• THE SERIES BYLL and Arizona are meeting for the

- THE SERIES. BYU and Arizona are meeting for the 25th time in the history of the series. The two schools are former members of the Western Athletic Conference from 1962 to 1978. They met 16 times as members of the WAC before the Wildcats departed for the Pac-8 conference in 1979. BYU actually won its first game over a ranked opponent in a 37-13 upset of No. 16 Arizona on Oct. 26, 1974, in Tucson but the Cougars trail in the series 11-12-1. BYU has won the last two matchups, including 28-23 in Tucson in 2018. Kalani Sitake is 2-0 against Arizona, picking up his first win as a head coch in 2016 with a 18-16 victory at University of Phoenix Stadium.
- SEASON OPENERS. Head coach Kalani Sitake is 4-1 in season openers. BYU is 15-5 over the past 20 seasons in game one. This will be the third time in the last six years BYU has opened its season against the Wildcats.
- VEGAS KICKOFF CLASSIC. The two teams are playing at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas. The last time BYU played in Las Vegas, the Cougars beat UNLV 31-21 in 2017. BYU's last neutral site game in Vegas was the 2015 Las Vegas Bowl.
- NFL STADIUMS. Arizona and BYU are kicking off
 the season in Allegiant Stadium, home of the Las Vegas
 Raiders. The Cougars last visited an NFL stadium in 2019 to
 Qualcomm Stadium to play San Diego State, former home
 of the Chargers before it was demolished to make way for
 a new stadium for SDSU. BYU also played South Florida in
 Raymond James Stadium, home of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 2019. The Cougars faced the Wildcats in University
 of Phoenix Stadium in 2016, home of the Arizona Cardinals.
- WATCH LISTS. BYU has eight different players that
 made various preseason watch lists for awards. Running
 back Tyler Allgeier made four watch lists, including the
 Maxwell Award (most outstanding player) and Doak Walker
 Award (best running back). Offensive lineman James Empey
 earned recognition on five different lists, including the
 Outland Trophy (interior lineman) and Rimington Trophy (best
 center). See all the watch list honorees on page 2.
- ALL ROYAL. The Cougars are sporting their new royal helmets to complete a new look of royal lids, royal jerseys and royal pants for an all royal blue look for the first time in school history. BYU added a navy blue helmet in addition to its traditional white helmet this season and plans to create unique combinations throughout the season.

Former Western Athletic Conference foe Arizona State visits Provo for the first time since 1998 when BYU defeated the No. 14 Sun Devils 26-6 in Provo. The two teams also played 14 times as WAC members during ASU's membership from 1962-1978.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You and Vince Feula.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

His 7.53 yard average trails only Luke Staley (8.03) for the single-season record at BYU (min. 100 attempts). His 1,130 rushing yards ranked No. 8 in the FBS in 2020.

Wide receiver Gunner Romney averaged 19.67 yards per reception in 2020 to lead BYU and tie for No. 15 nationally. The big-play threat had four 100-yard games last season and finished with 39 receptions for 767 yards and two touchdowns.

Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.
- TWO BY TWO. BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for nearly 2,500 rushing yards and have 30 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'l Pau'u have posted 2,264 receiving yards and 13 touchdowns.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

The Cougars tallied eight interceptions during the 2020 season. Of those grabbing interceptions, five will return for another year at BYU including Jared Kapisi, Drew Jensen, Caleb Christensen, Max Tooley and Malik Moore.

The BYU defense returns eight players that started in games during the 2020 season including linebackers Payton Wilgar, Keenan Pili, Max Tooley, Pepe Tanuvasa, George Udo; defensive backs Keenan Ellis, Micah Harper, Chaz Ah You, Isaiah Herron: and defensive lineman Gabe Summers and Caden Haws

BYU finished the 2020 season ranked No. 11 in total defense, allowing 318 total yards per game.

During the 2020 season, the BYU defense had 18 turnovers ranking No. 25 in the nation. The turnovers included eight interceptions ranking No. 46 in the nation.

The BYU defense finished the 2021 season holding its opponents to only 15.3 points per game, ranking at No. 4 nationally. Only Army has held its opponents to less points this season at 14.8 among teams that played 12 games.

KALANI SITAKE HEAD COACH YEARS AT BYU 6th year at BYU YEARS OVERALL

6th year as head coach, 21 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the



Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
