a game by an average of 27.3 points to 14.7 points.

• **Fourteen different players have scored touchdowns this year** as BYU has been able to spread the ball around in 2012. Williams leads with 12, Hoffman has six, Friel has five and Taysom Hill has four while the rest go Lasike (2), Mahina (2) and then Lark, Alisa, Apo, Ridley, Falslev, Raymond, Foote and Nelson all with one each. Williams is the only player with both a rushing score and a receiving score.

**BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS**

- 1** BYU has allowed more than 24 points only one time this season (42 vs. Oregon State). The last time BYU held all but one opponent to 24 or less points was in 1979. The Cougars are No. 7 in scoring defense, giving up an average of 14.7 points per game.
- 3** The Cougars climbed to the No. 3 spot in total defense. BYU has held its opponents to an average of 273.5 yards per game. The Cougar rushing defense is No. 4, holding opponents to 89.27 yards per game while their passing defense comes in at No. 17 (184.3).
- 3** Junior Daniel Sorensen pulled down an interception against San Jose State for his third pick of the season. Sorensen also recorded a career-high six solo tackles against the Spartans.
- 8** The Cougars brought pressure against San Jose State with eight tackles for loss. Linebacker Kyle Van Noy led the attack with 3.0 tackles for loss to put his season total at 15.5. BYU has 74 tackles for loss on the season, No. 26 in the nation.

## THE BYU DEFENSE

- **BYU is No. 3 nationally in total defense.** With seven returning starters from the No. 13 defensive unit in 2011, the Cougars have continued to climb the defensive rankings in 2012. BYU has help opponents to an average of 273.5 yards. The powerhouse defense holds six top-10 defensive rankings, including the No. 2 red zone defense, allowing scores just 60.0 percent of the time.
- **One of everything almost... again.** After being the only Division I player to record a statistic in each of the major defensive categories in 2011, junior linebacker Kyle Van Noy is back at it again in 2012. The 6-foot-3, 235 pounder blocked a Georgia Tech punt to set up a BYU score and now only needs a fumble recovery to duplicate his 2011 feat. Against San Jose State, Van Noy forced a fumble, posted three tackles for loss, one sack and seven total tackles. The Bednarik Award, Nagurski Trophy and Lombardi Award watchlist honoree has top defensive marks for the Cougars in four categories, including tackles for loss (15.5), sacks (8.5), quarterback hurries (8) and forced fumbles (5). The junior playmaker is T-4th nationally in forced fumbles.
- **Stopping the run is often a theme and BYU is pretty good at it.** After finishing 2011 ranked No. 19 in rushing defense, BYU's run-stopping effort continues to be a trend in 2012. BYU held WSU's offense to -5 total yards rushing, the second time in three years allowing a team to negative rushing yards. The Cougars have held three teams under 50 yards rushing and limited San Jose State to its second lowest rushing total (59). BYU is No. 4 nationally in rush defense. The Cougars are holding their opponents to 89.27 rushing yards per game.
- **Ezekiel Ansah has come a long way since 2010** when he had to be taught how to put football pads on. The defensive lineman/linebacker hybrid had a break out game against Boise State, finishing with a career-high eight tackles and 2.5 tackles for loss, while picking up his first career sack. The sack was the first allowed by the Broncos this season. With a 6-foot-6, 270-pound frame, "Ziggy" also batted down a pass and snuffed out a 4th down attempt from Boise State. The former 200-meter track athlete improved on those numbers against Utah State, wreaking havoc in the backfield for the Aggies defense and setting career highs in tackles for loss (3) and sacks (2), and tacked on two quarterback hurries. Ansah once again led the defensive attack against Georgia Tech, stopping the run game and totalling eight tackles and one sack. He had six tackles and one pass breakup against San Jose State.
- **Behind enemy lines.** BYU rallied for 8.0 TFL against the Spartans. The Cougars have tallied at least 5.0 TFL in 10 of 11 games so far in 2012 with a season-best 11.0 TFL against Utah. Kyle Van Noy led the defensive attack against San Jose State with 3.0 TFL while five other players also made their mark. BYU is No. 26 nationally in TFL with 74 on the season.
- **Top dogs.** Five of the team's top eight tacklers are seniors and are playing their last regular season game against New Mexico. Senior linebacker Brandon Ogeltree is leading the No. 3 defense in tackles, solo tackles and assisted tackles. Ogeltree has 82 tackles on the season, giving him an average of over seven tackles per game. Preston Hadley, Ezekiel Ansah, Uona Kaveinga and Romney Fuga join Ogeltree as other top senior defenders.

During his seven seasons as the head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has returned the Cougars to the ranks of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to seven straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished their first season as a football independent in 2011 with a 10-3 record and No. 25 final ranking to finish nationally ranked for the fifth time in the last six seasons.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 72-29 (.713) record to date to rank No. 12 in total wins among all teams in the nation during that span. The Cougars have received eight straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history that will take his first eight teams to a bowl game.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in five of the last six seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win five bowls in a six-year span. Nationally, BYU is one of only seven programs to win five bowl games in the last six seasons. The Cougars have also won 10 or more games in five of the past six seasons and five of Mendenhall's seven seasons overall. In fact, only four programs have had more 10-win seasons over the past seven years.

BYU's success under Mendenhall is also evident in the national rankings and NCAA statistics. BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in the various national statistical categories 88 times in the past seven seasons (46 offense, 32 defense, 9 special teams, 1 misc.). The Cougars have achieved 55 top-15 statistical rankings, 37 top-10 rankings and 19 top-5 rankings in that span. The Cougars have also been ranked in the top-25 polls during each of the past six seasons and finished ranked No. 12 following the 2009 season -- the program's highest final ranking since finishing No. 5 in 1996.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member is tied for third nationally for Academic All-America recipients over Mendenhall's seven seasons at the helm. Seven Cougar student-athletes have been named ESPN Academic All-Americans in that span. Among all FBS schools only Penn State and Nebraska have had more during that period.

Mendenhall also serves as the team's defensive coordinator. The Cougars had the nation's No. 13 defense in 2011 to help BYU become one of only 11 programs to receive a final Top 25 overall team ranking in at least one of the two major polls during five of the past six seasons. BYU is one of only nine teams to do so in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
