INDEPENDENCE FAREWELL TOUR

- The 2022 season marks the final campaign as an independent program before joining the Big 12 in 2023.
- BYU has played 143 games over 11 seasons as an independent, with a record of 92-51 (.641). BYU's 92 wins in the independence era (2011-2021) are more than Baylor, Houston, Iowa, USC, Florida, Utah, Washington, Auburn and Texas among many others.
- BYU has faced more than 70 different teams from 36 different states, representing every FBS conference as well as Notre Dame and other fellow independent programs.
- BYU has played 50 games against Power 5 conference opponents in that span, with 23 wins, including at least one against every Power 5 conference.
- With a national schedule, BYU has averaged traveling just shy
 of 12,000 round-trip miles every regular season for the last 11
 years, totaling almost 130,000 miles as an independent program.
 The Cougars' covered more than 17,000 miles during the 2017
 season with trips to New Orleans, Starkville, Greenville, Fresno
 and Las Vegas. In 2022, BYU will compile more than 11,000
 miles of round-trip travel.

BYU VS. BAYLOR

- THE SERIES. BYU and Baylor are facing off for the fourth time, with the Bears holding a 2-1 edge in the series. It will be the last time the two teams match up as non-conference opponents before BYU joins the Big 12 Conference next year and any games between the two would be league contests. Last year, Baylor beat the Cougars 38-24 in Waco. The Bears came to Provo in 1983 and won 40-36 while BYU got a 47-13 win in Waco in 1984. BYU also welcomes back Baylor OC Jeff Grimes and OL coach Eric Mateos. Grimes was at BYU for six years over two stints (OL 2004-06, OC 2018-20) and Mateos for two seasons (OL 19-20).
- **TOP 25.** BYU is No. 25 in the preseason AP Top 25 and receiving votes in the Coaches Poll. BYU is 19-5 under Kalani Sitake when playing as a ranked team. Baylor was ranked No. 10 in both polls. The new rankings will be revealed following Labor Day's games.
- VS. RANKED FOES. BYU is 31-64-1 vs. ranked opponents in its history. The Cougars are 5-22-1 against teams in the top 10, with their last victory over a top 10 team coming in 2018 against Wisconsin on the road. BYU is 6-8 against ranked teams under Sitake, including a 4-3 mark at LaVell Edwards Stadium.
- LAVELL'S 50th ANNIVERSARY. The 2022 season marks the 50th anniversary of Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards being named the head coach at BYU. In the 47 seasons prior to Edwards, BYU had won 173 games, ranking 113th nationally. Since Edwards' takeover in 1972, BYU has won 431 games, tied for No. 8 nationally. BYU more than doubled its average win total per season from under 4 to 8.6. Edwards won multiple national coach of the year awards and led BYU to the 1984 national championship and was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame. The program will honor him in various ways this season to highlight his legacy.
- MILESTONE W. Edwards won his 50th game (50-26-1) in his 77th try as the head coach of the program. Sitake will try for his 50th (49-29) in game No. 79 against the Bears this week.
- HOME OPENER. BYU is 3-3 under Sitake in home openers, but have also faced four Power 5 teams in those contests and also two ranked teams, going 1-1.

INDEPENDENCE: THE FAREWELL TOUR

After finishing the 2021 season 10-3 and ranked in the final polls for the second-consecutive season, BYU enters its 12th and final season as an independent before moving into the Big 12 Conference in 2023. This season, the Cougars play four teams from Power 5 conferences in addition to Notre Dame. Following the season opener, BYU will face back-to-back preseason ranked teams in No. 10 Baylor and No. 11 Oregon. The Cougars will also match up with No. 5 Notre Dame and No. 19 Arkansas of the SEC. In addition to those ranked matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars also host Wyoming, East Carolina and Utah Tech and have road trips to Liberty and Stanford.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. Stadium record: 252-81 (.757)

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

BYU BY THE NUMBERS

- **575.0** BYU's yardage against USF gave BYU a No. 11 in ranking after one full weekend of college football. It was the second-most yards in an opener under Kalani Sitake (580 at Navy, 2020)
 - 135 Chris Brooks 135 rushing yards against South Florida put him at No. 7 nationally per game and No. 14 overall in total rushing yards with a few teams having played two games.
- Jaren Hall's pass efficiency of 161.0 against the Bulls gave him his seventh start at quarterback with an efficiency rating of more than 150. Last season his 156.1 rating was No.23 nationally.
 - **78.1** Hall's completion percentage of 78.1 percent is No. 17 in the FBS. It was his second-best mark of his career (20-25 vs. Idaho State, 80.0) but tops among FBS opponents.
- BYU started the year with 575 yards of total offense in game one. In 2021, BYU put up 734 yards on Virginia, 560 against Idaho State and 507 against Georgia Southern. The last time the Cougars had 3 straight games of 500+ yards on offense was the first three games of the 2020 season.

