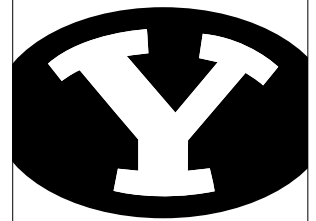

BYU STORYLINES

- BYU fell at Saint Mary's 64-57 last Thursday and is now 20-9 overall and 9-5 in WCC play. Brandon Davies led the Cougars with 25 points, 9 rebounds, 4 assists and a steal. Tyler Haws added 12 points, 6 rebounds and a steal while Nate Austin and Brock Zylstra added 6 points apiece.
- Tyler Haws has scored 20-plus points in 19 games and Matt Carlino has scored in double figures in 12 of 14 conference games. Brandon Davies is averaging 18.1 points and 8.4 boards in the last seven games.
- Gonzaga leads the all-time series against BYU 4-2. BYU fell to the Bulldogs 83-63 earlier this season in Spokane. Brandon Davies and Josh Sharp scored 14 points apiece and Matt Carlino added 11 points, 4 assists and 4 steals.

BY THE NUMBERS**6**

Dave Rose and the Cougars have the second-longest current streak of consecutive 25-win campaigns in the country at six (2006-07 to 2011-12). Only Bill Self and Kansas, owners of seven-consecutive 25-win seasons (2005-06 to 2011-12), have a longer current streak. BYU has also advanced to the NCAA Tournament for six-straight seasons.

14

Matt Carlino hit a three in 14-straight games before the streak ended at Saint Mary's. His streak tied Jimmer Fredette (2010) and Terrell Lyday (2001) for the eighth-longest streak of consecutive games with a 3-pointer in program history.

18

Brandon Davies has taken 18 charges through 29 games, including a season high of three vs. Tennessee State. He has now taken 49 charges the last two seasons, including 31 in 2011-12. Nate Austin has taken seven charges this season after drawing 29 offensive fouls last season.

21

Brandon Davies has eight double-doubles this season, with 22 points and 10 rebounds vs. UTSA, 21 and 10 vs. Montana, 26 and 17 at Baylor, 27 and 10 vs. Northern Arizona, 20 and 10 at Portland, 20 and 12 at Pepperdine, 16 and 11 vs. Santa Clara and 20 and 10 at San Diego. He now has 21 career double-doubles, including nine last season.

42

The number of points Tyler Haws scored against Virginia Tech, a career high and tied for the sixth-most scored by an individual in the NCAA Division I this season. The 42 points are also a BYU sophomore record and tied for the eighth most in program history. Haws also broke the family record of 40 set by his father Marty Haws in 1989.

205

Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 205 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

CARLINO NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – FEB. 2, 2013

Matt Carlino was named WCC Player of the Week after leading BYU to wins over Pepperdine and Santa Clara while averaging 20.0 points, 5.0 assists and 2.5 steals while shooting .464 on FGs, .444 from three and 1.000 on FTs.

HAWS NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – JAN. 14, 2013

Tyler Haws was named WCC Player of the Week after leading BYU to wins over Pepperdine and Santa Clara while averaging 24.0 points and shooting .643 from the field, .400 from three and .909 from the free throw line.

HAWS NAMED WCC, SI.COM, NBC SPORTS PLAYER OF THE WEEK – DEC. 31, 2012

Tyler Haws was named player of the week by the WCC, SI.com and NBC Sports after leading BYU to wins over Northern Arizona and Virginia Tech. Haws averaged 28.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals.

DAVIES NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – DEC. 17, 2012

The WCC named Brandon Davies the Men's Basketball Player of the Week for his career-high 33 points and added eight rebounds and one block in BYU's 78-68 victory at Weber State.

LAST TIME OUT – BYU FALLS TO SAINT MARY'S DESPITE DAVIES' 25 POINTS

MORAGA, Calif. – Despite an exceptional performance by senior Brandon Davies, the BYU men's basketball team fell to the Saint Mary's Gaels 64-57 Thursday night at McKeon Pavilion.

With the loss, BYU moves to 20-9 on the season and 9-5 in the West Coast Conference. Saint Mary's improves to 23-5 overall and 12-2 in the WCC.

Davies led all scorers with 25 points on 10 of 16 shooting. He was also the leading rebounder with nine boards and tied Gaels point guard Matthew Dellavedova with a game-high four assists.

The loss soured a milestone night for BYU sophomore Tyler Haws, who became the second Cougar in history to reach 1,000 career points during his sophomore season. Haws finished the game with 12 points and six rebounds. He now has 1,003 career points.

With BYU up 4-3 early on, senior Brock Zylstra saved the ball from going out of bounds and found Craig Cusick open for a 3-pointer. A nice spin move and finger roll by Davies gave BYU an 11-6 advantage five minutes into the game. After a 6-0 BYU run, the Gaels tied the game at 13 with seven unanswered points of their own. With BYU trailing 18-17, Cougar guard Matt Carlino split the defense and forced Gaels forward Mitchell Young to slide into help position, leaving Davies wide open to throw down an alley-oop with 10:04 to go in the half.

Saint Mary's took a 22-19 lead after making four straight free throws. BYU regained the lead with a pair of free throws by Nate Austin and a turnaround jumper by Davies on the right block with 6:00 remaining in the first period.

2 #BYUhoops

Davies capped off his impressive first half with a nice bounce pass to Austin for a layup that gave the Cougars a 32-28 advantage that they took into the locker room at halftime. Davies scored 12 points, grabbed five rebounds and dished out four assists in 17 first half minutes. BYU shot 59 percent in the first half, compared to 35 percent for Saint Mary's.

