

BY THE NUMBERS

- Dave Rose and the Cougars have a current streak of six-consecutive 25-win campaigns (2006-07 to 2011-12), 2 second only to Bill Self and Kansas, owners of seven-consecutive 25-win seasons (2005-06 to 2011-12).
- Brandon Davies picked up where he left off last season, taking three charges vs. Tennessee State. He has now 3 taken 34 charges since the beginning of last season.
- The Cougars have won 25-plus games and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for six-straight seasons (2006-07 to 6 2011-12) Both streaks are program records
- Matt Carlino opened the 2012-13 season with 10 assists vs. Tennessee State, one off his career high of 11 set last 10 season vs. Buffalo. He just missed a double-double with nine points in addition to five rebounds.
- 13 Brandon Davies has 13 career double-doubles, including nine last season.
- The Cougars had 20 assists on 30 made baskets against Tennessee State. BYU had 20-plus assists 12 times last 20 season and averaged 17.1 per game, the sixth best average in NCAA Division I basketball.
- Tyler Haws ended his freshman year by making his final 48 free throw attempts, a BYU record for charity-stripe 50 shots without a miss. He extended the streak to 50 with two makes in the first half. The streak ended with a miss in the second half but he made his last six to finish 8 of 9. Haws has made 56 of his last 57 free throws.
- Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 186 career victories, behind only 186 the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972.
- Last season Brandon Davies became the 44th Cougar to score 1,000 career points and by the end of the season 1.059had climbed to 42nd all-time. With 16 points vs. Tennessee State he passed Scott Runia (1,051 points) and is now 41st all-time in scoring at BYU and nine points behind Keena Young (1,068 points) for 40th.

REGULAR SEASON TOURNAMENT SUCCESS

With BYU's 81-66 win over Tennessee State in the season opener and first game of the Acura Coaches vs. Cancer Classic, BYU is now 21-2 under Dave Rose in regular season tournaments. Under Rose, the Cougars have won four regular season tournament titles and taken second twice. BYU continues in the CVC Classic with a home game vs. Georgia State on Nov. 13 before heading to the Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y., for games on Nov. 16 and 17 against Florida State and then either Notre Dame or St. Joseph's.

LAST TIME OUT - DAVIES, HAWS AND ZYLSTRA LEAD BYU TO WIN IN OPENER AGAINST TENNESSEE STATE

Nebraska

PROVO, Utah - Led by its three captains, the BYU men's basketball team won the 2012-13 season opener 81-66 over Tennessee State in the first game of the Acura Coaches vs. Cancer Classic at the Marriott Center on Friday night.

Sophomore Tyler Haws led all scorers with 22 points on 7 of 15 shooting and had four rebounds and one assist. Haws' school-record streak of 50-consecutive free throws without a miss came to an end with a miss in the second half. He made his first two before missing and then hit his last six attempts to finish 8 of 9 from the charity stripe.

Seniors Brandon Davies and Brock Zylstra also scored in double digits, picking up 16 and 11 points, respectively. Davies blocked a career-best four shots and had seven rebounds, three assists and two steals. Sophomore Matt Carlino just missed a double-double, logging 10 assists to go along with nine points on a night where BYU (1-0) assisted on 20 of 30 makes. The Cougars shot 54.5 percent for the game and held the Tigers to 33.8 percent shooting.

The first five minutes of the game started with a quick pace, both teams trading baskets to an 11-11 tie. Tennessee State took advantage of the 3-point line, making three from downtown while BYU favored the dunk with Davies, Haws and Josh Sharp all getting in on the action.

Neither team could put together much of a run, trading baskets with the score tied 25-25 with just over four minutes to go in the first half. Agustin Ambrosino checked in and knocked down his first shot, a long three to give BYU a 28-25 lead, igniting the crowd.

The score was part of a 9-0 Cougar run that propelled the home team to a 32-25 lead, but Tennessee State hung around, trailing 34-28 at halftime.

Sharp opened the second half hot, scoring the first bucket out of the gate before swatting away a shot on defense. The block led to a fast-break layup from Haws, giving BYU a 38-30 lead in the opening minutes of the second half. Sharp set a new career high with two blocks in the game and scored seven points.