- **25.0** BYU's defense allowed a 3rd down conversion rate of just 25 percent (3-12) against USF, good for No. 28 among FBS teams.
 - The Cougar defense allowed just 12 first downs to USF on Saturday, ranking No. 11 nationally after one weekend of play.
 - BYU intercepted USF once, returning it for a score. As a team, BYU made 15 interceptions last season to rank 12th nationally. After Malik Moore's and Jakob Robinson's three picks apiece, Payton Wilgar added two interceptions before shoulder surgery cut his season short prior to the Georgia Southern game. Overall, nine Cougars intercepted an opponent pass last year.
 - 19 BYU ranked No. 19 in turnover margin (+8 last season).
 - The Cougars had four penalties for 35 yards against USF. BYU averaged 41.5 penalty yards per game last season, which ranked No. 15 nationally for fewest penalty yards per game.







BYU SPECIAL TEAMS BY THE NUMBERS

BYU ranked No. 4 in the nation in punting average in 2021. Punter Ryan Rehkow had the No. 4 average at 48.58 but was below the minimum of 3.6 punts per game to be listed in the official NCAA rankings. per game required. With the success of the BYU offense, BYU ranked No. 8 for the fewest total punts (40),

BYU ranked No. 12 last year for the most returns by an entire team of 20 or more yards (4) and No. 25 in punt return yards per game (18.3). In win at USF, Talmage Gunther made the team's only two returns (1 punt return for 7 yards and 1 kick return for 19 yards).

Jake Oldroyd made both his field goal attempts in BYU's win over USF last week. Last yaer he set a new BYU record at Utah State by extending his streak of consecutive successful field goals to 16 before suffering his first miss after a perfect 2020 season. Oldroyd moved past Owen Pochman who set his mark in 1999.

Against Arizona State last year, Ryan Rehkow set sail with an 83-yard punt for a new school record. The previous record came in 2014 when Scott Arello booted a kick 81 yards against Middle Tennessee.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) is in his seventh season overseeing the BYU football program in 2022. After the 2021 regular season, BYU inked Sitake to a new contract running through the 2027 season.

Sitake was named to an Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award Finalist and George Munger Collegiate Coach of the Year Award Semifinalist for the second consecutive year in 2021. Facing one of its toughest schedules ever, BYU went 6-1 against Power 5 conference opponents in 2021 to finish 10-3 overall and record back-to-back top-20 rankings for the first time since 2006 and 2007. BYU Athletics also formally received and accepted an invitation during the season to join the Power 5 ranks as a member of the Big 12 Conference, starting

On the field in 2021, BYU demonstrated the improving strength and maturity of the program under Sitake. Coming off an 11-1 season in 2020 that saw 13 players leave for the NFL, including five draft selections led by No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson, the team didn't miss a beat and responded with BYU's first consecutive double-digit victory seasons since 2008 and 2009 against one of the program's most challenging schedules. Sitake's team finished just out of the New Year's Six bowl consideration and earned a No. 19 final ranking.

Starting his 22nd overall season as a coach in 2022, Sitake leads the program he once played for under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards. A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972,

when Edwards took over the program. Sitake is Edwards' first former player to be named BYU head coach.

Sitake returned to his alma mater from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under Gary Andersen. Sitake took the helm at BYU after 15 years in the college coaching profession, which included seven seasons serving as a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 29 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU running backs Tyler Allgeier and Jamaal Williams and linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner. Allgeier was the fifth-round pick by Atlanta in 2022 while Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in 2019 and Warner has become arguably the NFL's top linebacker after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 13 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 13 contests. He began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior. Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake. Born in Nuku alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have four children, Skye, Sadie, Kelaokalani (KK) and Sylvia.
