INDEPENDENCE FAREWELL TOUR

- The 2022 season marks the final campaign as an independent program before joining the Big 12 in 2023.
- BYU has played 144 games as an independent, with a record of 93-51 (.641). BYU's 93 wins in the independence era (2011-2021) are more than Baylor, Houston, Iowa, USC, Florida, Utah, Washington, Auburn and Texas among many others.
- BYU has faced more than 70 different teams from 36 different states, representing every FBS conference as well as Notre Dame and other fellow independent programs.
- BYU has played 51 games against Power 5 conference opponents in that span, with 24 wins, including at least one against every Power 5 conference.
- With a national schedule, BYU has averaged traveling just shy
 of 12,000 round-trip miles every regular season for the last 11
 years, totaling almost 130,000 miles as an independent program.
 The Cougars' covered more than 17,000 miles during the 2017
 season with trips to New Orleans, Starkville, Greenville, Fresno
 and Las Vegas. In 2022, BYU will compile more than 11,000
 miles of round-trip travel.

BYU VS. OREGON

- THE SERIES. BYU and Oregon are meeting for the seventh time with the series even at 3-3. The last game between the two teams was BYU's 38-8 victory over the Ducks in the 2006 Las Vegas Bowl.
- TOP 25. BYU is No. 12 in AP Top 25 and No. 14 in the Coaches Poll. BYU is 20-5 under Kalani Sitake when playing as a ranked team. Oregon ranks No. 25 in the AP and 24 in the Coaches Poll.
- VS. RANKED FOES. BYU is 32-64-1 vs. ranked opponents in its history. BYU is 7-8 against ranked teams under Sitake and has won three in a row (2021 No. 21 Utah, No. 19 ASU, 2022 No. 9 Baylor). Last year, BYU also faced ranked teams in back-to-back weeks, winning both of them (Utah/ASU). BYU's last win against a ranked team on the road was a 51-17 victory over No. 21 Boise State in 2020.
- RANKED VS. RANKED. BYU is 14-16 all-time when ranked and playing another ranked opponent. The Cougars have won 3 of their last 4 Top 25 matchups.
- VS. THE PAC-12. BYU went 5-0 last season against the Pac-12 with wins over league champ Utah, Arizona, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. Under Sitake, BYU is 8-8 against the Pac-12.
- MILESTONE W. LaVell Edwards won his 50th game (50-26-1) in his 77th try as the head coach of the program. Sitake earned his 50th (50-29) in game No. 79 against the Bears last week.
- QB VS. P5. Quarterback Jaren Hall is 7-1 against Power 5 teams as a starting quarterback. He is also 3-0 against ranked teams.
- LAVELL'S 50th ANNIVERSARY. The 2022 season marks the 50th anniversary of Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards being named the head coach at BYU. In the 47 seasons prior to Edwards, BYU had won 173 games, ranking 113th nationally. Since Edwards' takeover in 1972, BYU has won 432 games, tied for No. 8 nationally. BYU more than doubled its average win total per season from under 4 to 8.6. Edwards won multiple national coach of the year awards and led BYU to the 1984 national championship and was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame. The program will honor him in various ways this season to highlight his legacy.

An familiar foe from the past resurfaces with the Wyoming Cowboys coming to Provo. Other than Utah and Utah State, BYU has played the more games against Wyoming, with 78 completed in the series dating back to 1922, holding a 45-30-3 edge.

9/29 Utah State 6:00 p.m. ESPN

The Battle for the Old Wagon Wheel continues at LaVell Edwards Stadium after BYU took it back to Provo in 2019 and held onto it last season with a 34-20 win at Maverik Stadium. The teams have met 90 times and BYU leads the series 50-37-3.

10/8 vs. Notre Dame 4:30 p.m. NBC

After appearing on BYU's early schedules in independence, Notre Dame returns to the schedule for 2022. This game will be the annual Shamrock Series game for the Fighting Irish and will be played at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas.

10/15 Arkansas TBA ESPN Networks

Arkansas will become just the second team playing in the SEC to visit LaVell Edwards Stadium (Mississippi State). BYU and Arkansas have never played in football. The Cougars are scheduled to play at Arkansas in 2023.

BYU returns a game to Lynchburg, Virginia after beating the Flames 31-24 in 2019 in Provo. Liberty is coming off an 8-5 season in 2021 and looking to replace NFL Draft pick Malik Willis at quarterback.

BYU and East Carolina are matching up for the third time in the series. The two split the previous contests with the home team coming up with a win. The Cougars edged the Pirates 45-38 in 2015 but came up short in 2017 in Greenville, losing 33-17.

BYU travels to the blue turf for the seventh time, looking to replicate 2020's trip to Boise State. The Cougars got their one and only win on the road with a 51-17 runaway victory behind Zach Wilson. The Broncos did beat the Cougars in 2021 in Provo.

BYU and Utah Tech meet for the first time on the gridiron. A new FCS program that made the jump from Division II in 2020, the Trailblazers from St. George, Utah, will give the Cougars a new in-state matchup late in the season.

