QUICK HITS

- After hitting just 7 of 27 3-pointers in the first two games of the season, BYU caught fire from downtown, hitting 27 of 48 in the next two games (15 of 26 vs. Longwood, 12 of 22 vs. Prairie View A&M). The 27 3s over a two-game stretch are a program record. The Cougars continued their hot shooting by hitting 8 of 18 from three vs. Nevada.
- Seniors Noah Hartsock and Charles Abouo led BYU against Nevada. Hartsock tied his career high with 21 points on 9 of 12 shooting and Abouo hit 8 of 12 from the field and 4 of 5 from three for 22 points.
- After struggling from the field the first two games of the season, BYU is shooting 55.4 percent from the field and 53.0 percent from three the last three games. During that stretch, Abouo is averaging 18.0 points and shooting 66.7 percent and Hartsock is averaging 17.0 points and shooting 65.6 percent.
- The Cougars have been on fire in the second halves of the last three games, shooting 64.8 percent from the field and 60.5 percent from three. BYU is averaging 51.7 points during those three second halves. Abouo is averaging 12.3 points and shooting 92.9 percent in those second halves and Hartsock is averaging 7.3 points and shooting 75.0 percent.
- Dave Rose is one of the most successful coaches in the history of BYU basketball. He is second in program history in wins (163), first in winning percentage (.780) and has led the Cougars to five-straight NCAA Tournament berths and four conference titles. He also earned three Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year awards.

LAST TIME OUT - BYU VS. NEVADA

HOFFMAN ESTATES, Illinois – Seniors Charles Abouo and Noah Hartsock led the BYU men's basketball team to a 76-55 victory over the Nevada Wolfpack on Friday to move on to the Chicago Invitational Challenge championship game.

Abouo led the Cougars with 22 points and eight rebounds while tying his career high with four three-pointers. He shooting 8 of 12 from the field, including 4 of 5 from three, and did not miss a shot in the second half. Hartsock tied his career high with 21 points and hit 9 of his 12 shots in the game.

Junior Brandon Davies scored 10 points to make it three Cougars in double figures. The win is the fourth consecutive 20-point win for BYU since losing the season opening game at Utah State and pushes its record to 4-1. Rose started his third different lineup in five games this season and the team got off to a rousing start. BYU jumped out to a 24-6 lead in the first 8:31 of the game largely due to 17 points off 13 first half Nevada turnovers.

The lead faded progressively as the first half went on as Nevada switched to a zone defense and slowed down the BYU offense. BYU managed just 10 points during the final 11:29 of the half and went into the locker room up 34-27.

Hartsock led BYU with 11 first half points, while first time starter Anson Winder, Abouo and Davies each added six first half points. The Cougars went into the locker room with no points from the bench. The teams exchanged baskets to start the second half as the BYU lead stayed in single digits. Abouo helped BYU extend the lead back to double digits with two 3s in a two-minute span, the second coming with just over 10 minutes remaining and making the score 55-43.

Junior Stephen Rogers scored the first bench points for BYU on a fast break layup with 9:30 remaining to put BYU up 57-43. Nevada countered and brought the game back within single digits before the Cougars put the game away with a 21-7 run. Niether Abouo nor Hartsock missed a shot in the second half, going 6 of 6 and 4 of 4 from the field.

Anson Winder had his first career points and assists, hitting 2 of 4 threes for eight points and dishing out five assists. Nate Austin and Josh Sharp pitched in down low as Austin had four points, three boards and a block and Sharp had one point, three assists and four rebounds. In all, the four newcomers totaled 24 points, 10 assists, eight rebounds and one block.

The freshmen had another impressive outing against Prairie View A&M. Winder totaled 11 points and four assists and Sharp contributed five points and six boards. In all the newcomers totaled 23 points, 10 rebounds, seven assists and two steals.

Junior Forward Brandon Davies has made a habit of making the opposition pay when driving to the basket. Against Utah State, Davies drew four charges. He took three charges against BYU-Hawaii, two against Prairie View A&M and one against Nevada to bring his season total to 10. Nate Austin assumed Davies' role against Longwood, taking three charges.

GOING GREEK

BYU men's basketball went on a 10-day, four-game tour of Greece in August. The Cougars won their first two games against the Athens All-Stars (88-56) and ASE Doukas (114-45) while also playing a friendly game against US Navy personnel on a base in Crete. While in Greece, BYU was invited to participate in the Acropolis of Athens Tournament against the Greek and Italian National Teams, both ranked among the top 10 in the world by FIBA. Against Greece, Stephen Rogers led BYU with 20 points in an 83-54 loss. Brock Zylstra exploded for 26 points and four 3-pointers in BYU's 102-63 loss to an Italian team that featured three NBA stars.

NEW HOME

In 2011-12, BYU men's basketball enters its first season as a member of the West Coast Conference. The Cougars have played each member of the league at least twice all time. Last season, BYU defeated St. Mary's 74-73 in the South Padre Island Invitational championship game and Gonzaga 89-67 in the third round of the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16. COACHING STAFF

For the second-straight season there was a change to the coaching staff. Former associate head coach Dave Rice, who had been with the staff since Rose became the head coach in 2005, left to take the head job at his alma mater, UNLV. Rose hired Mark Pope as an assistant coach in May 2011. Pope comes to BYU after one season as an assistant at Wake Forest. Prior to Wake Forest, Pope was the director of basketball operations at Georgia. Pope played his college ball at Washington and Kentucky. In 1996, he was a team captain and helped Kentucky win the NCAA National Championship. Pope was selected by he Indiana Pacers in the second round of the NBA draft and played seven seasons in the NBA. He played in the Eastern Conference Finals with Indiana (1998) and Milwaukee (2001).




