- BYU improved to 19-8 overall and 9-4 in WCC play with an 86-72 win against Portland on Saturday. Tyler Haws scored a game-high 28 points and added 8 boards, Brandon Davies had 23 points, 5 assists and 3 blocks and Matt Carlino and Craig Cusick each registered 10 points and 7 assists.
- Tyler Haws has scored 20-plus points in 18 games and Matt Carlino has scored in double figures in 12 of 13 conference games. Brandon Davies has 8 double-doubles this season.
- BYU leads the all-time series with Utah State 136-92. The Cougars were scheduled to host the Aggies on Dec. 5, 2012, but the game was postponed due to the serious medical situation of USU student-athlete Danny Berger that occurred during practice on Dec. 4.

Dave Rose and the Cougars have the second-longest current streak of consecutive 25-win campaigns in the country at six (2006-07 to 2011-12). Only Bill Self and Kansas, owners of seven-consecutive 25-win seasons (2005-06 to 2011-12), have a longer current streak. BYU has also advanced to the NCAA Tournament for six-straight seasons.

Brandon Davies has taken 18 charges through 27 games, including a season high of three vs. Tennessee State. He has now taken 49 charges the last two seasons, including 31 in 2011-12. Nate Austin has taken seven charges this season after drawing 29 offensive fouls last season.

21

Brandon Davies has eight double-doubles this season, with 22 points and 10 rebounds vs. UTSA, 21 and 10 vs. Montana, 26 and 17 at Baylor, 27 and 10 vs. Northern Arizona, 20 and 10 at Portland, 20 and 12 at Pepperdine, 16 and 11 vs. Santa Clara and 20 and 10 at San Diego. He now has 21 career double-doubles, including nine last season.

The number of points Tyler Haws scored against Virginia Tech, a career high and the second-most scored by an individual in the NCAA Division I this season. The 42 points are also a BYU sophomore record and tied for the eighth most in program history. Haws also broke the family record of 40 set by his father Marty Haws in 1989.

204

Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 204 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

CARLINO NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – FEB. 2, 2013

Matt Carlino was named WCC Player of the Week after leading BYU to wins over Pepperdine and Santa Clara while averaging 20.0 points, 5.0 assists and 2.5 steals while shooting .464 on FGs, .444 from three and 1.000 on FTs.

HAWS NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK – JAN. 14, 2013

Tyler Haws was named WCC Player of the Week after leading BYU to wins over Pepperdine and Santa Clara while averaging 24.0 points and shooting .643 from the field, .400 from three and .909 from the free throw line.

HAWS NAMED WCC, SI.COM, NBC SPORTS PLAYER OF THE WEEK – DEC. 31, 2012

Tyler Haws was named player of the week by the WCC, SI.com and NBC Sports after leading BYU to wins over Northern Arizona and Virginia Tech. Haws averaged 28.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals.

LAST TIME OUT – BYU SOARS OVER PILOTS IN 86-72 VICTORY

PROVO, Utah – Four players scored in double figures as the BYU men's basketball team grounded the Portland Pilots 86-72 on Saturday night at the Marriott Center.

"I'm really pleased with how we shared the ball on offense," BYU head coach Dave Rose said. "Our emphasis in the last week was to try to get our guys to compete together as a group on both ends of floor. Defensively we were really together as a group in man and zone. The guys came to play and trusted each other."

BYU (19-8, 9-4) shot 59.6 percent for the game on 34 of 57 shots – the team's best shooting night of the season – while Portland (10-18, 3-10) went 28 of 60 for 46.7 percent.

Former Cougar greats Mel Hutchins and Roland Minson were honored at halftime with a special jersey retirement ceremony. Hutchins was an All-American, NBA Rookie of the Year and with Minson, led the Cougars to the 1951 NIT Championship. Minson was BYU's all-time leading scorer with 1,407 career points for 22 years until the record was broken in 1973 and was the MVP of the NIT.

BYU opened the game with a 10-6 lead, six points coming from Haws and four from Davies. Cusick added a triple to make it a 13-6 lead with 13:00 to play in the first half.

The trey was part of a 9-3 run that built the Cougar lead to 17-9 over the next two minutes. Cusick added another 3-pointer with 11:10 to go until the break.

A 10-0 Cougar run had the Pilots trailing at 27-12 with 8:20 left until halftime. Portland broke up the run with a made free throw but Haws quickly responded with a long two on the next possession.

2 #BYUhoops

Brock Zylstra drilled a three and Haws added a short jumper around the three-minute mark to build the Cougar lead to 41-22.

Down the stretch of the first half, Carlino added one more trey for BYU to push the lead to 46-25 at the break. The Cougars shot over 60 percent for the first half and Haws led with 15 points while Davies added 11.

In the opening minutes of the second half, Cusick drained his third trey of the game to put the Cougars up 52-32. Davies banked in a jumpshot to make it 60-38 with 13:48 to go but Portland had some fight left, knocking down their sixth 3-pointer to keep the lead under 20. A short 7-2 run by the Pilots made it 62-45 with 11:39 on the clock.

BYU wouldn't have anything to do with a Pilot comeback however, putting together a 6-0 stretch to push the lead back to 24 at 71-47 with 9:17 to go.