INDEPENDENCE: THE FAREWELL TOUR

After finishing the 2021 season 10-3 and ranked in the final polls for the second-consecutive season, BYU enters its 12th and final season as an independent before moving into the Big 12 Conference in 2023. This season, the Cougars play four teams from Power 5 conferences in addition to Notre Dame. Following the season opener, BYU will face back-to-back preseason ranked teams in No. 10 Baylor and No. 11 Oregon. The Cougars will also match up with No. 5 Notre Dame and No. 19 Arkansas of the SEC. In addition to those ranked matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars also host Wyoming, East Carolina and Utah Tech and have road trips to Liberty and Stanford.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. Stadium record: 253-81 (.758)

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA, His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

BYU BY THE NUMBERS

- **3–3** BYU has only gone for it fourth down three times but has been successful all three times so far in the 2022 season.
- 6x Quarterback Jaren Hall has had six consecutive games passing for 250 yards or more dating back to last year. He has thrown for 250+ in 8 of his last 9 games.
- 7-1 Hall is 7-1 against Power 5 teams as a starting quarterback after last week's win over No. 9 Baylor. The squad is also 3-0 against ranked teams when he starts at quarterback.
- **6.38** Running back Christopher Brooks ranks No. 30 nationally with 6.38 yards per carry after two games in 2022.
- 122 Chase Roberts' 122 receiving yards against Baylor was the first time a BYU freshman receiver had 100 yards since Cody Hoffman had 137 against UTEP in 2010. Hoffman went on to become BYU's career leader in receptions and receiving yards.

- Malik Moore and Jakob Robinson each made 3 interceptions last season as starters at the safety positions. Robinson made two picks at Georgia Southern to become the first Cougar since Dayan Ghanwoloku in 2017 (at Miss. St) to make two interceptions in the same game. Robinson and Moore rank 33rd nationally with their 3 picks.
- The Cougars achieved top-25 rankings in 10 different defensive statistical categories in 2021. Among them, the defense finished No. 2 for fewest passing plays allowed of 30 or more yards (9), No. 12 in interceptions made (15), No. 16 for fewest passing touchdowns allowed (14), No. 15 for fewest overall plays allowed of 30 or more yards
- As a team, BYU made 15 interceptions last season to rank 12th nationally. After Malik Moore's and Jakob Robinson's three picks apiece, Payton Wilgar added two interceptions. Overall, nine Cougars intercepted an opponent pass last year.
- 19 BYU ranked No. 19 in turnover margin (+8 last season).
- Top-10 Baylor ran the ball 52 times but BYU held them to 152 yards on the ground (2.9 yards per carry overall).

BYU SPECIAL TEAMS BY THE NUMBERS

BYU ranked No. 4 in the nation in punting average in 2021. Punter Ryan Rehkow had the No. 4 average at 48.58 but was below the minimum of 3.6 punts per game to be listed in the official NCAA rankings. per game required. With the success of the BYU offense, BYU ranked No. 8 for the fewest total punts (40),

BYU ranked No. 12 last year for the most returns by an entire team of 20 or more yards (4) and No. 25 in punt return yards per game (18.3). In two games in 2022, Talmage Gunther has made the team's only returns (four punt returns for 12 yards and 1 kick return for 19 yards).]

Jake Oldroyd made his first four field goals this year before missing his last two attempts. Last yaer he set a new BYU record at Utah State by extending his streak of consecutive successful field goals to 16 before suffering his first miss after a perfect 2020 season. Oldroyd moved past Owen Pochman who set his mark in 1999.

Against Arizona State last year, Ryan Rehkow set sail with an 83-yard punt for a new school record. The previous record came in 2014 when Scott Arello booted a kick 81 yards against Middle Tennessee.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) is in his seventh season overseeing the BYU football program in 2022. After the 2021 regular season, BYU inked Sitake to a new contract running through the 2027 season.

Sitake was named to an Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award Finalist and George Munger Collegiate Coach of the Year Award Semifinalist for the second consecutive year in 2021. Facing one of its toughest schedules ever, BYU went 6-1 against Power 5 conference opponents in 2021 to finish 10-3 overall and record back-to-back top-20 rankings for the first time since 2006 and 2007. BYU Athletics also formally received and accepted an invitation during the season to join the Power 5 ranks as a member of the Big 12 Conference, starting

On the field in 2021, BYU demonstrated the improving strength and maturity of the program under Sitake. Coming off an 11-1 season in 2020 that saw 13 players leave for the NFL, including five draft selections led by No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson, the team didn't miss a beat and responded with BYU's first consecutive double-digit victory seasons since 2008 and 2009 against one of the program's most challenging schedules. Sitake's team finished just out of the New Year's Six bowl consideration and earned a No. 19 final ranking.

Starting his 22nd overall season as a coach in 2022, Sitake leads the program he once played for under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards. A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972,

when Edwards took over the program. Sitake is Edwards' first former player to be named BYU head coach.

Sitake returned to his alma mater from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under Gary Andersen. Sitake took the helm at BYU after 15 years in the college coaching profession, which included seven seasons serving as a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. Sitake spent 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 29 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU running backs Tyler Allgeier and Jamaal Williams and linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner. Allgeier was the fifth-round pick by Atlanta in 2022 while Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in 2019 and Warner has become arguably the NFL's top linebacker after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 13 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 13 contests. He began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior. Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake. Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have four children, Skye, Sadie, Kelaokalani (KK) and Sylvia.