Continuing his stellar night, Davies scored the first basket of the second half to put the Cougars up 34-28. The Gaels, however, regained the lead with a 7-0 run over the next three minutes. Saint Mary's pushed its lead to five at 41-36 before Davies finished an old-fashioned three-point play to pull the Cougars within three. A layup by Zylstra tied the game at 41 with 13:37 to play in the game.

Zylstra split a pair of free throws to put BYU ahead at 44-43 with 11 minutes to go. The Cougars went cold for the next three minutes, however, allowing the Gaels to build a 49-44 lead.

With BYU trailing 54-48 with 5:49 left in the game, Davies caught the ball on the right block and spun to the baseline. A quick pass fake to the middle of the floor turned Davies' defender around, freeing the BYU big man up for a layup. It was the Cougars' first field goal in more than five minutes.

Just before the five-minute mark, Zylstra made a 3-pointer in transition that pulled the Cougars within one at 54-53. With 1:20 to play and BYU trailing 59-57, Carlino went to the free throw line with a chance to tie the game but missed both shots. Saint Mary's put the game away at the free throw line, making four in a row to make the final score 64-57.

2012-13 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Player and team notes

- BYU won its 20th game with a 70-68 victory against Utah State, giving the Cougars eight-straight 20-win seasons, the longest such streak in program history. All eight seasons have come under Dave Rose, a program record for 20-win seasons by one coach. Stan Watts had seven 20-win seasons.
- Dave Rose earned his 200th career victory with a 74-57 win over San Diego on Jan. 19, 2013. Stan Watts is the only other coach in BYU history with 200-plus wins. Watts won his 200th game during his 12th season at the helm on Feb. 2, 1961, at New Mexico. It was his 329th career game (Watts' career record was 371-254 in 23 seasons). Rose is in his eighth season and earned win number 200 in his 259th game.
- Tyler Haws reached 1,000 career points when he hit a jumper at the 15:30 mark in the second half at Saint Mary's. He joins Danny Ainge as the only BYU players to reach 1,000 career points as sophomores. Haws has 1,003 points and is the 45th Cougar to reach the milestone.
- Brandon Davies has stepped up his play of late, averaging 18.1 points, 8.4 boards and 1.4 steals and shooting .547 over the last seven games. He's had four 20-plus point games and four double-doubles during that time.
- BYU has completed four comebacks after trailing at the half this season. The Cougars trailed Utah and San Francisco by nine at the half and won 61-58 and 80-76. BYU trailed Pepperdine by five at the half at home and came back to win 76-51. The Cougars trailed at Pepperdine 31-20 but bounced back in the second half to win 63-61.
- BYU has been a better shooting team in league games than nonconference games. The Cougars are shooting better from the field (.481 in WCC play to .445 in nonconference games) and from three (.368 to .306).
- The Cougars are on pace to break team records in steals in a season and steals per game for a season. BYU has 258 steals in 29 games, good for 8.9 per game. The current records of 307 steals and 8.5 steals per game were set during the 2009-10 season.
- Tyler Haws has shot 100 percent from the line while attempting at least 10 free throws in three games this season, tied with Russell Larson (1993-94) and Ken Roberts (1994-95) for most perfect days from the line (minimum of 10 attempts). Haws has four such games in his career, tied for the most in BYU history with Jimmer Fredette. Danny Ainge, Lee Cummond, Larson and Roberts are tied for second on the career list with three.

Haws's big day

On Dec. 29, 2012, Tyler Haws scored a career-high 42 points against Virginia Tech as he hit 14 of 25 from the field, 6 of 8 from three and 8 of 9 from the free throw line. See below for the records Haws set in his breakout game:

- Most points scored by a BYU sophomore
- Tied for eighth-most points scored by an individual in BYU history
- Most points scored by a BYU player not named Jimmer Fredette since 1961 (Bob Skousen, 47 vs. UCLA)
- Gives BYU a father-son duo in the 40-point club (Haws's father Marty scored 40 vs. Siena in 1989)
- In the final five minutes of games this season, Tyler Haws is 32 of 49 from the field, 7 of 9 from three and 22 of 24 from the free throw line in the last five minutes of games.

BYU vs. the top 5 in Provo

Ranked No. 2 in the AP and Coaches Polls, Gonzaga enters Thursday's game as the highest ranked opponent BYU has played in the Marriott Center and tied for the highest ranked team the Cougars have played in Provo. Below is a list of games against top 5 teams BYU has played in Provo.

Fast start for Tyler Haws

Tyler Haws opened 2012-13 with six-straight 20-point games, the second best such streak in program history. Only Devin Durrant started a season with more consecutive 20-point games, seven in 1983-84. Danny Ainge, Kresimir Cosic and Michael Smith started seasons with five-straight 20-point games.

Davies does it all

Brandon Davies has stuffed the stat sheet this season, averaging 18.0 points, 7.7 rebounds, 2.4 assists, 1.1 blocks and 1.4 steals in 29 games. Last season he became the second Cougar in program history to average at least one of everything (points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks). Russell Larson is the only other BYU player to produce a 'one of everything' season and did so twice, in 1993-94 and 1994-95 (blocks and steals were not tracked until the 1977-78 season).

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to its most successful eight-year run since taking over in 2005. His career record of 205-63 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.765). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice and has guided the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances and six 25-win seasons. In 2010 he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one tournament game in the two seasons since, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2011.
