• **THE SERIES.** BYU and Arizona State are meeting for the 28th time. The two schools are former members of the Western Athletic Conference from 1962 to 1978 when Arizona State departed to form the Pacific-10. During the time BYU and ASU spent together in the WAC, the two schools met 14 times, with the Sun Devils winning 11 of the 14 matchups. The two teams played four games in the 90s, splitting the series 2-2 with the last game in 1998, a 26-6 victory for BYU over No. 14 Arizona State in Provo. Running back Ronney Jenkins ran for 171 yards and a touchdown and kicker Owen Pochman connected on four field goals.

• **BACK IN THE TOP 25.** Coming off its victory over Utah on Saturday, BYU has entered the national top-25 polls for the first time this season, receiving a No. 23 ranking in both the USA Today Coaches Poll and The Associated Press Top 25. BYU was last ranked in the final polls last season when the Cougars finished No. 11 in both national rankings with an 11-1 record.

• **BIG 12.** On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an official invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 83-48 since becoming an independent in 2011. ([Read more](#))

• **RANKED TEAMS.** This is the first time since Utah in 2009 that two ranked teams are facing off inside LaVell Edwards Stadium. BYU was 18 and Utah was 22 in the AP poll. BYU is 4-2 in its last six games against ranked opponents after topping No. 21 Utah last week. The Cougars have beat 32 ranked teams since 1974, including four consecutive seasons with a win over a ranked opponent (2018 - Wisconsin, 2019 - USC, 2020 - Boise State, 2021 - Utah). It is just the second time in program history the school has had four consecutive years beating a ranked team (1996-99).

• **POWER 5 WINS.** BYU has nine wins over Power 5 teams under head coach Kalani Sitake. BYU's 29 Power 5 wins since 2003 are the most of any non-Power 5 team.

• **TURNOVER MARGIN.** The Cougars are +3 in the turnover margin through two games and have yet to turn the ball over on offense. BYU has won 16 consecutive games when even or ahead in the turnover battle.

• **HOME SWEET HOME.** BYU has won 11 in a row at LaVell Edwards Stadium. BYU went 7-0 at home in 2020.

• **DAVEY O'BRIEN AWARD.** Quarterback Jaren Hall was named to the Davey O'Brien Award Great 8 list for week two after leading the Cougars to a win over Utah. Hall had a career-best three touchdown passes, 149 passing yards and ran for a career-high 92 yards in BYU's first victory over Utah since 2009. Hall will also be added to the midseason Davey O'Brien Award watch list.

**INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN**

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

**LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM**

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

**MISSIONS**

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

**HONOR CODE**

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

**POLYNESIAN PIPELINE**

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You and Vince Feula.

**FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF**

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

- 0** BYU was turnover free in the opener against Arizona and against Utah last week. The Cougars have zero turnovers in four of six season openers under head coach Kalani Sitake. BYU had five games without turnovers in 2020. Dating back to last season's Boca Raton Bowl, the Cougars have gone three games without a turnover, a program first since LaVell Edwards took over as head coach in 1972. It was the first turnover free rivalry game since 2009.
- 1-2-3-4** The Cougars scored in every quarter against Utah and for the first time this year. BYU scored in every quarter in eight games last season. In 12 games in 2020, BYU's best quarter was the second, scoring 186 points in the second stanza. Through two games, quarter two is tops again with 27 points scored.
- 100.0** With seven trips to the red zone, BYU is 7 for 7 in scoring, picking up touchdowns on five red zone possessions and field goals in two. BYU is one of 19 teams with at least seven trips to the red zone to remain perfect.
- 200+** With 149 passing yards against Utah, BYU's streak of 28 consecutive games with 200+ passing yards was broken against the Utes. It was the third longest streak in school history. The Cougars did run for 224 yards. During the Sitake era, BYU is 23-4 when rushing for 200+. The 224 rushing yards against Utah were the most by BYU in the rivalry game since 1996 when the Cougars ran for 366 in a 37-17 win.

Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.

• **TWO BY TWO.** BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 2,600 rushing yards and have 31 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'l Pau'u have posted nearly 2,500 receiving yards and 17 touchdowns.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