With 4:30 left in the game Portland's Tanner Riley knocked down a triple but Zylstra answered with a spinning layup on the next trip down for BYU. Riley tried to spark the Pilots with another trey in return but Haws was right back at it with a 3-pointer of his own to make it 82-62. The Cougars would go on to win 86-72.

BYU hosts Utah State on Tuesday, Feb. 19 at 7 p.m MST in the Marriott Center. The game will be televised on BYUtv and broadcast on KSL Newsradio 102.7 FM and 1160 AM.

2012-13 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Player and team notes

- Dave Rose earned his 200th career victory with a 74-57 win over San Diego on Jan. 19, 2013. Stan Watts is the only other coach in BYU history with 200-plus wins. Watts won his 200th game during his 12th season at the helm on Feb. 2, 1961 at New Mexico. It was his 329th career game (Watts' career record was 371-254 in 23 seasons). Rose is in his eighth season and earned win number 200 in his 259th game.
- Tyler Haws has scored 20-plus points 18 times this season. He opened the year with six-straight 20-point games and later had a streak of seven-consecutive 20-point games.
- Matt Carlino has scored in double figures in 12 of 13 WCC games. During that stretch he is averaging 15.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 2.8 steals. His assist to turnover ratio during that time is 2.1 to 1.
- BYU has completed four comebacks after trailing at the half this season. The Cougars trailed Utah and San Francisco by nine at the half and won 61-58 and 80-76. BYU trailed Pepperdine by five at the half at home and came back to win 76-51. The Cougars trailed at Pepperdine 31-20 but bounced back in the second half to win 63-61.
- BYU shot a season-best .596 from the field against Portland on Feb. 16, surpassing the .583 the Cougars shot at home against Santa Clara on Feb. 2. BYU has shot .500 or better 12 times this season and is 11-1 in those games. The Cougars also had 26 assists against the Pilots, one off the season high of 27 set against Eastern New Mexico. BYU did set a season best with a 3.3 to 1 assist to turnover ratio against Portland.
- BYU has been a better shooting team since starting league play. The Cougars are shooting better from the field (.479 in WCC play to .450 in nonconference games) and from three (.369 to .315). BYU has also shown big improvements in the steals category, increasing its per game average from 8.4 per game in non-league games to 9.4 per game in WCC games. At 8.9 steals per game in all games, the Cougars are on pace to set the program record for steals per game and steals in a season.
- Tyler Haws has shot 100 percent from the line while attempting at least 10 free throws in three games this season, tied with Russell Larson (1993-94) and Ken Roberts (1994-95) for most perfect days from the line (minimum of 10 attempts). Haws has four such games in his career, tied for the most in BYU history with Jimmer Fredette. Danny Ainge, Lee Cummond, Larson and Roberts are tied for second on the career list with three.

Haws's big day

On Dec. 29, 2012, Tyler Haws scored a career-high 42 points against Virginia Tech as he hit 14 of 25 from the field, 6 of 8 from three and 8 of 9 from the free throw line. See below for some of the records Haws set in his breakout game:

- Most points scored by a BYU sophomore
- Tied for eighth-most points scored by an individual in BYU history
- Most points scored by a BYU player not named Jimmer Fredette since 1961 (Bob Skousen, 47 vs. UCLA)
- Gives BYU a father-son duo in the 40-point club (Haws's father Marty scored 40 vs. Siena in 1989)

Haws the closer

Tyler Haws has played some of his best basketball in the final five minutes of games this season. Against Cal State Northridge, BYU trailed 74-73 with less than four minutes remaining. Haws hit a jumper with 3:44 to go to give BYU the lead and had 10 of the Cougars' final 14 points to help secure the 87-75 win. Against Utah, BYU trailed 58-56 before Haws completed a three-point play with 2:47 to go. He added two free throws with 16 seconds remaining to secure the 61-58 win. After struggling from the field the first 35 minutes at Weber State, Haws scored nine points in the last five minutes on 3 of 3 shooting from the field and 2 of 2 from the free throw line. Against Saint Mary's he scored six points in the final five minutes, including four in the last 41 seconds. For the season, Haws is 31 of 46 from the field, 7 of 9 from three and 20 of 22 from the free throw line in the last five minutes of games.

Fast start for Tyler Haws

Tyler Haws opened 2012-13 with six-straight 20-point games, the second best such streak in program history. Only Devin Durrant started a season with more consecutive 20-point games, seven in 1983-84. Danny Ainge, Kresimir Cosic and Michael Smith started seasons with five-straight 20-point games.

Davies does it all

Brandon Davies has stuffed the stat sheet this season, averaging 18.0 points, 7.7 rebounds, 2.4 assists, 1.2 blocks and 1.4 steals in 27 games. Last season he became the second Cougar in program history to average at least one of everything (points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks). Russell Larson is the only other BYU player to produce a 'one of everything' season and did so twice, in 1993-94 and 1994-95 (blocks and steals were not tracked until the 1977-78 season).

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to its most successful eight-year run since taking over in 2005. His career record of 204-62 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.767). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice and has guided the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances and six 25-win seasons. In 2010 he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one tournament game in the two seasons since, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2011.

Rose among the nation's best

Dave Rose is sixth in career winning percentage among active NCAA Division I head coaches (as of 2/17/13).
