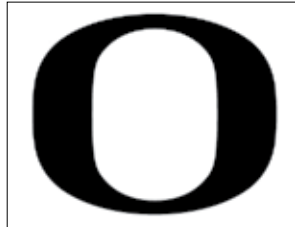

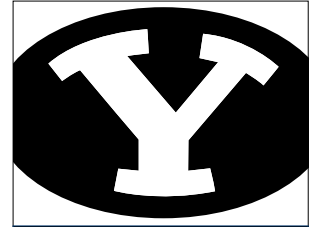

BYU STORYLINES

- This marks BYU's ninth-straight postseason appearance and seventh NCAA tournament appearance in the last eight years. The Cougars have won at least one postseason game in each of the last four years.
- BYU's second round game will be a rematch as the Cougars and Ducks met earlier this season on Dec. 21, 2013, in Eugene, Ore., at Matthew Knight Arena. Oregon defeated the Cougars 100-96 in overtime.
- Four Cougars earned All-WCC honors in 2013-14. Junior guard Tyler Haws was named the WCC Player of the Year and to the All-WCC First Team. Sophomore guard Kyle Collinsworth also made the All-WCC First Team and junior guard Matt Carlino was named honorable mention. Freshman forward Eric Mika earned All-WCC Freshman honors.

BYU NCAA TOURNAMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- This year marks BYU's 28th NCAA tournament appearance in the program's history. The Cougars have a 15-30 record in the NCAA tournament.
- The Cougars are back in the NCAA tournament after a one-year absence. In BYU's last appearance in 2012, the Cougars defeated Iona 78-72 in the first round. BYU trailed by 25 in the first half (49-24) before coming back to win, making it the biggest comeback in NCAA tournament history.
- 2013-14 marks BYU's first time as a No. 10 seed in the NCAA tournament and BYU's first time playing in Milwaukee, Wis., in the NCAA tournament.
- BYU has gone to the NCAA tournament 10 out of the last 14 seasons and seven of the last eight (2001, 2003, 2004, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014). BYU has earned a post-season tournament invite in 14 of the last 15 years (NIT in 2000, 2002, 2006, 2013).
- By earning a No. 3 seed in 2011, the Cougars matched their best seed in program history. BYU was also a No. 3 seed in 1980 and in 1986 the Cougars were a No. 4 seed. Other single-digit seeds included being a No. 5 seed in 1979, a No. 6 seed in 1981 (the year the Cougars advanced to the Elite Eight), a No. 7 seed in 1993 and 2010, and No. 8 seeds in 1984, 1995, 2007, 2008 and 2009. BYU has been a No. 10 seed in 1987, 1991, 1992 and 2014, a No. 12 seed in 2001, 2003 and 2004 and a No. 14 seed in 2012.
- BYU's 99-92 win over Florida in double overtime in 2010 was the program's first NCAA tournament victory since 1993 when the No. 7 seed Cougars defeated SMU, 80-71, in Chicago.
- BYU is 10-17 in its opening round games in NCAA tournament play.
- In 2010-11, BYU won two games and advanced to a region semifinal in the NCAA tournament for the first time since 1981 when the Cougars (as a No. 6 seed), defeated Princeton, 60-51 before upsetting No. 3-seed UCLA 78-55. BYU went on to defeat No. 2-seed Notre Dame on Danny Ainge's last-second, length-of-the-court dash, 51-50, to advance to the Region Final before losing to Ralph Sampson and No. 1-seed Virginia, 74-60.
- Current Cougar head coach Dave Rose is 4-5 in five NCAA Tournament appearances, tied with legendary BYU coach Stan Watts for the most NCAA tournament wins. Watts had a 4-10 record in seven appearances. Rose and Watts are followed by Frank Arnold (3-3 in three appearances), Ladell Andersen (2-3 in three appearances), Roger Reid (2-5 in five appearances) and Steve Cleveland (0-3 in three appearances).
- BYU head coach Dave Rose played in the NCAA championship game for Houston's "Phi Slamma Jamma" team that lost to North Carolina State at the final buzzer in 1983.

BY THE NUMBERS

1 Tyler Haws is the only player in BYU history to surpass 1,700, 1,800 or 1,900 career points during his junior season. The previous record holder for points through a junior season by a Cougar was Danny Ainge, who scored 1,685 in his first three years at BYU. Haws and Ainge are the only Cougars to reach 1,000 career points as sophomores. Ainge had 1,030 at the end of his sophomore season while Haws had 1,177.

7 The number of times a player in the West Coast Conference has scored 35 points or more in a single game since BYU joined the league in 2011. Five of the seven instances have been achieved by Tyler Haws: 42 vs. Virginia Tech on 12/29/12, 37 vs. Washington on 3/19/13, 35 vs. Pepperdine on 1/9/14, 48 at Portland on 1/23/14 and 38 vs. Pacific on 1/30/14. The other two players to reach 35 are Stephen Holt of Saint Mary's (35 on 2/22/14) and Jared Brownridge of Santa Clara (38 on 3/1/14).

8 The number of career games for Tyler Haws shooting 100 percent from the free throw line with a minimum of 10 attempts, a BYU record. 88.6 Tyler Haws' career free-throw percentage, first all-time in BYU history. He has hit 514 of 580 from the line in his career.

2013-14 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to one of the most successful runs in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 232-77 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.751). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice, led the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances, two NIT appearances, six 25-win seasons and nine 20-win seasons. In 2010, he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one postseason game in the three seasons since, including a spot in the Sweet 16 in 2011 and a trip to the NIT semifinals in 2013.

Postseason experience

BYU has multiple players with NCAA tournament experience. Nate Austin, Matt Carlino, Josh Sharp and Anson Winder were freshmen when the Cougars made the field in 2012 and overcame a 25-point deficit to defeat Iona in the First Four. Tyler Haws played in the dance in 2010 as a freshman prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in the Philippines. That year BYU defeated Florida in double overtime to advance to the round of 32. Kyle Collinsworth – who is out with a torn ACL – played on BYU's 2011 Sweet 16 team before serving a two-year mission in Russia. Austin, Carlino, Haws, Sharp and Winder also played in the NIT last season.

Tyler Haws scored 31 points against Loyola Marymount while hitting 9 of 19 from the field and 13 of 14 from the free throw line. He joined Brandon Davies (33 vs. Weber State on Dec. 15, 2012) as the only other player to score 30-plus points without hitting a three since Keena Young scored 34 vs. UNLV on March 10, 2007. The last BYU wing/guard to score 30 without hitting a three was Travis Hansen on Jan. 5, 2002 when he netted 30 against Pepperdine. Prior to Hansen, the last guard to score 30-plus without a three was Marty Haws, Tyler's father, on Jan. 4, 1990 vs. Hawaii.

30 points without a free throw

Matt Carlino tied his career high with 30 points against Portland on Feb. 22, 2014, without making a free throw. It was only the fifth game in BYU history in which a BYU player has scored 30-plus points without making a free throw.