Zylstra snagged a rebound, sprinted the floor coast-to-coast and laid in a bucket while getting fouled. The senior captain completed the three-point play to give BYU its first double-digit lead of the contest at 49-38 with 12:14 remaining in the game. Zylstra picked up three more on a trey two minutes later to stretch the lead to 54-40. Carlino scored his first points of the game at the 7:36 mark on a layup assisted by senior Craig Cusick. Tennessee State answered with a jumper on the other end to keep pace.

After making two earlier in the game, Haws' school-record streak of 50 made free throws ended with a miss on the first of two shots with under six minutes to go in the game. Haws quickly started a new streak, making the second and on the next possession picked up an andone play to push BYU's lead to 63-48.

The Cougars went on an 8-0 run down the home stretch to push the lead to 79-60. The run featured two buckets by Carlino and a one-handed slam by Davies to help close the door on the Tigers as BYU rolled to an 81-66 opening-night victory.

2012-13 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Welcome back Tyler Haws

Tyler Haws scored 22 points vs. Tennessee State, his first game since serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the Philippines. It was his 22nd career game scoring in double figures, fifth 20-point game and sixth-time in his career as BYU's leading scorer. As a freshman in 2009-10 he averaged 11.3 points and 4.2 rebounds while shooting .498 from the field, .368 from three and .917 from the free throw line.

Davies does it all

Brandon Davies stuffed the stat sheet against Tennessee State, tallying 16 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists, 4 blocks and 2 steals while drawing 3 charges. Last season he became the second Cougar in history to average at least one of everything (points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks). Davies averaged 15.2 points, 7.7 rebounds, 2.1 assists, 1.3 blocks and 1.5 steals. Russell Larson is the only other BYU player to produce a 'one of everything' season and did so twice, in 1993-94 and 1994-95 (blocks and steals were not tracked until the 1977-78 season).

Taking charge

Brandon Davies drew three charges in the season opener vs. Tennessee State. Last season Brandon Davies made the opposition pay when they drove to the basket, taking 31 charges. Nate Austin took his fair share of charges as well with a total of 29 last season. He and Brock Zylstra both took a charge in the season opener.

Block party

Brandon Davies (4), Josh Sharp (2) and Nate Austin (2) combined to block eight shots vs. Tennessee State in the opener. The eight blocks is the sixth-highest total in a game by a BYU team. Last season the single-game high was nine vs. Weber State. The program record is 15 vs. Eastern Kentucky in 1990 when Shawn Bradley had 14.

Newcomers hit big shots

Four Cougars — Agustin Ambrosino, Cory Calvert, Raul Delgado and Ian Harward — saw their first NCAA Division I action in the opener against Tennessee State. Ambrosino made his presence felt immediately, hitting a 3-pointer 12 seconds after checking in to break a 25-all tie in the first half. Calvert hit a big three in the second half to extend BYU's lead to 43-34.

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to its most successful seven-year run since taking over in 2005. His career record of 186-54 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.775). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice, led the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances and six 25-win seasons. In 2010 he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one tournament game in the two seasons since, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2011.

Rose in season and home openers

With the 81-66 win over Tennessee State to start the season, BYU basketball is 5-3 in season openers and 7-1 in home openers under Dave Rose. After dropping his first two season openers in 2005 and 2006, Rose led BYU to four-straight season-opening wins before falling 69-62 at Utah State to open last season. Rose lost his first home opener (also the season opener in 2005) but has since won the last seven home openers.

Roster notes

BYU coach Dave Rose announced on Nov. 7 that freshman Cooper Ainge will redshirt this season. Ainge is the son of BYU-great Danny Ainge and prepped at Wellesley High School in Wellesley, Mass. Earlier this fall it was announced that injuries ended the careers of two former Cougars, Chris Collinsworth and Stephen Rogers. Collinsworth had battled knee injuries for two years but was preparing to return to the court before it was discovered he needed microfracture surgery on his left ankle. Rogers tore the meniscus in his right knee last season and had surgery in December 2011 and April 2012. The knee did not respond to treatment and continued to swell and give Rogers pain, preventing him from returning to full activity with the team.




